Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland A's, play the third game of a season-ending six-game series against the Lake County Captains, the High-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, the 224th all-time meeting between the two teams. The Lugnuts are 8-12 vs. the Captains this season, losing four of five games in Eastlake in April before winning four of seven games in Lansing in May, splitting a six-game series in July, and dropping the first two games of the current series.

Yesterday: Captains 13, Lugnuts 1 (8 innings). Lake County scored 10 runs in the first three innings, the top three Caps batters each collected three hits, and torrential rain ended things early in a Lake County Wednesday matinee rout on Senior Day.

Starting Matchup: 22-year-old right-hander **Jacob Watters**, the Athletics' 4th-round selection in 2022 and top pitcher drafted, makes his team-leading 21st start of the year, opposite Captains right-hander **Ethan Hankins**, the 35th overall pick in the 2018 draft. Watters has struck out 15 batters combined in his last two starts, firing 4 2/3 one-hit scoreless innings with seven strikeouts vs. West Michigan last time out.

Lug•Notes

Sizzling at the Plate: SS Euribiel Ángeles and 1B Brennan Milone both have 11 hits in their last 23 at-bats. Ángeles has raised his average from .257 to .270 in five games while Milone has raised his average from .213 to .250 in six games.

Transaction: INF Casey Yamauchi flew in to join the Lugnuts yesterday from Double-A Midland. Signed as an undrafted free agent following five years at Hawai'i Hilo, where he set the career program records for runs scored, base hits, doubles and stolen bases, Yamauchi played three games in the Arizona Complex League and 11 games in the Texas League. Yamauchi is the 26th different position player used and the 52nd different player overall for the Nuts this season.

Among the League Leaders, Individual: The promoted Daniel Susac leads the Midwest League in qualified batting average with a .303 average and is 9th in OBP (.373) and 9th in OPS (.810). Danny Bautista, Jr. is 3rd in base hits (114) and 10th in batting average (.271). Junior Pérez is tied for 3rd in stolen bases (41), tied for 6th in doubles (26), 9th in total bases (168) and 10th in extra-base hits (40).

Among the League Leaders, Team: The Nuts' offense is 3rd in the MWL in team batting average (.251), 2nd in fewest strikeouts (1036), 2nd in stolen bases (185), tied for 2nd in sacrifices (15), tied for 3rd in sacrifice flies (46), 3rd in base hits (1047), 3rd in doubles (211) and 4th in triples (30). The Nuts' pitchers are 1st in GO/AO ratio (1.00) and GiDP (95) and 3rd in saves (37). Lansing also leads the league with 113 double plays turned, seven more than second-place Peoria.

Reunion in Oak Town: In yesterday's 5-2 Athletics victory over the Blue Jays, consider the contributions made by Lugnuts alumni. Carlos Pérez (2011-12) hit a two-run blast and Kevin Smith (2018) knocked a three-run homer to supply the entirety of Oakland's runs. Mason Miller (2022) fired two perfect innings with three strikeouts, fanning pinch-hitter Alejandro Kirk (2019), before yielding to Dany Jiménez (2018) for the eighth inning, in which Davis Schneider (2017 Crosstown Showdown) swatted a solo home run. Ryan Noda (2018) went 0-for-4 with a run scored for the A's in the win, while Cavan Biggio (2016) went 2-for-4 with a run scored in the losing cause.

Keeping it Close: Of the Lugs' 126 games played this year: 45 have been one-run games, 34 have been two-run games, 16 have been three-run games, nine have been four-run games, and 23 have been games decided by five or more runs. Yesterday was the first game since August 13 that the Lugnuts had lost by more than three runs. 30 of the Lugnuts' 34 losses this half have been decided by three runs or fewer.

Consistent Faces: Lansing has used the same outfield of LF Danny Bautista, Jr., CF Junior Pérez and RF Colby Thomas for 15 straight games, every game since August 20th, since Clark Elliott was placed on the Injured List. Bautista, Jr. has played in 60 of the last 61 Lugnuts games dating back to June 24, while Pérez has played in 56 of the last 57 games and Thomas has played in 50 consecutive games since joining the Nuts on July 7.

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster has two current first-rounders: shortstop Jacob Wilson, the sixth overall pick this year from Grand Canyon University, and the Blue Jays' 2021 first-round selection, 19th overall, Gunnar Hoglund, acquired via trade in March 2022 for Matt Chapman. The A's 2021 first-round selection, shortstop Max Muncy, and 2022 first-round selection, catcher Daniel Susac, are both currently excelling with the Double-A Midland RockHounds in the Texas League.

In a Nutshell: Added to Lansing roster from Stockton on August 15, 2023, to replace the promoted Brady Basso... had previously been a member of the Lugnuts from April 14-May 10, 2022 before getting transferred to Stockton for the rest of the season.

Strong First Impression: Pitched in piggyback relief on August 17 vs. Great Lakes, following Jacob Watters (2 2/3) and John Beller (1 1/3)... fired five scoreless innings, whiffing six... struck out first two batters faced in a perfect 5th... pitched around a one-out Griffin Lockwood-Powell single in the 6th... allowed a one-out Kenneth Betancourt single but erased it with a Chris Alleyne double-play ball in the 7th... walked two batters but stranded them in the 8th... gave up a one-out Luis Guerra single in the 9th but induced second double-play ball to finish fifth scoreless frame... 65 pitches, 40 strikes.

Second Time Out: Pitching at Dayton on August 24, James struck out the side around a walk in the 1st inning, struck out the side again in the 2nd inning around a Hector Rodriguez double, worked a perfect 3rd inning, stranded a two-out walk and single in the 4th inning, and allowed a run on a leadoff double and a sacrifice fly in the 5th inning... 81 pitches, 52 strikeouts... Lugnuts went on to win, 3-2.

Path to Lansing: After signing as a free agent at age 18 in 2019, James jumped from the Dominican Summer League that initial professional season to the Arizona Complex League and the Low-A West in 2021, then joined the Lugnuts out of Extended Spring Training last season before finding a regular role in the Ports' rotation... this season, he ranked second in the California League in strikeouts (108) and seventh in innings pitched (87 1/3), recording four quality starts as the ace of the Stockton starting rotation.

Changing Things Up: Fellow Lugnuts pitcher Stevie Emanuels credits James for teaching him his current change-up grip last year while with Stockton... James's sinking change-up is considered his best pitch.

Los Canaleros: Joins Joshwan Wright (Injured List) as native Panamanians on the Lugnuts' roster... both were on Team Panama's World Baseball Class team this year... made one appearance, allowing three hits and two runs without recording an out.

Good Company: The best players from Panama in baseball history: Mariano Rivera, Rod Carew, Carlos Lee, Bruce Chen, Juan Berenguer.
