AMARILLO, TX – Despite a two-homer night from right fielder Tyler Gentry – including back-to-back home runs in the first inning with Nick Loftin, an offensive outburst in the middle innings from the Amarillo Sod Poodles was too much to overcome, as the Northwest Arkansas Naturals fell Wednesday night, 10-4.

- Barely two minutes into the game, Loftin drilled a 448-foot shot to left field, his eighth of the season and second of the series, after homering in the ninth inning Tuesday in his previous at-bat. Four pitches later, it was Gentry's turn, as he connected on his first of the night, the second set of back-to-back homers for the Naturals this season.
- Amarillo cut the lead in half in the second inning, then stormed ahead in the third with a four-run frame against starter Alec Marsh, then held that lead for the rest of the night. Marsh struck out four across 4.0 innings of work, also being tagged for two more runs in the fourth inning.
- The Sod Poodles struck for three in the sixth off of reliever Will Klein for a 10-2 lead, then Jonah Dipoto took over in the sixth with the bases loaded, stranded them loaded and retired all five batters he faced for 1.2 perfect innings. Andres Sotillet contributed a scoreless eighth inning, but the Naturals could not come back.
- After pinch-hitter Brhet Bewley led off the eighth with a single, Gentry capped a 7-pitch at-bat with his second home run of the night, his third of the week and overall sixth with the Naturals in just his 12th Double-A game.

### THIS DAY IN NATURALS HISTORY

The Naturals are 6-5 all-time when playing on June 30

On June 30, 2018, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals walked off on the San Antonio Missions, a 4-3 win in nine innings at Arvest Ballpark. Erick Mejia doubled in Jackson Flores to score a run in the first, then the Missions tied the game in the fourth on a Fernando Tatis Jr. home run, took the lead in the fifth and added a run of insurance in the eighth on another home run from Tatis. As Northwest Arkansas headed into the bottom of the ninth trailing 3-2, Elier Hernandez walked to lead off the inning, then scored on a Kort Peterson double. Peterson came around on a Kelvin Gutierrez single to tie the game, then advanced to third as Anderson Miller reached on a Tatis fielder's choice and throwing error. Still with no outs in the ninth, Alex Liddi singled home Gutierrez for the walk-off win.

**FOLLOW THE LEADER**

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 16 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 8 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: **Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Jake Means, Noah Murdock, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter** and **John Rave**.

**EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM**

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring seven runs or more, the Naturals are 26-3, while when scoring six runs or less, just 6-35.
- The Naturals are 20-8 when recording 10 hits or more, but when they get nine hits or less, are just 12-30.
- The Naturals are 30-10 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 2-28 when out-hit by their opponent.
- When the Naturals score first, they are 21-11, whereas 11-27 when the opponent scores first ... in June, the Naturals have scored first in 9 of 25 games (36.0%) and are 5-4 in those games ... in the recent 12-game homestand, the club scored first three times, the last three games against the Travelers on 6/17, 6/18 and 6/19, not scoring first at all against Springfield.

**ONE RUN GOES A LONG WAY**

The Naturals are 3-13 in one-run games this season, meaning 13 of their 38 losses this season have been decided by just one run.

- The Naturals have had the winning run at the plate in eight losses this season (six one-run losses) and had the tying run at the plate or on base in 15 losses this season (including 10 of their one-run losses).

**RIGHT WHERE THEY BELONG**

The Northwest Arkansas Naturals have generally hovered around .500 for most of the season, the loss yesterday brought the team back down to a season-low six games under .500 with a 32-38 record ... the Naturals have been at or within a game of .500 after 40 of 70 games this season (57.1%).

- The team has peaked at two games above .500, at a 15 - 13 record after the game May 10, but with a low-point of six games under .500 right now.
- After 14 of 70 games this season, the Naturals have ended the day with an even .500 record.
- After 26 of 70 games this season, the Naturals have ended the day within a game of .500, either one game over or under.

**YO, YOU WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?**

Through 70 games, the Naturals have stolen 93 bases in 109 attempts (average 1.33 steals/game, 85.32% success rate).

- 93 steals ranks second in the Texas League, fourth in Double-A and tied 25th in the Minors.
- Maikel Garcia's** 23 steals (in 25 attempts) ranks tied second in the Texas League and tied fourth among all Double-A hitters/basestealers.
- The Naturals have pulled off a double steal 12 times, meaning 24 of 93 steals this year (25.8%) have come on a double-steal.
- The Naturals have stolen at least one base in 45 of 70 games this season, including 24 games with two or more steals ... there have been three occasions where the team has stolen five bases, with perfect 5-for-5 steal efforts as a club on 5/13 vs. Wichita and 5/21 @ Arkansas.
- Naturals players have stolen two bases in a game 11 times, led by FOUR two-steal games from Garcia.

**GAR-SEE YA ON BASE**

Shortstop **Maikel Garcia** has reached base in 57 of the 66 games he has played in this season, reaching base multiple times on 37 occasions, including a team-best 21 multi-hit games.

