LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox clinched a series win on Sunday via a 3-0 shutout over the Binghamton Rumble Ponies. Four Baysox arms combined on the shutout: RHP **Seth Johnson** (3.2 IP), LHP **Ryan Hennen** (2.1 IP), along with RHP **Lincoln Henzman** (1.1 IP), and RHP **Dylan Heid** (1.2 IP), for Bowie's sixth shutout win of the season. 1B **Dylan Beavers** led off the game with a home run, while DH **Samuel Basallo** doubled home a run and C **Silas Ardoin** hit a solo shot.

BASALLO BITS

During his team-high 17-game on-base streak, C/1B **Samuel Basallo** is hitting .375 (3rd EL) with a 1.108 OPS (4th EL). Basallo's five home runs during that stretch are third-most in the league. The 19-year-old is the youngest player in the Eastern League this season. He currently has the fourth-most hits (60) and home runs (10) of all qualified players.

TEENAGE DREAM

With his two-run shot Friday night, **Samuel Basallo** became just the ninth teenager to reach 10 home runs in a season at the Double-A level since the year 2005. Basallo is the first teen in the Eastern League to reach the mark since Vladimir Guerrero Jr did so with the New Hampshire Fisher Cats in 2018. Basallo's 55 games to reach 10 Double-A home runs makes him the third-fastest teenager to do so since 2005. Only Guerrero (44 GP in 2018) and Giancarlo Stanton (41 GP in 2009) reached 10 HR in fewer games.

ON-BASE BEAVERS

OF/1B **Dylan Beavers** has reached base in 41 of 47 games started in his second season with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 7 prospect leads the team in OBP (.364) and leads the team in walks (29), the seventh-most in the Eastern League. On Sunday, Beavers belted the first leadoff home run for the Baysox in 2024 and their first since Jud Fabian against Harrisburg on July 20, 2023.

TERRY TWO BAGS

Baysox RF/1B **TT Bowens** hit his team-leading 15th double of the season on Saturday night - tying him for the third-most in the Eastern League this season. Bowens has been a clutch bat for Bowie, leading the team with 34 RBI and hitting .308 with runners in scoring position - second-best on the team to **Collin Burns** (.316)

BUILT BY THE BULLPEN

Bowie's bullpen leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings pitched (274.2) and strikeouts (319). The Baysox bullpen owns a 1.18 WHIP, which is good for third-lowest in Double-A.

TELL THE WHOLE PHAM

RHP **Alex Pham** has continued to rack up the strikeouts. Pham has matched a Double-A best, with seven strikeouts, in three of his last four starts. Baysox arms lead the league in strikeouts as a staff with 572. Pham has struggled a bit with the long ball this season. Allowing 9 in 45.1 IP after just 5 across 60.2 IP in Double-A last season.

SCOUTING THE SENATORS

Entering this week, the Harrisburg Senators sit at 32-25 on the season - tied for second in the Eastern League Southwest division and just a game out of first place. Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, the Senators are led by second-year manager and former Baysox player (1999) Delino DeShields. Harrisburg's roster includes four of the Nationals' top 8 prospects (per MLB Pipeline) - OF Dylan Crews (WSH No. 2/MLB No. 6), IF Brady House (WSH No. 3/MLB No. 36), IF Yohandy Morales (No. 4 WSH/MLB No. 88), and OF Robert Hassell III (No. 8 WSH).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Michael Cuevas is Tuesday night's projected starter for Harrisburg. Cuevas enters his second season at Double-A, after tossing 97.2 innings at the level last season. Cuevas made four starts against Bowie last season, going 1-1 with a 5.95 ERA in 19.2 innings. 1B/RF **TT Bowens** is hitting .400 (6-for-15) with three doubles in his career of Cuevas. Tuesday night will be Cuevas' 17th start against an O's farmhand in his career. He was drafted in the 23rd round by the Nats in 2019 out of Brennan High School (TX).

2024: Matched season-high with 7 K over 3.1 IP, gave up 4 R (3 ER) on 3 H over 2 BB in a no-decision in most recent start on 6/5 vs BNG. Baysox have won six of last seven games that Pham has started in. Has struck out 5+ batters in seven of 11 starts. Has matched season-high 7 K in three of last four starts. Ended month of May with a 5.64 ERA. Allowed just two runs or less in four of his five starts in May. Looking to go 5.0 IP for first time since 5/7. Collected first Double-A win on 5/7 vs AKR after dealing 5.0 IP with 6 K, matching season-high. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster and was named Opening Night starter. Second season as full-time starter after beginning pro career in bullpen.

2023: Began the season with High-A Aberdeen, going 3-3 with a 2.45 ERA in 12 outings. Won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month award in May, posting a 1.54 ERA and 34 K in 23.1 IP. .163 opposing average was the lowest in the South Atlantic League at the time of his promotion. Five of 10 starts with Aberdeen were 5+ IP with one run or fewer allowed. Promoted to Bowie on 6/2. Began Double-A career with nine scoreless frames across two starts. Surrendered fewer than 3 ER in 11 of his 14 Double-A outings, including six outings of 5 IP or more. Had a 1.80 ERA for Bowie in July. Was named an Orioles' Organizational All-Star in 2023.

2022: Spent the first portion of 2022 on the injured list, being activated by Single-A Delmarva on April 26. Pitched in six games for the Shorebirds, allowing two earned runs through 11.1 innings, before promotion to High-A Aberdeen on May 24. Only allowed a single run through his first three appearances for Aberdeen (8 IP) before allowing six runs across four innings in back-to-back rough outings. Placed on IL for the second time in the season in late June. Spent a brief rehab stint with the FCL Orioles after being activated August 5, before finishing the season with Aberdeen. In total, pitched to a 5.66 ERA with the IronBirds across 20.2 innings in the regular season.

2021: Pitched 6.2 innings for the FCL Orioles in 2021, surrendering six runs before throwing five scoreless innings across three appearances in Delmarva to end the season.

Personal: Pitched for four seasons at the University of San Francisco, finishing seventh in program history with 215 strikeouts and fourth with 11 saves.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles’ Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer’s fifth season in the Orioles’ system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach

Sebbly joins the Baysox staff as the Fundamentals Coach in 2024. Sebbly was the fundamentals coach in Aberdeen last season and was a development coach within the Orioles’ organization in 2022. Sebbly played collegiately as a catcher at Cypress College and Ball State.

BILLY FACTEAU

Development Coach

A familiar face in Bowie, Facticeau rejoins the Baysox staff in 2024. Facticeau was the development coach in Aberdeen last season, but began his professional coaching career as a development coach on the Baysox staff in 2022. Prior to his first stint with Bowie, Facticeau first served in the Orioles’ organization as a technology intern.
