JOHNSON'S GRAND SLAM PUSHES RIDERS OVER HOOKS:
The Frisco RoughRiders defeated the Corpus Christi Hooks 9-4 on Thursday evening from Riders Field. Tied at 4-4 in the bottom of the sixth inning, Cooper Johnson smacked the first grand slam of the season for Frisco (2-1, 46-26) to give the Riders the lead for good. Corpus Christi (1-2, 27-45) opened the scoring against Frisco starter Nick Krauth (6-3) in the top of the third on a two-run homer by Zach Cole, scoring Miguel Palma. The RoughRiders responded in the bottom of the fourth frame, using back-to-back doubles by Liam Hicks and Cody Freeman to chop the Corpus Christi lead to 2-1. Freeman later scored on a sacrifice fly by Abimelec Ortiz, tying the game. Tommy Sacco Jr. gave the Hooks a 3-2 lead with an RBI double that brought home Kenedy Corona in the visiting half of the fifth. Frisco answered with a run of their own when Hicks brought **Kellen Strahm** across the plate with a single to tie the game. Corpus took the lead back on Pascanel Ferraras' RBI groundout that scored Jordan Brewer, giving the Hooks the upper hand by a 4-3 score in the sixth. The RoughRiders loaded the bases in the bottom of the frame, tying the game on an RBI single to right field by **Geisel Cepeda**. Johnson then swatted a grand slam, giving the Riders their first lead of the evening at 8-4. **Reid Birlingmair** tossed a 1-2-3 seventh inning with a strikeout before handing the ball to **Ricky DeVito** worked a pair of scoreless frames with a pair of punchouts. Frisco added a run of insurance in the bottom of the eighth when Strahm delivered his fourth homer of the season, a solo shot to left center. Offensively, the RoughRiders notched 12 hits as each of the first three hitters in the lineup logged multi-hit performances. Strahm, Hicks, Josh Hatcher and Keyber Rodriguez each claimed two hits.

For the first time this season, the Riders have had three-consectutive starts of six innings (Josh Stephan, Ryan Garcia and Nick Krauth) to start the series. Their starting pitchers this year have an ERA of 3.97, which is fourth-best in the Texas League and they have 24 wins, which is second in the league (averaging 5.0 IP/GS). Last season, Frisco finished last in the league with a 5.63 starter ERA and last with 18 pitcher wins (4.0 IP/GS).

Tuesday marked the first day of the second half. After a Midland loss on last Sunday, the RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

## **GRAND OPENING:**

On Thursday, **Cooper Johnson** clubbed the first grand slam home run of his career and the first for the RoughRiders this year. Last season, Frisco hit a franchise record nine grand slams. Corpus Christi is now the only team in the Texas League without a grand slam.

## **DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:**

The Riders have the fewest errors in all of Minor League Baseball (40) while also ranking second in fielding percentage (.984) in the minors. Frisco's 68 double plays are second among non-Triple-A teams. Frisco have allowed the third-fewest stolen bases in MiLB (50), throwing out 27 percent of total base runners against them.

## THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen has been the best in the Texas League this season, owning a 2.88 ERA, which is also the third-best in all of Minor League Baseball. The Riders' pen allowed three runs on Friday, which was more than their previous 12 games, owning a 0.41 ERA (2 ER/43.2IP) over that span. In their last five series, spanning 28 games, Frisco's bullpen has a 1.63 ERA (18ER/99.2IP). In June, **Steven** Jennings has been fantastic, not allowing a run over his eight outings, throwing 16.1 innings.

In their last 19 games, the Riders have allowed just 41 earned runs over 166.0 IP (2.22 ERA). Frisco has the best ERA in all of Minor League Baseball during the month of June, at 2.66 through the first 23 games. Having won 21 of their last 30 games since May 25th, the Riders have the best ERA in Minor League Baseball (2.47) during that stretch while also being tied for third in saves (9) and tied for first in wins (21) since May 25th. The team with the second-best ERA in that stretch (Palm Beach) has a 2.95 ERA. In those last 30 games, the Riders have allowed more than three runs in a game just nine times and six times in the last 18 games. Their Tuesday and Thursday 2-1 losses last week marked their first two losses when allowing three runs or fewer, dropping them to 36-2 in those games.

## HICKS IS THE DICK.

Liam Hicks has been on fire at the plate for the Riders over his last 35 games, batting .331 (39-for-118)/.442/.466/.908 with seven doubles, three home runs, 18 RBIs, 19 walks, 15 strikeouts and 22 runs. In his last 19 games, he is hitting .343 (22-for-67)/.458/.552/1.010. Two Fridays ago in Corpus Christi, Hicks collected two home runs for his first multi-home run game of his Minor League career.
