TONIGHT: The Stripers conclude the second leg of a 12game road trip with the finale of a six-game series vs. the Norfolk Tides (Baltimore Orioles) at Harbor Park. It is the last of 18 meetings between the two clubs this year, and the last of 12 games Gwinnett will play in Norfolk. With a win. the Stripers would snap a seven-game losing streak in series finales (last won finale on 5/8 vs. CLT, 6-5).

AT NORFOLK: The Stripers are 65-69 (.485) in 134 games all-time at Norfolk's Harbor Park, including 5-6 (.455) in 11 games this season. Gwinnett is 6-6-0 in 12 season road series vs. the Tides all-time (2009-current), including 4-2-0 over the last six years (2015-current).

RISING WATERS: Drew Waters blasted a decisive two-run homer in the third inning last night (off RHP Blaine Knight), his fifth of the year. Gwinnett is now 5-0 when he homers this season. In 42 total games, Waters is batting .242 (40for-165, 6 2B, 3 3B, 5 HR, 22 R, 16 RBI, 3 SB, .700 OPS), including .391 (4 2B, 1 HR, .983 OPS) vs. LHP and .185 (2 2B, 3 3B, 4 HR, .591 OPS) vs. RHP.

• GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2019, Waters is batting .246 (166-for-676, 33 2B, 4 3B, 18 HR, 109 R, 64 RBI, 34 SB, .708 OPS) in 171 games.

SHEW-MAKING IT HAPPEN: With his ninth-inning two-run home run last night (#5, off RHP Marcos Diplan), Braden Shewmake has hit safely in 10 of 12 games since 6/7, batting .313 (15-for-48, 2 2B, 2 HR, 5 R, 9 RBI, 2 SB, .825 OPS) in that span. In 55 games overall on his Triple-A debut, he's batting .271 (56-for-207, 10 2B, 1 3B, 5 HR, 28 R, 17 RBI, 6 SB, .724 OPS).

POSTSEASON HEROES ON REHAB: Two key players from the Atlanta Braves' 2021 World Series championship are currently on injury rehab assignments with Gwinnett: OF Eddie Rosario and LHP Tyler Matzek.

- Rosario: Batting .241 (7-for-29, 2 2B, 3 R, 5 RBI) in seven games since 6/25. He is on the 10-day IL following a procedure to correct blurred vision and swelling in his right retina. Rosario, the 2021 NLCS Most Valuable Player, is rehabbing with the Stripers for the second time in his career (13G from 8/11-26, 2021).
- Matzek: Has struck out five of six batters faced over two games (2.0 IP, 0 H, 0 BB) since 6/29. He is on the 15-day IL with left shoulder inflammation after going 0-1 with a 5.06 ERA and .167 BAA in 13 games with Atlanta this season. It is his second career stint with the Stripers (0-0. 9.00 ERA in 5G in 2019).

CAN'T TOUCH TONKIN: Michael Tonkin (1.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 1 SO last night) enters play riding a team-best 10.0-inning scoreless streak over his last nine appearances. In that stretch, he's posting a 0.50 WHIP (4 H, 1 BB), .118 BAA, 15.30 SO/9.0 IP ratio (17 SO), and two saves (2-for-2). In 23 games overall, Tonkin is 3-0 with a 2.19 ERA (6 ER in 24.0 IP), .185 BAA, 14.96 SO/9.0 IP ratio (41 SO), and team-high five saves (5-for-6, T-13th in IL).

KINGS OF THE "K": Stripers pitchers lead the International League in strikeouts with 780 in 77 games (10.13 SO per game). That's second-most in all of Triple-A, eight behind Round Rock of the Pacific Coast League (788 SO in 77G). Kyle Muller (1st, 102), Tucker Davidson (T-7th, 69), Huascar Ynoa (T-9th, 67), and Bryce Elder (T-14th, 62) all rank among the IL top 15 in strikeouts.

<u>DESHIELDS KEEPS REACHING:</u> Delino DeShields Jr. has reached base safely in 14 of 16 games with at least one plate appearance since 6/1, batting .333 (14-for-42, 2 2B, 1 HR, 11 R, 6 RBI, 6 SB, .934 OPS). Overall with the Stripers this season, he has reached base safely in 44 of 52 games (84.6%) with a plate appearance, batting .272 (40-for-147, 6 2B, 1 HR, 24 R, 16 RBI, .757 OPS).

