SUNDAY'S RECAP

Chesapeake defeated Harrisburg in Sunday's series finale by a final of 6-3. Starting pitcher **Braxton Bragg** struck out eight in six strong innings, allowing just two runs on four hits. Jeremiah Jackson broke the tie in the eighth with a go-ahead RBI single. Adam Retzbach went 3-for-3 with three RBI, including a two-run single in the fourth to open the scoring. Silas Ardoin knocked in a pair with a ninth inning double. Keagan Gillies nailed his sixth save of the year to clinch the victory for Chesapeake.

CREED CRUSHES

C Creed Willems is tied for seventh in the Eastern League in doubles (11) and tied for eighth in extra base hits (18). The Orioles No. 12 prospect is tied for the fourthmost homers in the league in the month of May (4). The 21-year-old is the youngest position player on the Baysox.

ENRIQUE ELECTRIFIES

OF Enrique Bradfield Jr. tallied his fourth-career Double-A game with three or more hits on Friday, and his first such game of the season. In 38 career Double-A contests, the O's No. 3 prospect is batting .295, with a .395 on-base percentage and .805 OPS. The Baysox are 8-2 this season in games started by Bradfield, who missed 32 games earlier this season due to injury.

ACTION JACKSON

Over his last 13 games, IF Jeremiah Jackson is batting .333 with two homers, seven doubles, 10 RBI and a .940 OPS. The first year Baysox shortstop is third in the league in doubles (15). Jackson delivered two go-ahead hits late in Harrisburg last week. The next home run for Jackson will be the 100th of his pro career.

WALK THIS WAY

C Silas Ardoin leads the Eastern League in walks (35). Ardoin drew the most walks in the league in the month of April with 18. Last season, he drew 47 walks in 104 games. OF **Doug Hodo** has drawn the seventh-most walks in the league (24).

JOHNSON AND JOHNSON

RHP **Preston Johnson** is scheduled to make his fifth career start and his first Double-A start tonight for the Baysox. The 25-year-old last started a game on July 3, 2024 while with High-A Aberdeen. In four career starts, Johnson holds a 4.64 ERA in 13.1 innings.

BULLPEN BEASTS

Chesapeake's bullpen holds a 2.88 ERA, which is third-best in Double-A and fifthbest in MiLB. Baysox relievers threw 14 consecutive scoreless innings to open the week in Harrisburg - the most of any Minor League team - and allowed just three runs in 25.2 innings in the series (1.05 ERA) - the best of any Double-A team.

ONE RUN WONDERS

Friday night was Chesapeake's 13th one-run victory of the season - the most of any Minor League team. The Baysox have also played more one-run games (21) this season than any other MiLB side.

PREVIEWING THE PONIES

The Binghamton Rumble Ponies enter this week with a 27-17 record. The Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets are in first place in the Northeast Division and have won eight of their last 10. The Rumble Ponies roster features two active members of the Mets Top 30 prospect list (per MLB.com) - IF Jett Williams (No. 1), RHP Jonah Tong (No. 4), OF Ryan Clifford (No. 5), OF Nick Morabito (No. 17), RHP Jonathan Pintaro (No. 23), and RHP Jack Wenninger (No. 28).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Joshua Cornielly is expected to start for the Rumble Ponies tonight. Cornielly will be making just his eighth career start and his first of the season. The 24-year-old is in his second year with Binghamton after debuting with the Ponies last year. Cornielly was signed by the Mets as an international free agent from Venezuela in 2018.

COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

Roberto Mercado returns for his second season as Baysox Manager in 2025 after completing his first year at the Double-A level last season. The 17th manager in franchise history, he led the Baysox to a 62-75 overall record, oversaw 18 player promotions to Triple-A and coached two former Baysox who would go on to make their Major League debuts in the same season. The New Britain, CT native also managed the Surprise Saguaros of the Arizona Fall League this past offseason, where he led them to a league-best 18-10 record and a Fall League Championship Game appearance.

Before the Baysox, Mercado spent two seasons as manager of the Aberdeen IronBirds - the Orioles' High-A affiliate. Mercado received the Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award in 2022 by the Orioles.

Prior to joining the O's, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut and served as Dean of Students for over 18 years.

JORDIE HENRY

Pitching Coach

Jordie Henry enters his first season as Baysox Pitching Coach in 2025 and his third season as a member of the Orioles' system. Previously, Henry served as the pitching coach at High-A Aberdeen where his staff recorded 1,357 strikeouts last season – 2nd-most in the South Atlantic League and 2nd-most in IronBirds franchise history. Before joining the Orioles, Henry was the Director of Pitching at Prime Sports Performance in Baltimore – a private athletic development training facility. He also worked as a pitching coach and instructor at the high school and summer collegiate levels. Henry pitched collegiately for four seasons at Wayland Baptist University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Josh Bunselmeyer returns for his second season as Baysox Hitting Coach in 2025 and his sixth as a member of the Orioles' system. He joined the Baysox as hitting coach in 2024, after filling the same role for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, in 2023. CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™"- a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.



Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
