Last Night: **Dragons 6, Locos 3.** Dayton received home runs from **Jay Allen II**, **Logan Tanner** and **Hector Rodriguez**, and then held on tight as **Bryce Hubbard** struck out **Colby Halter**, **Brayan Buelvas** and **Henry Bolte** in the bottom of the ninth inning with each representing the potential game-tying run.

LUG•NOTES

Streaking: 1B **Will Simpson**, who had the day off yesterday, has reached base in each of his first 14 games this season. Simpson leads the Midwest League in walks (17) and tops the Lugnuts in hits (14), RBIs (13, tied for 3rd in the MWL), OBP (.508, 2nd in the MWL), slugging (.535) and OPS (1.043, 5th). **Jonny Butler** has reached base in 10 consecutive games.

Heating Up: INF/OF **Danny Bautista Jr.** followed up a 5-for-5 showing on Sunday at Lake County by going 2-for-3 with a single, triple and walk yesterday. He has reached base in eight of his last nine plate appearances and nine of his last 11, raising his batting average from .160 to .333 (11 hits in 33 at-bats).

League Leaderboard: The Nuts lead the East Division in runs scored (77) and rank 2nd overall in the 12-team Midwest League in team walks (80), thanks to six more drawn yesterday – three from **Colby Halter**, whose 15 walks ranks 2nd in the league behind teammate **Simpson**. **Brayan Buelvas** is tied for 2nd in runs scored (15) and tied for 5th in stolen bases (6); relievers **Garrett Irvin** and **Dylan Hall** are in a nine-way tie for 1st in appearances (6).

Leaving the Yard: The Lugnuts won four of six games at Lake County in large part due to their power, slugging eight home runs in the six-game series against the Captains. However, with last night's three-HR output from Dayton, Nuts pitchers have also allowed the most home runs in the league (20).

Action on the Bases: In their four meetings, Lansing (9-for-13) and Dayton (7-for-8) have already combined to swipe 16 bases.

A Grand Start: On April 3, first baseman **Will Simpson** crushed a grand slam (as well as a solo shot) in an 18-0 victory over Michigan State in the Crosstown Showdown. Ten days later, Simpson launched a grand slam off the Great Lakes Loons in an 8-5 loss.

EMU to The Show: The Lugnuts' first debuting Major Leaguer this year is 2021 super utilityman **Max Schuemann**, who made his Major League debut on April 12 as a pinch-runner for the Oakland Athletics, scoring the game-winning run in the bottom of the 10th, and followed up on April 20 with a solo home run for his first MLB hit (in a 6-3 A's loss at Cleveland).

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster includes two MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 12) and first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 30). Bolte, the A's No. 2 outfield prospect, was selected 56th overall in 2022 from Palo Alto High School, where he led all California high schoolers with 13 home runs. He spent the 2023 season with Single-A Stockton, where he slashed .257/.356/.421 in 112 games, collecting 17 doubles, five triples, 14 home runs and 32 stolen bases. Simpson, the A's No. 2 first base prospect, impressed with a .319/.367/.543 line in his professional debut after he was drafted in the 15th round from Washington last year.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2010: Ride the rollercoaster: The Lugnuts scored three runs in the bottom of the 8th to take an 8-6 lead over Dayton, watched the Dragons tie the score against Brian Slover in the 9th, and then walked off in the 10th on an Oliver Dominguez one-out RBI double, 9-8. It was all part of a three-game home sweep of Dayton, turning the tables after the Dragons swept the Lugnuts in three games at Fifth Third Field to start the year.

2012: The Chiefs scored six runs in the bottom of the ninth, capped by a Paul Hoilman grand slam, to beat Ajay Meyer and the Lugnuts, 6-2. Starter Aaron Sanchez struck out seven batters in three scoreless innings in a no-decision.

2017: Edward Olivares hit for the cycle, finishing with a two-run triple in the eighth, and the Lugnuts beat the South Bend Cubs, 11-5, at Cooley Law School Stadium. It was the first cycle for a Nut since 2010 (Brad Glenn) and the third consecutive game that the Nuts had scored at least 11 runs.

In a Nutshell: Opens the season in a tandem with Jose Dicochea, relieving Dicochea the second day of the season, April 6 at Dayton, before receiving his first start of the year, April 13 vs. Great Lakes... in last appearance, fired three hitless innings against the Lake County Captains on April 18... family is in town from Venezuela for this homestand.