- In 312 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 115 times (78 hits + 37 walks), for a .371 on-base percentage.
- Garcia has walked 37 times and struck out 53 times, a 0.70 K/BB rate that ranks tied second among Royals minor league hitters with at least 230 plate appearances.
- The shortstop places among the Texas League leaders in several categories, ranking second in hits (78), tied second in steals (23), fourth in doubles (21) and tied 10th in runs scored (49) ... he ranks among the Double-A leaders in steals (tied fourth), hits (fifth) and doubles (tied seventh).
- Maikel's 21 doubles are tied for the most among all Royals Minor League hitters, while he ranks second in the organization with 78 hits and 23 steals ... he ranks tied second in runs scored (49), third in walks (37), tied fifth in total bases (107) and extra-base hits (24) and sixth in on-base percentage (.371) and batting average (.288).
- His 14-game hitting streak between April 27 and May 12 is the longest on the Naturals this year, tied for the 15th-longest in club history and tied for the second-longest in the Texas League this season ... in those 14 games, he hit .397 (23-for-58) with six doubles and a .970 OPS.

**PUSHIN P(ORTER)**

Catcher **Logan Porter** has quietly flown under the radar as one of the top hitters in the Royals system so far in 2022.

- Among full-season Minor League hitters, Porter ranks 10th in on-base percentage (.442) and fifth among all Double-A hitters in OBP ... in the Texas League, he is fourth in OBP and ninth in OPS (.930).
- Among qualified Royals minor league hitters, Porter has the highest on-base percentage, ranks third in OPS and batting average (.302) and fifth in slugging percentage (.488) ... his 38 walks are tied for the second-most in the system, behind Omaha's Nick Pratto (41).
- Porter has reached base in 46 of 51 games he's played this season, with hits in 32 of 51 and 17 multi-hit games, nine of which came in May.
- Porter's 17-game on-base streak between May 31 and June 23 is tied with Robbie Glendinning for the longest on the team this season, a stretch where he hit .321 (17-for-53) with 15 walks and a .493 on-base percentage.

**ROCKIN' ROBBIE**

After slumping for much of June, first baseman Robbie Glendinning has begun to heat back up in the last week.

- The West Australian had two or more hits in four games between June 24 and 28 with hits in five straight games, batting .500 (10-for-20) since June 24, with three doubles and two home runs and a 1.515 OPS.
- After a pair of two-hit games to open the month, Glendinning hit just .192 over his next 15 games, going just 10-for-52 at the plate between June 3 and June 23, with eight hitless games and 21 strikeouts.
- 18 multi-hit games this season ranks fourth among Naturals hitters, 17 being two-hit games ... Robbie recorded his first 3-hit game on Saturday June 25 against Springfield, a 3-for-4 game with a double and home run.
- Glendinning home run in the 8th inning on June 25 snapped a drought of 100 plate appearances and 24 games without a home run, the longest between two home runs for any Natural this season ... his last came on May 24 in Midland, then homered back-to-back days on June 25 and 26.

**Pitchers of the Month (1)**

\* **May: LHP Drew Parrish** ... started five games and went 3-1 with a 0.59 ERA (2 ER in 30.2 IP) ... only allowed 15 hits and four walks, while striking out 29 opposing hitters ... among qualified Texas League pitchers, threw the most innings and had the lowest ERA and WHIP (0.62), while holding opponents to a .144 average.

**Players of the Week (2)**

\* **April 25 to May 1: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit .417 (10-for-28) across six games with a league-best 19 total bases and nine runs batted in, while tied for the Texas League lead with 10 hits. His 1.221 OPS ranked third among players with at least 20 at-bats, while his .417 average tied for second among that same group.

\* **May 23 to May 29: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit a league-best .481 (13-for-27) across six games in Midland, while tied for the league lead with 19 total bases. He drove in nine runs as well, doubling three times with one home run, a go-ahead grand slam on May 24 and collected multiple hits in each of the first five games of the series.

**Pitchers of the Week (3)**

\* **May 2 to May 8: LHP Drew Parrish** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 7 @ Springfield ... held the Cardinals to just two hits and one walk while striking out four. He retired the first eight he faced and the final five, with five 1-2-3 frames.

\* **May 9 to May 15: LHP Drew Parrish** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 13 vs. Wichita ... held the Wind Surge to just three hits and no walks while striking out nine. Between the second and sixth innings, he retired 13 straight batters, retiring the side 1-2-3 in the first inning, as well as the third through sixth.

\* **June 6 to June 12: LHP Anthony Veneziano** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings in a complete-game shutout on June 9 @ Tulsa ... held the Drillers to just three hits and one walk while striking out five, on 79 pitches. Retired the final eight hitters he faced and 11 of the last 12, only needing five pitches for a 1-2-3 seventh inning to end the night.