• IL Leaderboard: DeShields ranks among the IL top 15 in steals (T-9th, 16) and walks (T-12th, 37).

MULLER'S QUALITY STREAK ENDS: Kyle Muller saw his five-game quality start streak snapped on Friday (loss, 5.1 IP, 4 H, 2 ER, 1 HR, 3 BB, 3 SO). During the streak from 6/2-6/26, he went 2-1 with a 1.87 ERA (7 ER in 33.2 IP), 0.77 WHIP, .171 BAA, and 11.49 SO/9.0 IP ratio (43 SO).

- IL Leaderboard: Muller leads the league in strikeouts (102, 8th in MiLB) and ranks among the IL top five in ERA (2nd, 2.99), WHIP (2nd, 1.09), innings (2nd, 81.1), BAA (3rd, .216), and starts (T-5th, 14).
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2021, he is 9-9 with a 3.19 ERA (57 ER in 161.0 IP), .219 BAA, and 195 strikeouts (10.90 SO/9.0 IP ratio) in 31 starts.

TURNING THREE: 3B Joe Dunand, 2B Braden Shewmake, and 1B Pat Valaika combined to turn a 5-4-3 triple play in the second inning on Friday. It's the first triple play turned by a Triple-A team this season, and the sixth triple play in Gwinnett history (first since 6/5/21 vs. JAX, 3B Johan Camargo to 2B Jason Kipnis to 1B Travis Snider).

CASTEEL IN THE CLUTCH: Ryan Casteel tallied a seasonhigh four RBI on Thursday (2-for-4, 2B, HR), his most RBI in a game since 6/24/21, also at Norfolk (1-for-4, grand slam, 4 RBI in 6-2 win). Of his 17 hits, 12 have gone for extra bases (70.6%, 4 2B, 1 3B, 7 HR). For his Gwinnett career, 50.0% of his hits have been for extra bases (26 of 52), including 10 doubles, one triple, and 15 homers.

DEMERITTE RETURNS: Travis Demeritte is batting .167 (7for-42, 4 R, 1 RBI, 2 SB) in 11 games with Gwinnett since being optioned by Atlanta on 5/28. He hit .213 (19-for-89, 2 2B, 3 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI) in 26 games during his first career stint with the Braves from 4/22-5/27.

• GWN Career: Demeritte has reached base safely in 170 of 200 games (85.0%) with the Stripers since 2019, batting .277 (192-for-693, 49 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 130 R, 138 RBI, 15 SB, .914 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Mejia.

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) .. In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... On 6/9/22 at Jacksonville, he became the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 career wins ... Began his managerial career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for MiLB Manager of the Year ... Coached at the Braves' Alternate Training Site in 2020.

• IL Leaderboard: Entering play, ranks sixth in the league in strikeouts (69).

• GWN Career: Makes his 19th career start with Gwinnett ... Is 5-7 with a 3.33 ERA (36 ER in 97.1 IP), .233 BAA, and 109 strikeouts (10.08 SO/9.0 IP ratio) since 2019.

• On the Road: Makes his 10th career Triple-A road start ... Is 3-3 with a 2.64 ERA (14 ER in 47.2 IP), .218 BAA, and 58 strikeouts (10.95 SO/9.0 IP ratio).

PROSPECTING: Davidson is currently ranked the Atlanta Braves' No. 7 prospect by MLB.com. He is the third-highest ranked pitching prospect on Gwinnett's active roster, behind LHP **Kyle Muller** (No. 3) and RHP **Bryce Elder** (No. 4).

2022 WITH GWINNETT: Has had two stints with the Stripers, 4/12-5/16 (1-1, 4.44 ERA, .214 BAA in 5 starts) and 5/29-current (1-3, 4.34 ERA, .281 BAA in 5 starts) ... **6/11 at JAX:** Set a career high with 11 strikeouts over 7.0 IP (5 H, 3 ER) in a 3-2 loss ... **6/22 at NAS:** Earned second win with 6.2 scoreless IP 6 H, 0 BB, 9 SO) in 7-2 win.

2022 WITH ATLANTA: Made the Atlanta Braves' Opening Day roster for the first time in his career ... Pitched once in relief (4/11 vs. WAS, 2.2 IP, 5 ER in 11-2 loss) before being optioned to Gwinnett on 4/12 ...
