ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Brooklyn toppled Hudson Valley 7-5 last night, holding on in the ninth inning to tie the series at one game apiece. The Cyclones held a 7-1 advantage heading into the ninth before the Renegades rallied for four two-out runs. INF **William Lugo** went 3-for-4 with his second High-A home run, and INF **Jose Peroza** went 3-for-4 with a double, an RBI, and two runs scored. LHP **Keyshawn Askew** retired the first ten men he faced in relief before allowing four late runs in the ninth. RHP **Daison Acosta** earned his sixth save, retiring the final batter of the game. Hudson Valley's 3B Tyler Hardman slammed his 17th home run in the effort.

TOMMY BOY: Mets reliever RHP **Tommy Hunter** continues a rehab assignment with the Brooklyn Cyclones tonight as the starter. The 36-year-old veteran has been on the Mets injured list since August 6th with lower back tightness. Signed to a MiLB contract April 28, pitching with Triple-A Syracuse eight times until his contract was selected on June 17 to MLB.

SUBWAY SERIES: For the final time in 2022, the Cyclones face the Hudson Valley Renegades. Last series, at Dutchess Stadium, the Cyclones won four out of six, winning a series at the home of the Renegades for the first time since the 2019 season. This year, both team have each won 13 games of the 26 in the season series. The run differential is +9 in favor of Brooklyn.

DIVISION ON THE LINE: Including today, the Cyclones have 22 games remaining and four series: four more vs. Hudson Valley, six at Jersey Shore, six vs. Wilmington, and six at Winston-Salem. Brooklyn is vying for a playoff spot with a second half division title in the North Division of the South Atlantic League, sitting a 1/2-game ahead of Hudson Valley for first place.

TOP 30 UPDATE: *MLB Pipeline's* new rankings

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: The New York Yankees affiliate host five of the Bronx Bombers' Top 30 prospects, including two in the top 10. OF Jasson Dominguez ranks second in the system and 42nd in baseball. SS Trey Sweeney ranks No. 6, LHP Yoendrys Gomez ranks No. 12, LHP Edgar Barclay ranks No. 29, and RHP Juan Carela ranks No. 30. The Renegades finished the first half nine games behind division-winner Aberdeen.

BRETT THE BAT: Former Brooklyn Cyclones 3B **Brett Baty** made his MLB debut last night with the Mets in Atlanta, hitting a two-run home run in his first at-bat en route to a 9-7 thrilling Mets victory. Baty played with Brooklyn in 2019 and in 2021 and becomes the 91st former Cyclones player to make the major leagues. He is also the first from the 2019 Mets draft class to make his debut with New York.

PEROZA PRODUCING: Since July 9, INF **Jose Peroza** has a OPS of .863 over his past 30 games with a 17-game on-base streak. The Mets No. 29 prospect has been on base in 28 of the past 30 games, hitting .296 with a .391 OBP. The current active streak leader is Rome C **Tyler Tolve** who has a 24-game on-base streak.

MASTERS OF THEIR DOMAIN: The Cyclones have allowed the fewest runs in the league in the second half and overall. Brooklyn ranks first in the North Division with a +18 run differential with Hudson Valley. The Cyclones have allowed just 170 runs over 44 games (3.9 runs/game) in the second half. The next-closest team is Hudson Valley, allowing 4.3 runs per game in the second half.

BIRTHDAY BOY: Santos celebrated his 21st birthday this past Tuesday.

INNINGS EATER: Santos ranks third in the Mets organization with 95.1 innings pitched. Last year, Junior tossed 96 innings as a career high and has the possibility to pass that mark tonight.

HIGH-RANKING MEMBER: Santos ranks as the top pitching prospect on the staff, ranking No. 16 according to *MLB Pipeline* and No. 17 according to *Baseball America*.

BREAKOUT: The 20 year old pitched with Low-A St. Lucie in 2021, tossing 96 innings which doubles the workload he turned in in 2019 (40.2 IP) and 2018 (45). This season marks the second full season assignment for the righty.

VALUED MEMBER: Santos signed with the Mets in 2018 for \$275,000 out of Santiago in the Dominican Republic.

OPENING DAY STARTER: Junior Santos made Brooklyn's Opening Day start in Wilmington, Delaware on Saturday evening. It was Santos' fourth Opening Day and first Opening Day start since 2018 when he pitched for the DSL Mets against the DSL Angels. In that outing, he struck out six over three innings of one-run ball.
