TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field! Your first-place Quakes continue a six-game set against the San Jose Giants (SF) today with game two of the series. Tonight is Bark in the Ballpark, presented by Raising Cane's, as fourlegged friends are welcome with the purchase of a \$3 Pet Pass. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE GIANTS: Today's game is the second of 18 games against the Giants and the second of 12 here at home. The Quakes were 7-5 against the Giants in 2024, 4-2 here at LoanMart Field.

LAST GAME: Samuel Munoz enjoyed a big day at LoanMart Field, as he collected three hits, including the game-winning walk-off RBI single, as the Quakes downed the Giants on Tuesday afternoon by a final of 4-3 in ten innings. Munoz had three singles and two RBIs, capping his day with a lead-off single in the tenth down the right-field line against Giant's reliever Ryan Slater (1-1), scoring Mike Sirota from second base to end the game. The win snaps San Jose's six-game win streak and gives Rancho their second straight victory, keeping them a perfect 4-0 at home. Logan Tabeling (1-0) fired a scoreless tenth to earn the win. Quakes' starter Samuel Sanchez was sharp in the no-decision, allowing one run over 4.2 innings.

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes made a roster move early Tuesday morning, placing Oswaldo Osorio on the Injured List. Taking his place is infielder Eduardo Guerrero, who joined the team from High-A Great Lakes.

STILL WEARING THE SAME SHOE: The Quakes have welcomed back Manager John Shoemaker, who returns to Rancho to guide the Quakes for a fifth straight year, a franchise record. The club is 271-243 in four seasons under "Shoe", having made the playoffs twice, including one appearance in the Championship Series (2023). The Quakes have only one returning coach to this year's club, as pitching coach Ramon Troncoso returns to Rancho, joining Shoemaker for his fifth year as well. New members of the coaching staff include hitting coach Johermyn Chavez, pitching coach Brandon Bailey, Bench Coach Dunior Zerpa, Bullpen Coach and former Quake Marco Hernandez, Athletic Trainer Alfredo Casillas, Performance Coach Jake Taylor and Video Associate Max Delorme.

PROSPECT HEAVY: According to MLB Pipeline's rankings the Dodgers have stocked the Quakes with seven of their top-30 prospects. In order, they are: INF Kellon Lindsey (#8), OF Eduardo Quintero (#9), INF Joendry Vargas (#12), RHP Hyun-Seok Jang (#17), OF Mike Sirota (#21), OF Jaron Elkins and RHP Samuel Sanchez (#28). Of the 29 active players on the Rancho roster, 15 of them saw time in a Quakes' uniform in 2024.

HYUN-SEOK JANG: Right-hander Hyun-Seok Jang makes his third start of the year and his first against San Jose. In his last outing, a loss to Stockton on April 10th, he allowed four runs on just one hit, walking four and hitting a pair of batters over just 2.1 innings. Jang went 1-2 with an 8.14 ERA over 13 games (10 starts) and 24.1 innings pitched in the ACL last year, before finishing the year with five starts in Rancho, where he went 0-1 with a 2.19 ERA over 12 innings pitched. Jang, who signed with the Dodgers in August of 2023 out of South Korea, was regarded as the top pitching prospect coming out of Korea in 2023 and is rated by MLB Pipeline as the Dodgers' 17th best prospect.

NIKO MAZZA: Right-hander Niko Mazza makes his second start of the year and first against the Quakes. In his only start this year, which was also his pro debut, he pitched four scoreless innings in a no-decision against Visalia on April 9th, allowing four hits with one walk, while striking out four. Mazza played college ball at Southern Mississippi and was drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2024 draft.
