Transactions: Today the A's promoted Lugnuts outfielder **Bryan Buevas**, the reigning MWL Hitter of the Week, and closer **Colton Johnson** to Double-A Midland, replacing them on the Nuts' roster with prospect outfielder **Ryan Lasko** from Stockton and returning right-hander **Wander Guante** from Midland.

Streaking: **Will Simpson** comes in with a 17-game on-base streak, tying his own season high from April and one game shy of **Cameron Masterman's** team-high 18-game streak spanning April and May.

The Future is Here: Lugnuts right-hander **Luis Morales**, the youngest player on the team, tossed 2/3 of an inning in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game last Saturday at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas, plunking Dylan Crews, striking out Jeral Perez and Deyvison De Los Santos, and walking Great Lakes' Thayron Liranzo before departing in favor of Quad Cities' Ben Kudrna, who stranded the runners.

All-Star Alumni: The Lugnuts were represented in the MLB All-Star Game by 2017 Nuts alum **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.**, who went hitless, and 2022 Lansing standout **Mason Miller**, who tossed a perfect frame for the A.L., striking out **Shohei Ohtani** and **Trea Turner** and hitting 103.6 mph, the fastest pitch in All-Star Game history. For Vladdy, this was his fourth consecutive All-Star nod while rookie Miller made his first All-Star appearance.

To the Show! 2023 Nuts sensation **Jacob Wilson** was called up to the Majors today by the A's and will become the fifth former Lugnut this year and 189th all-time to make his MLB debut. Wilson, the 6th overall pick in the 2023 draft, is in the A's starting lineup tonight, starting at shortstop and batting eighth in the order against the Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim.

Prospecting: Lansing has four MLB Pipeline Top 30 Oakland Athletics prospects on its roster: starting pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2, and the A's No. 1 pitching prospect), outfielder **Ryan Lasko** (No. 15), slugger **Will Simpson** (No. 24), and pitcher **Will Johnston** (No. 27).

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2012: A pair of unusual coaching ejections occurred as the Lugnuts were swept in a doubleheader at Beloit, 2-1 and 7-1. In Game 1, hitting coach / 1st base coach Kenny Graham was thumbed out in the seventh inning following Shane Opitz getting picked off. In Game 2, it was pitching coach Vince Horsman who was ejected in the sixth inning.

2017: Ronnie Dawson homered twice in a nine-run second inning, Josh Rojas also homered twice, and the Quad Cities River Bandits opened up a three-game home series by steamrolling the Lugnuts, 20-3, at Modern Woodmen Park. The Bandits led 15-0 after the third inning and 18-0 after the fifth. The game set Lansing's franchise record with a 17-run margin of defeat and tied franchise records with 20 runs allowed and six home runs allowed. Rodrigo Orozco singled, walked and doubled before getting robbed by first baseman Troy Seiber on a line drive down the line, ending a streak of eight straight plate appearances reaching base.

In a Nutshell: Declared a free agent on August 25, 2022... signed on the first day of the international signing period, January 15, 2023... signing bonus of \$3 million broke the record given to Sandy Gaston by Tampa Bay (\$2.61 million in 2018) and then motored through four levels in his 2023 professional debut... glove this year is green and black to represent A's green and Lugnuts' black... opened 2024 on the Injured List, activated April 29... notable splits:

Off to Arlington: Luis represented the Oakland Athletics in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game on July 13 at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas, becoming the fifth active Lugnut in team history to participate in the Futures Game, joining Denzel Clarke (2022), Bo Bichette and Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (2017) and Ángel Perdomo (2016). He was one of seven current Midwest Leaguers to be part of the Futures Game roster, along with Ethan Salas (Fort Wayne), Ben Kudrna (Quad Cities), Noble Meyer and Thomas White (Beloit), Thayron Liranzo (Great Lakes) and Cam Collier (Dayton). He faced four batters, striking out two, hitting Dylan Crews with a pitch and walking Liranzo.

Prospecting: Morales is ranked the Oakland Athletics' no. 2 prospect behind SS Jacob Wilson and top pitching prospect by MLB Pipeline, which grades his fastball at 60, his curve at 50, his slider at 55, his change at 50 and his control at 50. They write, "Morales was billed as the consensus top pitching prospect of the 2023 international signing period when he signed for \$3 million with the A's in January that year. After setting a U-18 record for strikeouts with 161 across 82 2/3 innings between 2019-20 in Cuba's Serie Nacional, he defected in 2021 to Mexico, where he trained with Maels Rodriguez, a former Cuban National team pitcher and Olympian who regularly threw 100 mph fastballs. Initially expected to pitch solely in the Dominican Summer League for his introduction to pro ball, his excellent performance earned him stops at four different levels. He finished the year at High-A Lansing, combining for a 2.86 ERA with 53 strikeouts in 44 innings."

Path to Lansing: Luis opened the 2023 season in the Dominican Summer League, making his professional debut on June 6 with 1 2/3 hitless innings vs. DSL Astros Blue, striking out three... struck out six batters in three one-hit innings on June 20... struck out five batters in four one-hit innings on June 27... made four appearances in DSL before he was promoted to the Arizona Complex League Athletics on July 2, debuting on July 4 with three innings, allowing one run with three strikeouts vs. D-Backs Black... made three starts in AzCL before he was promoted to the Stockton Ports on July 24, debuting on July 28 with three one-hit innings and five strikeouts vs. Lake Elsinore... in last of five California League starts, tossed four two-hit scoreless innings at Fresno on August 25... promoted to Lansing on August 30, his fourth different stop along the ladder.

History: On June 13, relieved Jake Garland beginning in the 6th inning and tossed 2 2/3 hitless innings, walking one and striking out three, as part of the Lugnuts' 8-0 no-hitter of the Cedar Rapids Kernels, the 4th no-hitter in franchise history and the first home no-hitter since 2003.
