#### FROM THE CROWS NEST

Record in 2024. 3-1 LAST TIME OUT: For the second straight night, the Bradenton Marauders toss a shutout in a 4-0 victory over the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels on Friday night

Current Streak. at LECOM Park. Carlson Reed tossed five shutout frames before Peyton Stumbo and Magdiel Cotto hurled two scoreless innings each to complete the shutout. Eddy Rodriguez reached base four times and tallied three hits to lead the offense.

GOING FOR THE WIN: Having won three of the first four games of this week's series against the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels, the Bradenton Marauders have at least captured a split in this six-game series. A win on Saturday would Bradenton's first series victory of the year.

**BLANKED:** For the second straight night, the Bradenton Marauders shutout the Fort Myers Mighty Musels 4-0 on Friday night. The last run allowed by the Marauders pitching staff was in the sixth inning on Wednesday on a solo-home run from Jose Rodriguez. The Marauders currently own a 21.2 innings scoreless streak entering Saturday. The four shutouts are tied for the second-most in the FSL, only trailing the Daytona Tortugas who have five. Bradenton finished with seven shutouts last season, the fourth-most in FSL. The Marauders have now recorded three shutouts over their last seven games, the most in Minor League Baseball.

FINDING THEIR GROOVE: Since April 17, the Bradenton Marauders pitching staff owns the second-best ERA in the Florida State League and Single-A at 2.41, only trailing the Daytona Tortugas who sport a 2.13 ERA. It's also the third-best ERA in all of MiLB during this span, with the Birmingham Barons (CWS. Double-A) who sit second with a 2.35 ERA.

HE GETS ON BASE: INF Garret Forrester's 11 game hit streak came to an end on Friday night. With a hit in nine of the 11 games, Forrester hit .417 (15-for-36) with 4 doubles, a HR, 6 RBIs, 6 walks, and 6 runs. It was the longest active on-base streak for the Marauders with Forrester raising his season batting average from .139 to .261. The former Oregon State Beaver also recorded five multi-hit games in this span with the highlight being a 3-for-3 night at the plate versus Fort Myers on Tuesday night.

**GOT EM!: Peyton Stumbo** picked off Omari Daniel in the seventh inning on Friday night for the Marauders ninth pickoff of the season. As of Saturday, the Marauders are currently tied for first in all of MiLB with the Hudson Valley Renegades (High-A, NYY) and Fredericksburgh Nationals (Single-A, WAS). Bradenton had 23 last season, which ranked the second-most in the FSL and 11th-most in MiLB.

**HEATING UP:** Over the last five games, Esmerlyn Valdez is hitting .389/.450/.611 with four doubles, three RBIs, and one walk while also reaching base in seven straight contests. Valdez leads the Marauders with six doubles on the year and a .271 AVG.

A GOOD DAY ATTHE OFFICE: RHP Tyler Kennedy set a new career-high, striking out six batters in two scoreless innings of relief on Wednesday night against Fort Myers. The six strikeouts were also the most by a Marauders reliever this season until Connor Oliver matched that total the next night on Thursday.

IN HIS GROOVE: With another scoreless outing on Tuesday night, LHP Hunter Furtado has extended his season-long scoreless streak to 5.2 innings. Over his last three outings, the 2023 Sixth-Round pick has struck out seven and walking one while allowing just three hits.

**ROSTER MOVE**: Priot to Tuesday's contest, the Pittsburgh Pirates announced **OF Joshua Palacios** was to begin his Minor League rehab assignment with the Bradenton Marauders. Palacios was acquired in the Minor League Rule 5 Draft by the Pirates in Dec. 2022. He went on to appear in 91 games last year for the Buccos, hitting .239 AVG with 10 HR and 40 RBIs. He was originally drafted by the Toronto Blue Jays in the 4th round of the 2016 MLB Draft. Palacios spent almost the entire season with the Dunedin Blue Jays in 2018 where he was named a Post-Season All-Star. In 125 games, the left-handed hitter slashed .292/.357/.418 with 30 doubles, 8 HR, 78 RBIs while stealing 15 bases.

CLOSE QUARTERS: Saturday night's loss marked their 10th one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own a 3-7 record in those games with 18 of their first 25 (72.0%) games having been decided by three runs or less. In last week's series against Clearwater, all six games were by a total of eight runs. The series featured four-one run contests with another two decided by two runs each.
