YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels scored seven unanswered runs to beat the RubberDucks, 8-5, in 10 innings at Canal Park. Down, 4-1, in the sixth, **Brett Auerbach** started the rally with an RBI single. In the seventh, **Ricardo Genoves** hit an RBI double and **Shane Matheny** followed with an RBI single to tie the game, 4-4. In the top of the 10th, Matheny gave Richmond a 5-4 lead with an RBI single. **Tristan Peters** hit a two-run double and **Casey Schmitt** added an RBI single to open an 8-4 lead. Akron scored one run in the bottom of the 10th, but **Clay Helvey** got the final outs to finish the Richmond win. **Kyle Harrison** allowed four runs over 4.2 innings. **Ryan Walker** and **Melvin Adon** combined for 4.1 scoreless innings out of the bullpen.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. The two teams met for 12 games in the first half of the season, with the Flying Squirrels going 7-5 against the RubberDucks. The winning record served as a tiebreaker in the first-half standings, clinching a postseason spot for Richmond. At The Diamond from May 3-8, the Flying Squirrels won the first three games of the series before the RubberDucks won the last three for a split. At Canal Park from May 31-June 5, the Flying Squirrels won four-of-six. The series is the final set between these two teams this year.

TICKET PUNCHED: The Flying Squirrels clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division First-Half title with a win on May 26 paired with a loss by the Akron RubberDucks against the Harrisburg Senators. Richmond finished the first half tied with Akron, but held the tiebreaker with a 7-5 head-to-head record. The league adopted the split-season format in 2019. After playing a full-season system last year, they returned to the split-season format this year. The Flying Squirrels will play in the Eastern League playoffs for the third time in franchise history. In 2011, they swept the Senators in the division series before falling to the Fisher Cats in the ELCS, three games to one. In 2014, they eliminated the RubberDucks in four games before being swept in the championship series by the Binghamton Mets.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 16-29 in the second half. They are 10-21 in the last 31 games, including a season-high six-game losing streak from July 14-23. The Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost eight and split five this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 1,236 strikeouts and rank fourth with 142 homers. The Flying Squirrels are 25-33 on the road this year. Richmond is 24-23 in games decided by two-or-less runs.

THE RUBBERDUCKS are in fourth place in the Southwest Division standings in the second half, five games behind first-place Bowie and Erie. They are 13-6 in their last 19 games since August 6, including winning five-of-seven in last week's series at Erie. The Akron offense has the fewest strikeouts in the Eastern League this season and their pitching staff has recorded the most strikeouts. Akron's roster includes nine of MLB.com's top-30 Cleveland prospects, including RHP Daniel Espino (No. 1 - on IL), RHP Gavin Williams (No. 3), RHP Tanner Bibee (No. 8), INF Angel Martinez (No. 12), INF/OF Jhonkensy Noel (No. 17), INF Jose Tena (No. 18), RHP Tanner Burns (No. 19), LHP Joey Cantillo (No. 25 - on IL) and C Bryan Lavastida (No. 26).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Kai-Wei Teng** makes his league-leading 24th start of the season. He last pitched on Thursday against the Rumble Ponies and allowed five runs on 5.1 inning with seven strikeouts. In his last three starts since August 6, Teng has collected 27 strikeouts in 15.1 innings of work. This year, Teng is second in the Eastern League with 130 strikeouts, which is the third-most in Double-A. Since the start of the 2021 season, Teng is ranked 10th among all MiLB pitchers with 272 strikeouts. Teng spent the entire 2021 season with the High-A Eugene Emeralds, going 5-6 with a 4.33 ERA in 21 starts. For the season, Teng led the High-A West with 142 strikeouts, ranked tied for second with 21 games started, tied for first with one complete game and sixth with 95.2 innings pitched. He also ranked fourth in the Giants system in strikeouts. Teng was originally signed by the Minnesota Twins out of Taiwan in 2017. During his second season in 2018, he was traded to the Giants along with outfielder Jaylin Davis in exchange for right-handed pitcher Sam Dyson. **For more on Teng, see page two.**

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,224) and total attendance (336,084). Richmond is 14th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night and again on July 4 are the largest crowds in all of Double-A this year.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 142 home runs this season, which is fourth in the Eastern League. On August 7 in the 101st game of the season, **Riley Mahan** hit a grand slam to give the Flying Squirrels their 128th homer of the season, breaking the previous franchise record. Last year, the Flying Squirrels broke the team record for homers with 127 in just 113 games, passing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 172 home runs. **Sean Roby** is tied for third in the league with 23 homers on the season, with 19 coming at The Diamond.

RELYING ON THE LONGBALL: On the year, the Flying Squirrels have scored 245-of-their-245 runs on homers. At 45.54 percent, they have the second-highest total of their runs scored on the year on homers, trailing Somerset (48.97 percent, 286-of-584 runs). The RubberDucks have scored the lowest percentage of their runs on homers (17.4-of-538 runs, 32.34 percent). **Will Wilson** has picked up 94.4 percent (17-of-18) of his Double-A RBIs on home runs this year. **Sean Roby** has driven in 66.0 percent (33-of-50) and **Tyler Fitzgerald** has 61.1 percent (33-of-54) of their RBIs on home runs.

