RHP Will Schomberg (4-1, 1.89 ERA) vs. RHP Patrick Copen (3-2, 3.41 ERA) TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field, as your first-place Quakes continue a 12-game home stand, with

game five of a six-game set against the Modesto Nuts (SEA). Everyone will enjoy post-game Fireworks tonight, thanks to Tam's Burgers! Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE NUTS: This is the 11th of 12 meetings between the two clubs this year and the fifth of six at LoanMart Field. The Quakes went just 1-5 at John Thurman Field earlier in the month and after four straight losses in this series, are now 1-9 this year. Last season, these two clubs met in the Cal League Championship Series, with Modesto sweeping the Quakes to earn their tenth title in franchise history. In the 2023 regular season, Rancho went 2-1 at LoanMart Field, 3-6 overall against the Nuts.

LAST GAME: A late Rancho rally fell short on Friday, as the Quakes dropped their sixth straight game overall, an 11-9 decision to the Modesto Nuts at LoanMart Field. Jonny Farmelo had four hits, two knocked in and two runs scored to lead Modesto's 15-hit attack. Modesto starter Tyler Gough (3-2) struck out a career-high nine batters, while allowing two runs in five innings for the win. Rancho starter Cam Day (1-2) allowed six runs (five earned) over 3.1 innings, suffering the loss. Rancho got two doubles and four RBIs from Juan Alonso, as the offense finished with ten hits. 1 VS 2, BUT WITH FLAWS: While they entered this series as the league's two best teams, both division-leaders were struggling coming into this head-to-head series. Modesto had lost a stunning five straight, after winning 25 of their first 33 games this year. Four consecutive Modesto wins over the Quakes this week obviously ended that skid, but extended Rancho's losing streak to a season-high six straight and seven of their last eight overall. Entering Saturday's action, Modesto's offense is tops in the league with a .276 average and a league-high 34 homers, six more than Rancho's

BOBBY MILLER SIGHTING?: Dodgers' right-hander Bobby Miller is scheduled to join the Quakes on Sunday, as they wrap up their six-game set against Modesto. Miller, who threw roughly 50 pitches as part of a simulation game on Tuesday at Dodger Stadium, will be making his first appearance ever in a Rancho uniform. Right shoulder inflammation has sidelined Miller for the last six weeks. Miller is 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA this season across three starts. All Dodger rehabbers are sponsored by Yaamava' Resort and Casino at San Manuel. Tickets are available at requakes.com.

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes made a pair of moves on Tuesday, as RHP Carson Hobbs was added to the club, joining the team from the Arizona Complex League. Hobbs, an 11th-round pick in the 2023 draft out of Samford, was 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA over six scoreless innings. Hobbs takes the spot of Jefferson Valladares, who heads back to the ACL. On Wednesday, RHP Reynaldo Yean was placed on the Injured List with no corresponding move.

PATRICK COPEN: Right-hander Patrick Copen makes his eighth start and ninth appearance of the year, his second against the Nuts. In his only game against Modesto, he allowed four runs on five hits over 3.2 innings in a loss at John Thurman Field on May 2. In his last outing, he allowed three runs on five hits over four innings in a no-decision against Inland Empire on May 19. The Dodgers drafted him in the seventh round of the 2023 draft out of Marshall. WILL SCHOMBERG: Righty Will Schomberg makes his ninth start of the year and second against Rancho. In his lone appearance against the Quakes on May 2, he completely dominated in a win, allowing one walk and striking out ten over six scoreless, hitless innings. In his last outing, he allowed four hits over four scoreless innings in a no-decision against San Jose on May 19.
