The Round Rock Express and Albuquerque Isotopes are set for game two of their six-game series at Dell Diamond tonight. First pitch is slated for 7:15 p.m. CT.

ISOTOPES EARN THE OPENER

Round Rock fell 6-5 to Albuquerque yesterday. The Isotopes loaded the bases in the second with a pair of hits and a walk. SS Drew Romo delivered a single for a 1-0 Albuquerque advantage. The Isotopes added another run in the third. DH Ezequiel Tovar and RF Zac Veen got aboard with singles, then Tovar scored on a LF Sterlin Thompson groundout. Round Rock 3B Josh Jung led off the fourth with a double and DH Rowdy Tellez recorded his first home run for the E-Train to tie the game at two. In the sixth, CF Sean Bouchard gave the Isotopes a lead with a two-run homer. SS Jose Torres drove another run in with his line out, allowing 3B Warming Bernabel to score from third for a 5-2 edge. 1B Blaine Crim brought the E-Train within one with a two-run blast in the bottom of the sixth. LF Kellen Strahm singled to tie the game. Albuquerque broke the tie in the eighth when 3B Warming Bernabel grounded out, sending Thompson home for a 6-5 lead. RHP Nick Anderson struck out the side for the Isotopes in the bottom of the ninth as Albuquerque took the series opener, 6-5.

GRAY SET TO REHAB

Texas Rangers RHP Jon Gray is scheduled to make a rehab start tonight for the Express. He has been out since Spring Training after he sustained a fractured right wrist when he was struck by a line drive. The 33-year-old has spent the last three seasons with Texas while posting a 21-21 record and a 4.16 ERA (179 ER/387.1 IP).

KOHL COMING UP NEXT

After Gray's rehab appearance on Wednesday, left-hander Kohl Drake is expected to take the baseball. Drake was promoted from Double-A Frisco last week and made his Triple-A debut in Sugar Land on July 2. In 12 starts with Double-A Frisco, Drake posted a 2.44 ERA (15 ER/55.1 IP) with 22 walks and 70 strikeouts. The 24-year-old is listed as the Rangers No. 11 prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

CRIM KEEPS GOING

1B Blaine Crim went 1-for-4 with a two-run home run in the series opener. Crim is now in sole possession of fourth place in club history with 238 RBI. He also extended his on-base streak to 23 games which is the fifth-longest active streak in the PCL.

RICHIE ON A ROLL

Round Rock SS Richie Martin went 2-for-4 with a strikeout on Tuesday night. He owns a six-game hitting streak. In his last 22 games, Martin is slashing .343/.463/.463/.926 with a triple, two homers, nine RBI, 19 runs scored, nine walks and 15 strikeouts.

LOOKING TO SNAP THIS

The Express have lost four consecutive games which is their second longest losing streak in 2025. It is their fourth losing streak of three games or more since the start of June. This is only the second one that has gone longer than three games (5, June 14-19). The streak comes after the Express won five of seven to begin the second half.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2025 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's third season with the E-Train. In 2024, Davis secured his 800th win as a manager on July 12 at Reno. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided the E-Train to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 744-665 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