CASEY AT THE BAT: Infielder **Casey Schmitt** was promoted to Double-A Richmond on August 9. After going 0-for-3 in his Double-A debut on August 10, Schmitt has hit .381 (16-for-42) with four doubles, a triple and four RBIs in his last 10 games since August 11. On Friday night, he tied a career high with four hits against the Rumble Ponies and collected two more hits on Saturday night.

SMITH STREAKING: **Armani Smith** is currently riding an 18-game on-base streak since July 29, which is the fourth-longest active streak in the Eastern League. It is also the second-longest on-base streak for a Richmond player this year, trailing a 24-game streak by **Shane Matheny** in May and June. During the streak, Smith is batting .290 (20-for-69) with three doubles, a homer, six RBIs and 11 walks. He posted a 12-game hitting streak from August 4-18, which was the longest active streak in the league at the time, but it was snapped with an 0-for-3 game with two walks on Friday night. He hit .313 (21-for-67) in his first 18 Double-A games from May 15-June 16 before batting .168 (17-for-101) in his next 29 games through August 2.

MARTY PARTY: **Brandon Martorano** homered in back-to-back games on Thursday and Friday, slugging a solo shot on Thursday night against Binghamton before adding a two-run homer on Friday night. He now has 10 homers this season, including three in his last eight starts since August 6. In his last 14 games since July 28, Martorano is batting .286 (14-for-49) with three homers, three doubles and 10 RBIs.

FITZ ON FIRE: Over his last 31 games since July 10, **Tyler Fitzgerald** has homered 11 times. He now has 21 homers this season, which ranks as the second-most in a season in franchise history, one homer ahead of **David Villar's** previous franchise record of 20 set last year and trailing 23 by **Sean Roby** this year. Over his last 21 games since July 28, Fitzgerald is batting .346 (28-for-81) with six homers, five doubles and 19 RBIs, which has raised his season batting average from .194 to .227. On Saturday night, Fitzgerald hit a solo homer in the first inning and added an inside-the-park homer in the seventh. Fitzgerald is the third player in franchise history to hit an inside-the-park homer, joining **Brandon Crawford** (2010) and **Tyler Graham** (2014). He was named Eastern League Player of the Week on Monday for his performance last week against the Rumble Ponies.

ROBUST: **Sean Roby** hit his 21st homer of the year on July 4 against the Fightin' Phils, moving him ahead of **David Villar** for the most home runs in a season in Flying Squirrels franchise history. He added his 22nd homer on July 7 and his 23rd on July 9. Roby is tied for third in the EL in homers. He has hit 19 homers at The Diamond this season, which is a new record for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history, ahead of 10 by **Adam Duvall** in 2013. It is also a new franchise record for the most career homers at The Diamond. He has also set the franchise record for the most multi-homer games in a season and a career with four.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Frankie Tostado** is ranked second in batting average (.284). **Sean Roby** is tied for third in homers (23). **Mike Gigliotti** is 10th in on-base percentage (.366), tied for ninth in walks (51) and sixth in stolen bases (24). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is eighth in homers (21) and is tied for eighth in runs scored (61).

WHERE THE RUBBERDUCKS RANK: In the Eastern League, **Micha Pries** is tied for eighth in RBIs (66), fourth in SLG (.499), fifth in OPS (.844), tied for sixth in doubles (24), tied for fourth in triples (5), fourth in extra-base hits (46) and sixth in total bases (182). **George Valera** is eighth in OBP (.367), eighth in OPS (.837), eighth in walks (52) and fifth in runs scored (64). **Jose Tena** is tied for third in hits (111) and tied for fourth in triples (5). **Brayan Rocchio** is eighth in runs scored (62).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have five players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Casey Schmitt** (2), **Ryan Murphy** (15), **Will Wilson** (22) and **Ricardo Genoves** (30). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." **Harrison** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. **Schmitt** is listed as the "Best Defensive Infielder" and "Best Infield Arm." MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes **Harrison** (2), **Schmitt** (6), **Murphy** (15), **Tristan Peters** (21), **Will Wilson** (26) and **Landen Roupp** (28). **Harrison** is *Baseball America's* No. 20 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 22 overall prospect.

ROAD TO THE SHOW: Two former members of the Flying Squirrels have debuted in the majors this week, both with the Philadelphia Phillies. On Sunday, pitcher **Tyler Cyr** made his debut. He pitched for the Flying Squirrels for three seasons from 2017-2019. On Tuesday night, pitcher **Michael Plassmeyer** worked a scoreless outing for the Phillies in his MLB debut. **Plassmeyer** was a starting pitcher for the Flying Squirrels in 2021. There are now 83 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors.
