### Today's Game

The Fightin Phils remain home and continue a six-game series against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. It is the fourth-of-18 matchups this season between the teams, and fourth-of-six at FirstEnergy Stadium. Hartford won the 2024 season-series over Reading 10-8. Following this week, the Fightin Phils go to Hartford from July 29-August 3 and Sept. 2-7. Hartford leads the season-series 2-1.

### Game 63 Recap

The Fightin Phils surrendered a late lead to fall 6-4 to Hartford on Thursday night. Griff McGarry made his return to the mound after two months on the injured list and allowed two runs, but none earned over 3.1 innings. McGarry struck out three, walked three, and allowed just one hit. John McMillon followed with 0.2 scoreless innings, but exited early after injuring himself warming up. Jack Dallas allowed a run over 2.1 innings, then Andrew Walling suffered the loss after surrendering three runs on three hits over 1.2 innings of work. Travis Kuhn did pitch a scoreless ninth. Offensively, Reading got two runs on a two-run double from Robert Moore. Leandro Pineda also doubled, and Cade Fergus had a hit. Alex Binelas stayed red-hot with two home runs.

### Binelas Brings the Boom

Alex Binelas stayed red-hot with two home runs on Thursday night. It was the fourth multi-homer game in Binelas' career and the first since June 22, 2023, when he did it with Portland, against Reading, at Hadlock Field. His two home runs marked the fourth multi-homer game hit by a R-Phil this season, and the second in three days, as Caleb Ricketts had two home runs on Tuesday against Hartford. Binelas enters tonight on a season-best 10-game on-base streak, dating back to June 6. Over the streak, Binelas is slashing .333/.462/.700 (1.162 OPS), with six runs, two doubles, three home runs and 11 RBI. A highlights of the streak was a career-high five RBI on June 12 against New Hampshire, a night in which Binelas had two hits, a run, a home run and five RBI. His nine RBI from June 10-15 were the most in the Eastern League for last week. Since June 10, Binelas holds the following Eastern League ranks: 1st AVG (.400), T-1st HR (3), 1st RBI (11), 2nd OBP (.484), 1st SLG (.840), 1st OPS (1.324) and 4th TB (21).

### Hammering Homers

After three-more home runs on Tuesday night and two on Thursday, the Fightin Phils have launched 21 home runs since the start of June. That is a mark that is most in the Eastern League, and one ahead of second place Erie, who has 19. Reading ranks fourth in the league in home runs this season with 54.

### Welcome Back Caleb

After missing two months on the injured list, Caleb Ricketts made his return to the Reading lineup in a big way on Tuesday night. The 25-year old catcher launched two home runs and drove in three runs in the win. His two home runs marked the second two home run game of his career, with the last coming on June 6, 2024, against Harrisburg at FirstEnergy Stadium. It marked the third two home run game of the season for a Reading player, with the other two being Robert Moore on Apr. 15 vs Binghamton and Paul McIntosh on June 7 at Harrisburg.

### Catch Me If you Can Carson

Carson DeMartini continues to be a threat on the base paths since joining the Fightin Phils last week. Over nine games, DeMartini has swiped six bags. Since June 10, his Double-A debut, DeMartini ranks second in the Eastern League in stolen bases, trailing only Hartford's Cole Carrigg, who has stolen eight bases since the start of last week. DeMartini is tied with Aidan Miller and Justin Crawford for second in the Phillies organization in stolen bases with 24.

### It's Miller Time

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller continues to be a threat on the base paths. After two-more stolen bases last Wednesday night, Miller is second in the Eastern League with 24 stolen bases. In the Phillies organization, Miller is tied for second with Carson DeMartini and Justin Crawford at 24 stolen bases, behind Lehigh Valley's Oscar Mercado, who has 26.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

**June 20, 1991:** At Reading, Pete Rose makes a surprise visit to Municipal Stadium to honor Mike Schmidt on the night Schmidt's number 24 is retired by the R-Phils. Rose had been banned from Organized Baseball and was not permitted to attend any Major or Minor League games at the time. The R-Phils had planned on retiring Schmidt's number the season before but the game was rained out. As for the game, Reading's Sean Ryan hits a 2-run homer in the 8th to break a 4-4 tie and lift the home team to a 6-4 win over Canton-Akron.

### Hey Hartford

Hartford enters tonight with a 34-32 record, 10-games back of Northeast Division first half champion Binghamton. The Yard Goats dropped four-of-six against Akron last week, including losing the final three games. After this week, Hartford returns home to face New Hampshire. Hartford's roster features eight of Colorado's top-30 prospects: Cole Carrigg (2), Seam Sullivan (8), Benny Montgomery (13), Kyle Karros (18), Wlinton Herrera (20), Jack Mahoney (24), Dylan Jorge (27) and Connor Staine (30).

### Goat on the Bump

Righty Blake Adams makes his 12th start of the season for Hartford. Adams is 2-5, with a 7.42 ERA (36 ER, 43.2 IP). He's struck out 48 over 43.2 IP (9.89 SO/9.0 IP). Adams suffered the loss last Saturday vs Akron, allowing six runs over 3.1 innings pitched. Adams split 2024 between Spokane (A+) and Hartford, combining to go 9-5, with a 2.91 ERA over 23 appearances. The 24-year old was drafted by the Rockies in the 13th round of the 2022 draft out of Kansas State. Adams pitched at Arkansas from 2020-21, and was teammates with Robert Moore. He then spent 2022 with Kansas State before being drafted.

Neunborn fell the victim of high pitch count and lack of run support as he suffered his first loss of the season last Sunday. After posting zeroes in the first two frames, Neunborn allowed a run in the third, his final inning of work. He allowed back-to-back singles, then threw a wild pitch to score the lone run he allowed. Neunborn did match a season-high with five strikeouts in the defeat. Neunborn was relieved by Gunner Mayer in the top of the fourth inning.

### 2025 Season:

- Has spent entire season with Reading (AA)
- First two starts this season have come against Harrisburg (June 5 and May 4), third and fourth came against New Hampshire on June 10 and 15
- Has pitched three-plus innings on five occasions this season: May 18 vs New Hampshire (1 ER, 5 SO), May 27 vs Erie (0 ER, 1 H, 0 SO), June 5 at Harrisburg (0 ER, 1 H, 3 SO), June 10 vs New Hampshire (0 ER, 4 H, 3 SO) and June 15 vs New Hampshire (1 ER, 4 H, 5 SO)
- Set season-high in strikeouts (5) May 18 vs New Hampshire over three innings of work
- Has gone two innings or more in 12-of-16 appearances this season
- Both wins this season came in both three-inning relief outings on May 18 vs NH and May 27 vs ERI
