YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels were shut out by the Baysox, 3-0. Matthew Etzel gave Bowie a 1-0 lead in the first inning with a groundout. In the bottom of the fifth, Frederick Bencosme hit an RBI single and a double play brought home a run to open a 3-0 lead. The Flying Squirrels had three baserunners in the game, including two singles by **Victor Bericoto** and a single by **Alerick Soularie**. Bowie's Kyle Brnovich pitched five innings and struck out four. Dylan Heid retired all nine batters he faced and struck out three. Dan Hammer pitched a 1-2-3 ninth to end the game. **Dylan Cumming** started and pitched four innings, allowing one run with six strikeouts. **Mat Olsen** threw two scoreless innings. The Baysox stranded at least one baserunner in every inning and went 1-for-10 with runners in scoring position.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles, in the third of a three-game series. In the Flying Squirrels' last trip to Bowie, they won five-of-six games in a series from May 21-26, with the lone loss being a 2-1 defeat on May 23. In that series, they outscored the Baysox, 46-26. This is Richmond's final series in Bowie this year. The Flying Squirrels won four-of-six at The Diamond against the Baysox from April 23-28. The Baysox will return to Richmond this week from Thursday through Saturday for the final meetings between the two teams this season.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 2-6 in their last eight games. They dropped four straight games to open the second half last week after going 7-2 in their previous nine games and 8-4 on their last 12-game road trip to New Hampshire and Portland. For the year, the Flying Squirrels are hitting .220 and averaging 3.8 runs per game (134 runs/35 games) at home compared to a .235 batting average and 4.73 runs per game on the road (194 runs/41 games).

THE BAYSOX went 4-2 last week at Reading to open the Eastern League's second half. In the first half of the season, they went 32-36, finishing in fifth place in the Southwest Division. Bowie is hitting .226 as a team this year, 11th in the league. The Baysox pitching staff has a 3.88 team ERA, fourth-best in the league and has allowed 80 homers, most in the circuit. Bowie's roster includes 10 of Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects, including C Samuel Basallo (No. 2), RHP Seth Johnson (No. 9), OF Dylan Beavers (No. 10), OF Jud Fabian (No. 12), 3B Max Wagner (No. 14), RHP Trace Bright (No. 20), OF John Rhodes (No. 26), RHP Alex Pham (No. 27), SS Frederick Bencosme (No. 28) and RHP Keagan Gillies (No. 29). Baseball America ranks Samuel Basallo as the best power hitter in the Orioles system, Silas Ardoian as the best defensive catcher, Jud Fabian as the best outfield arm and Trace Bright as having the best curveball. MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects list includes nine Bowie players, including Basallo (No. 2), Beavers (No. 7), Johnson (No. 10), Fabian (No. 12), Wagner (No. 14), Bright (No. 16), Rhodes (No. 23), Pham (No. 24) and Bencosme (No. 27).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Seth Lonsway** makes his second Double-A start. In his debut on Friday, he threw six scoreless innings and allowed four hits with five strikeouts against the Patriots at The Diamond. It was the first six-inning scoreless debut for the Flying Squirrels since **Conner Menez** in 2018. Dating back to his final two starts in High-A, it was the third straight outing he pitched six innings. In his final four High-A starts dating back to June 1, Lonsway posted a 2.95 ERA (7 ER/21.1 IP). Lonsway pitched at Ohio State before being selected in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Giants. He was also selected by the Reds in the 2017 MLB Draft out of high school but did not sign. Lonsway spent last season with Eugene and went 2-9 with a 5.87 ERA in 28 outings, including 17 starts. **For more on Lonsway, see page two.**

ZEROING IN: With his debut last Friday, **Seth Lonsway** became the first Flying Squirrels player to throw six scoreless innings in his Double-A debut since **Conner Menez** did it on June 16, 2018 at Harrisburg. The only pitcher in franchise with a longer scoreless Double-A debut was **Tyler Beede** on June 5, 2015 at New Hampshire (7.0 IP). There have been a total of five pitchers in Richmond franchise history to throw six-or-more scoreless innings in their Double-A debuts for the Flying Squirrels, including **Joe Biagini** in 2015 and **Jack Snodgrass**, who threw six innings in a seven-inning no-hitter on April 5, 2013 at The Diamond against New Britain. There have been 13 Double-A debuts go five-or-more scoreless innings in team history. **Clayton Tanner** pitched 5.1 in his 2010 debut. **Justin Fitzgerald** (2011), **Chris Heston** (2012), **Matt Frisbee** (2021), **Kai-Wei Teng** (2022), **Wil Jensen** (2022), **Keaton Winn** (2022) and **Carson Whisenhunt** (2023) each pitched five scoreless in their Double-A debut.

