TODAY'S GAME: The Curve wrap up a three-game set with the Harrisburg Senators, Altoona is 9-8 against Harrisburg this year.

LAST TIME OUT: Altoona dropped a pitcher's duel, 2-1, dropping their second straight game in the series at Harrisburg. The Curve managed

WE'RE ON TOP: With three series victories over Harrisburg, Akron and Richmond to begin the second half, Altoona begins their post-All-Star Game road trip with the best record in the Southwest Division. Altoona has won three straight six-game series for the first time since this schedule format began in 2021.

ALL IT TAKES IS ONE: Altoona picked up a 1-0 walk-off win on Saturday, July 16 by Connor Scott. It was just the 8th time in franchise history that Altoona has won a game on a walk-off, 1-0, though it was the first time that the Curve won on a sacrifice fly in a 1-0 win. Altoona last won 1-0 on a walk-off from Tyler Gaffney on 6/7/2018 against Reading. Saturday also marked the 8th time in franchise history that the Curve won

AARON SHACKELGOAT: Curve INF Aaron Shackelford picked up his second multi-homer game of the season on Friday, July 15 against Richmond. Shackelford hit the second of back-to-back homers with **Blake Sabol** in the first inning and added another solo homer in the third inning. The Curve previously got a multi-homer game from Shackelford on June 17 against Erie and he hit the first of back-to-back home runs on May 22 against Richmond with Andres Alvarez. In the second half (6/28 - Present), Shackelford is batting .328/.401/.627 with 8 2B, 4 HR, 8 RBI and 2-2 SB.

In the second half, Shackelford ranks all over the league leaderboards: 10th in BA (.328), 5th in SLG% (.627), 7th in OPS (1.027), T-9th in H (22), and T-3rd in XBH (12).

IMMACULATE ON A FRIDAY: Righty Luis Ortiz fired the third immaculate inning in franchise history on Friday, July 15 in Altoona's 4-2 win over Richmond. Previously, LHP Oddy Nunez (9/4/21 at Akron) and RHP Jeff Bennett (6/7/03 vs Harrisburg) had thrown an immaculate inning for the Curve.

HOT CURVE SUMMER: Altoona has three of the Eastern League's top hitters in the month of July. Matt Fraizer is batting .295/.358/.459 with 2 2B, 2 3B, 7 RBI and 6-6 SB, Jared Triolo is batting .297/.387/.391 with 1 2B, 1 3B, 1 HR, 8 RBI, 8 BB and 5-6 SB, Fabricio Macias is batting .340/.333/.460 with 6 2B, 12 RBI and 2-3 SB and Aaron Shackelford is batting .333/.408/.651 with 8 2B, 4 HR, 8 RBI and 2-2 SB.

A TREE-IDENTIFICATION WALK: After drawing just 19 walks in 42 games across April and May, INF Jared Triolo drew 20 walks in 25 games in June. Over his last 25 games (6/21 - Present), Triolo has a .404 on-base percentage.

THE FUTURE: Former Curve RHP Mike Burrows made an appearance in the SiriusXM Futures Game on Saturday night at Dodger Stadium in . Los Angeles. Burrows threw a scoreless 5th inning allowing 1 hit and 1 walk, he also struck out

NO LEAD IS SAFE: Altoona has held a lead after 5 innings in 44 of 89 games played this season and hold a 32-11 record in those games. Since May 17, the Curve are 21-2 when they hold a lead after 5 innings.

TROUBLE WITH THE LONG BALL: Altoona pitchers have surrendered 90 home runs on the season, tied for 14th-most by a pitching staff in Double-A and sixth-most in the Eastern League behind Hartford (123). The Curve have allowed a home run in 54 of 89 games

THE 6-YEAR REPRESENTATIVES: Managed by Tripp Keister, Harrisburg features several Eastern League veterans including: RHP Ronald Herrera (Trenton), Dakody Clemmer (Akron), Edgar Garcia (Reading), Brian Gonzalez (Bowie and Hartford) and Wilson Garcia (Akron). Additionally, they have former Pirates legend, John Nogowski. Harrisburg is coming off a series at Hartford in which they dropped 4-of-6.

THE FIRST TO FILIBUSTER: Jake Irvin takes the ball for the Harrisburg in the series finale. Irvin was drafted in the 4th round in 2018 out of the University of Oklahoma, as a high schooler he was a Minnesota Mr. Baseball finalist. Irvin missed the 2021 season after undergoing Tommy John surgery in October of 2020. He's 0-2 with a 4.91 ERA (8 ER / 14.2 IP) in three starts with Harrisburg this year. One of his catchers in college at Oklahoma was Brady Lindsly who was picked in the 4th round by the Nationals in 2020, he also briefly shared a pitching staff with Cade Cavalli who is one of the Nationals top pitching prospects and was drafted in the 1st round in 2020 out of Oklahoma.

#### **CAREER NOTES**

2022: Was a non-roster invitee to Pirates Spring Training... Ranked by Baseball America as the No. 22 right-handed pitching prospect in all of minor league baseball entering the season... Suffered an oblique injury at the end of spring training and missed all of April and May before returning for a rehab assignment beginning on Thursday, June 9 with Bradenton vs. Clearwater in which the Marauders threw a combined no-hitter (Priester 3.0 IP, Anthony Solometo 4.0 IP, Jake Sullivan 1.0 IP, Yunior Thaibo 1.0 IP), game was caught by rehabbing Curve C Henry Davis... Bradenton's no-hitter was the first he's ever been part of in his life... Completed his rehab assignment on 6/14 with Greensboro: allowed five runs on six hits in 2.2 innings...

2021: Entered the season ranked by Baseball America and MLB Pipeline as the fourth-best prospect in the Pirates system...Was also ranked by Baseball America as the No. 58 prospect in all of baseball and the No. 17 right-handed pitching prospect... Was listed as having the "Best Curveball" in the Pirates minor league system by Baseball America entering the 2021 campaign... Was a non-roster invitee to Pirates Spring Training where he made two appearances and allowed one earned run in 1.1 innings pitched... Spent the entire season in Greensboro's rotation, went 7-4 with a 3.04 ERA was the second-best mark among Pirates minor leaguers (minimum 90.0 IP) behind Bradenton's Adrian Florencio (2.46)... Picked up his first two wins of the season in back-to-back starts on May 18 and May 25 by throwing 5.0 scoreless innings... Completed 5.0 innings in each of his four starts in the month of July, going 1-0 with a 2.63 ERA (7 ER / 24.0 IP)... Was selected to appear in the Sirius/XM Futures Game at Coors Field, worked 0.2 of an inning and struck out one batter... Finished a career-best 7.0 innings for the second time on August 13 against Winston-Salem, struck out a career-high 10 and did not allow a run... Was named the High-A East Pitcher of the Week for the week ending August 29 after he delivered 6.0 scoreless innings on August 27 and allowed just one hit and no walks, struck out a career-best 13 - began the game with nine consecutive strikeouts and 11-of the first 12 batters he faced, combined with Colin Selby on a one-hitter... CURVE CUTS: Charles Quinn Priester... Was committed to play collegiately at Texas Christian University before his selection in the 2019 draft... Signed for a bonus of \$3,400,000 by Pirates scout Anthony Wycklendt... Is a 2019 graduate of Cary-Grove (IL) High School, where he posted an 8-2 record and 1.00 ERA as a senior... Was named the 2018-19 Gatorade Illinois Player-of-the-Year...