Round 2 vs. Dayton: In 2024 debut, entered in the 6th inning, walked Hector Rodriguez, retired Victor Acosta on a flyout, allowed a bunt single to Jay Allen II, walked Cade Hunter, allowed a sacrifice fly to Ruben Ibarra, and struck out Leo Balcazar to end the inning... returned in the 7th and set down Ethan O'Donnell on a foulout and Sal Stewart on a swinging strikeout before departing... Dayton scored two in the 8th against Garrett Irvin en route to an 8-5 victory.

Home Cooking: Born in Barquisimeto in the state of Lara, where former Lugnut and current Diamond-backs catcher Gabby Moreno was also born... cousin is Carlos "Cookie" Carrasco, in his 15th year in the Major Leagues and a current member of the Cleveland Guardians rotation; Carlos Carrasco led the Majors in victories (18) in 2017 and finished 4th in A.L. Cy Young voting.

Minor League Path: Signed at age 16 by Ruben Barradas in 2018... debuted on June 19, 2019, in the Arizona League... following the canceled season of 2020, split 2021 between the Arizona Complex League and the California League, working out of the Stockton bullpen... repeated in the AzCL and Cal League in 2022... spent all of 2023 pitching for Stockton... tossed six innings for the Ports on four different occasions, finishing the season with six shutout five-hit innings on September 7 at San Jose, with no walks and nine strikeouts... posted 6.57 home ERA in Stockton, 3.12 ERA on the road.

Home Cooking: Also from Tucson: Alex Verdugo, four-time All-Star Ian Kinsler, two-time All-Star J.J. Hardy, Cardinals All-Star catcher Tom Pagnozzi and Ron Hassey... in all, Tucson ranks second behind Phoenix in producing Major Leaguers from the Grand Canyon State.

Glory Days: Boasting a 96 mph fastball, Dicochea was highly regarded coming out of Sahuarita High School, ranked the No. 1 prep prospect in Arizona by Baseball America entering the 2019 draft... twirled a no-hitter in the state semifinals... signed for \$400,000... signing scout: Scott Cousins... signed away from commitment to University of Arizona... senior year stats: 1.30 ERA, 54 IP, 24 H, 10 ER, 11 BB, 86 K... in addition to pitching, also starred at shortstop.

Minor League Path: Dicochea opened his professional career in the 2019 Arizona League after signing, but his 2021 campaign was halted in Single-A Stockton due to injury on June 6 after only six appearances, five starts... returned from Tommy John surgery on August 12, 2022, and made two appearances in the Arizona Complex League before returning to Stockton on August 26, 2022... finished the year with three appearances for the Ports.

Bagels in April: Opened 2023 as the Ports' No. 4 starter, firing four scoreless innings at Fresno on April 11... that was the start of three consecutive scoreless outings to begin the year, finishing April with 13 2/3 scoreless innings... didn't allow first run until May 3 vs. Fresno, entering in relief in the fifth inning and allowing two runs in the fifth and two more in the seventh in a 5-4 Ports win... in total with Stockton, posted a 2.42 ERA with a .132 average against in five road starts (22 1/3 IP) compared to 4.24 ERA, .200 avg. in four home appearances (17 IP)... lefties hit .111/.243/.175 compared to righties' .205/.279/.308... base stealers went 2-for-2.

Rave Reviews: Dicochea was promoted from Single-A Stockton to Lansing on June 13, 2023, to replace Jack Perkins, who was transferred up to Double-A Midland... coincidentally, an article about Dicochea had just been written by MLB.com A's beat writer Martín Gallegos a day earlier, quoting A's GM David Forst in including Dicochea's name among the top pitching prospects in the system (Royber Salinas, Gunnar Hoglund, J.T. Ginn and Joey Estes). Wrote Gallegos about Dicochea, "Dicochea, an eighth-round selection by the A's in the 2019 MLB Draft out of Sahuarita (Ariz.) High School, ranks just outside Oakland's Top 30 Prospects list. But his inclusion in that group from Forst speaks volumes about how highly he is viewed. In nine games (seven starts) for Single-A Stockton this season, Dicochea holds a 3.20 ERA with 47 strikeouts against 17 walks in 39 1/3 innings. He has held opposing batters to a .163 average, which ranks lowest among all California League pitchers with at least 30 innings pitched. Dicochea's development hit a snag early in his pro career after he underwent Tommy John surgery in 2021. Since his return from injury, the 22-year-old right-hander is taking a big step forward this season, showing off a fastball that consistently hits 95 mph along with a solid slider and a changeup he's recently added to his mix. A's assistant general manager and director of player personnel Billy Owens added, "He's off to a promising start. Averaging well over a strikeout per inning. Overall, his command has taken a step forward. He's definitely an interesting arm on the horizon."
