YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the RubberDucks, 5-1. The only Richmond run scored on a solo homer by **Bryce Eldridge** in the second, who was making his season debut. The Akron pitching staff allowed three hits. The RubberDucks opened the scoring in the first with an RBI double by Kahlil Watson. After the tying homer by Eldridge, Jake Fox moved Akron back in front in the second with a run-scoring groundout by Jake Fox. In the bottom of the fifth, Travis Bazzana hit an RBI single and later scored on a sacrifice fly by Watson. Joe Lampe added an RBI single in the eighth. **Braxton Roxby** struck out five batters over two scoreless relief innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game road series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. The RubberDucks swept a three-game series at The Diamond to open the season from April 4-6. Richmond returns to Akron for a six-game series from July 8-13. The RubberDucks play one more series at The Diamond from August 26-31.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 7,347 fans per home game, which ranks second among all 120 MiLB clubs.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS went 2-4 in last week's home series against Chesapeake after going 2-4 in the previous week's road series at Harrisburg. In the Eastern League, the Richmond offense is second in hits (121), third in batting average (.237), 10th in runs (54), seventh in total bases (172), tied for eighth in doubles (21), tied for ninth in homers (10), 10th in RBIs (46), seventh in walks (55) and first in strikeouts (114 - fewest). The Richmond pitching staff is eighth in ERA (4.20) and sixth in strikeouts (151).

THE RUBBERDUCKS dropped four-of-six last week at Erie, their first series loss of the season. After sweeping Richmond to open the season from April 4-6, they won four-of-six against the Curve in their first homestand of the year from April 8-13. Akron's roster includes five of Baseball America's top-30 Guardians prospects, including 2B Travis Bazzana (No. 1), C Cooper Ingle (No. 7), 1B C.J. Kayfus (No. 8), RHP Austin Peterson (No. 24) and OF Kahlil Watson (No. 30). Bazzana is also ranked No. 23 on Baseball America's top-100 prospects list. MLB.com's top-30 Guardians prospects list features four Akron players, including Bazzana (No. 1), Ingle (No. 7), Kayfus (No. 8) and Peterson (No. 29).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander John Michael Bertrand makes his fourth start of the season and the ninth outing of his career against the RubberDucks. In his previous eight outings against the RubberDucks, he is 4-3 with a 4.73 ERA (21 ER/40.0 IP). Bertrand started on Opening Day for the Flying Squirrels on April 4 against Akron, becoming the first pitcher to start back-to-back season openers for the Flying Squirrels. Last year, he was named the Flying Squirrels' Pitcher of the Year after going 7-9 with a 4.32 ERA in 28 outings (27 starts). Bertrand also won the team's Community Service Award. He made two starts with Triple-A Sacramento to close the year. For the year, Bertrand led all Eastern League pitchers with 10 scoreless starts, all at least five innings. He also led all MiLB pitchers defensively in assists (31) and ranked second in total chances (38). He finished the season ranked first among all MiLB pitchers in double plays induced (23), five ahead of the next closest pitcher. Bertrand was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week twice last year, first for throwing seven perfect innings against the Baysox on April 27 and then for working six hitless innings in Bowie on May 23. Entering 2025, he is rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system for the second straight year. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two seasons at the University of Notre Dame. He was selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. For more on Bertrand, see page two.

FOR AKRON: Right-hander Austin Peterson makes his fourth start of the season and his second this year against the Flying Squirrels. At The Diamond on April 5, he threw four scoreless innings and allowed one hit with no walks and four strikeouts. After five scoreless innings against the Curve on April 11, he picked up his first win of the season last Thursday, allowing two runs in five innings at Erie. He joined Double-A Akron last June and went 7-2 with a 2.88 ERA in 13 starts. Peterson began the 2024 season with High-A Lake County, going 7-2 with a 2.44 ERA and combined to go 14-4 with a 2.64 ERA between the two stops. He was selected as a Midwest League Post-Season All-Star. Peterson was drafted by Cleveland in the ninth round in 2022 out of the University of Connecticut, where he was teammates with Reggie Crawford. He is rated by MLB.com as the No. 29 Guardians prospect.

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of **Adrián Sugastey** and **Zach Morgan** have combined to throw out 12 stolen base attempts this season, which leads all 30 Double-A teams and ranks tied for eighth among the 120 MiLB teams. Sugastey leads the Eastern League with seven runners caught stealing, which is also tied for first in Double-A. Morgan is second in the league with five.