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Seth Johnson makes his 15th start of the season and his fourth against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on Thursday at Reading and threw four scoreless innings. Johnson pitched at The Diamond on April 23 and allowed a season-high five runs (two earned) over 2.1 innings. He pitched in Richmond again on April 28 and surrendered two runs over four innings. On May 23 in Bowie, he faced the Flying Squirrels and allowed one run over five innings with six strikeouts. Against Richmond in his career, Johnson is 0-1 with a 3.97 ERA (5 ER/11.1 IP). Over his last eight starts since May 17, Johnson has posted a 1.53 ERA (5 ER/29.1 IP). Johnson was selected with the 40th pick in the 2019 MLB Draft by the Tampa Bay Rays out of Campbell University. Prior to pitching at Campbell, he was a shortstop at Louisburg College. He was traded to the Orioles on August 1, 2022 as part of a three-team deal that sent Jose Siri to Tampa Bay and Trey Mancini to Houston. Following the trade, he underwent Tommy John surgery and returned to the field late last year. In 2023, he made five starts, including one start with Bowie to close his season, and combined to throw 10.1 innings. Johnson is rated by Baseball America as the No. 9 Orioles prospect and No. 10 by MLB.com.

CARTER'S CRUISING: Dating back to June 13 in 15 games, **Carter Howell** is batting .339 (20-for-59) with three doubles, two triples and 12 RBIs. In that stretch, he has picked up three hits three times. He has two triples in his last six games, including an RBI triple on Thursday night. His four triples are tied for the most in the Eastern League this season. He is also tied for fifth in doubles (16), tied for ninth in hits (68), and 10th in batting average (.282).

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 21 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .360 (32-for-89) with three homers, five doubles, five walks and 14 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland. In his last 31 games since May 22, Bericoto is batting .331 (40-for-121) with six homers, six doubles, 11 walks and 23 RBIs. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in eight-of-13 games dating back to June 15 and is batting .389 (21-for-54) in that stretch.

TO THE MUNGUIA: Since being assigned to Richmond on June 19, **Ismael Munguia** is batting .310 (13-for-42) and has added two stolen bases. He has at least one hit in nine of his 10 games played, including three two-hit games. On Monday, he hit his first Richmond homer of the year, a two-run shot. He played 50 games with Triple-A Sacramento to open the year and batted .250 (36-for-144) in the Pacific Coast League. Munguia played 75 games for the Flying Squirrels last year and hit .282 (83-for-294), which led the team (min. 200 PA).

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked sixth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,862). The next home game on Thursday is sold out.

PROSPECT WATCH: Four of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 10), RHP **Trevor McDonald** (No. 18), RHP **Eric Silva** (No. 20), C **Adrián Sugastey** (No. 23) and RHP **José Cruz** (No. 28). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features five Richmond players, including McDonald (No. 12), Brown (No. 15), OF **Victor Bericoto** (No. 19), Sugastey (No. 23) and OF **Jairo Pomares** (No. 26).

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: This season, 10 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is tied for the second-most in a season in franchise history. Last year also saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster. In 2014, a team-record 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including **Joe Panik**, **Adam Duvall**, **Andrew Susac**, **Matt Duffy**, **Jackson Williams**, **Edwin Escobar**, **Hunter Strickland**, **Chris Dominguez**, **Gary Brown**, **Brett Bochy** and **Chris Heston**. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are **Erik Miller** (2023 Flying Squirrels), **Landen Roupp** (2022-23), **Kai-Wei Teng** (2022-23), **Nick Avila** (2022), **Randy Rodriguez** (2022-23), **Mason Black** (2023), **Gerson Garabito** (2021), **Spencer Bivens** (2023), **Raymond Burgos** (2023) and **Hayden Birdsong** (2023-24). Dating back to 2022, 20-of-the-last-21 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers) being the only exception.

In 2021, the Flying Squirrels beat the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, 2-1. It was their first full-capacity sellout of the year, drawing 9,560 fans, after early season crowd restrictions. Caleb Kilian started and allowed one run over six innings with nine strikeouts. Ronnie Williams threw the final three innings without allowing a run. Jacob Heyward tied the game, 1-1, with a solo homer in the second. Simon Whiteman hit a go-ahead RBI double in the bottom of the seventh.