BRYCE IS BACK: Northern Virginia native Bryce Eldridge returned to the Richmond roster on Tuesday after missing the start of the season with an injury. He hit a solo home run in his first plate appearance of the year. The 20-year-old first baseman played at four levels in the Giants organization in his first full professional season last year, including nine games with Richmond in September. For the year in 116 games, Eldridge hit .291 with 23 homers and 92 RBIs. He is ranked by Baseball America as the No. 11 prospect in baseball. Eldridge is also the fifth Virginia-born player to suit up for the Flying Squirrels in franchise history.

PLAY THE HITS: The Flying Squirrels have collected 121 hits through their first 16 games this season, which is the second-most in the Eastern League. The team is batting .237 (121-for-510), which is third-highest in the league. However, the Richmond offense is batting .194 (26-for-134) with runners in scoring position, which is 10th the league.

WHERE DID THESE GUYS COME FROM?: There are players from six different counties on the Flying Squirrels' roster, including the United States (21 players), Venezuela (2), the Dominican Republic (2), Cuba (1), Panama (1) and Puerto Rico (1). Among the 21 American-born players, 12 different states are represented, including North Carolina (3), Florida (3), Ohio (3), California (2), Michigan (2), Pennsylvania (2), Kentucky (1), Minnesota (1), North Dakota (1), Rhode Island (1), Texas (1) and Virginia. There are 12 players who joined the Giants organization out of the MLB Draft, six were signed as non-drafted free agents, five as international free agents, four who were picked up in trades and one who was claimed in the minor-league phase of the Rule 5 Draft. For 23 players, the Giants were their original affiliated organization and five have played with other major-league organizations.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Victor Bericoto is third in OPS (1.035), tied for fourth in homers (3), fifth in SLG (.596), sixth in OBP (.439), seventh in batting average (.319) and tied for eighth in total bases (28). **Jairo Pomares** is tied for fourth in home runs (3). **Jack Choate** is tied for sixth in strikeouts (21).

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster includes seven players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including Bryce Eldridge (No. 1), Joe Whitman (No. 10), Diego Velasquez (No. 13), Sabin Ceballos (No. 16), Trent Harris (No. 26), Aeverson Arteaga (No. 27) and Jack Choate (No. 28). There are also seven players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Eldridge, (No. 1), Whitman (No. 7), Harris (No. 11), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27). Eldridge is also ranked No. 11 overall by Baseball America and No. 22 by MLB.com.

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND **BASEBALL HISTORY**

BASEBALL HISTORY

1960: Eli Grba pitched a three-hit shutout to lead the Richmond Virginians to a 4-0 win over the Montreal Royals at Parker Field. He took a no-hit bid into the seventh inning until it was broken up by former Vee Curt Roberts. Grba added a solo home run in the eighth. Jim McKnight also homered in the inning 1966: The Richmond Braves played their first-ever game, falling to the Rochester Red Wings, 3-2, at Parker Field. It was the city's first professional game in 18 months after the Virginians relocated to Toledo following the 1964 season. The opener was originally scheduled for the previous day but was postponed for rain. Billy Southworth hit a solo homer in the seventh to break the shutout bid. 1974: The Richmond Braves swept a doubleheader over the Pawtucket Red Sox at rain. Billy Southworth hit a solo homer in the seventh to break the shutout bid. 1974: The Richmond Braves swept a doubleheader over the Pawtucket Red Sox at Parker Field, 6-5 and 5-2. Larry Howard won the first game with a walk-off single in the eighth inning. In the second game, Pawtucket's Fred Lynn hit a home run in the seventh and final inning to close the score to 5-2. After singles by Jim Rice and Frank Vazquez put two runners on base, Joe Niekro entered and stranded the bases loaded to end the game. Jim Breazeale homered in both games. 2004: Ryan Langerhans hit a walk-off single in the ninth as the Richmond Braves beat the Charlotte Knights, 5-4, at The Diamond. 2010: The Flying Squirrels beat the Reading Phillies on the road, 5-3. Thomas Neal became the first player in franchise history to homer twice in a game and the first to drive in five runs in a game. His two-run homer in the fifth and three-run homer in the seventh accounted for all five Richmond runs in the win. 2011: The Flying Squirrels beat the Altoona Curve, 3-2, in 1 innings at The Diamond. After the Curve took a 2-1 lead in the top of the 11th, a throwing error by Noah Krol on a Nick Noonan bunt brought the tying run in to score. In the next at-bat, Justin Christian scored on a wild pitch to give Richmond the walk-off win.
