LOS QUESOS FRISCO DOWN DIAMANTES IN GAME THREE OF THE SERIES:

The Frisco RoughRiders fell to the Arkansas Travelers on Friday night at Riders Field, 6-2. **Ezequiel Duran** became the third Frisco batter this season to finish with a four-hit night, joining **Blaine Crim** and **Jonathan Ornelas**. The RoughRiders (15-10) went 1-for-13 with runners in scoring position in Friday's game and left 11 men aboard. Reliever **Seth Nordlin** did not allow an earned run in his 4.2 innings of relief. Nordlin struck out six batters after taking over in the fourth without walking a batter. Frisco **Cody Bradford** (2-2) allowed five runs on seven hits in 3.1 innings and finished with no strikeouts for the first time this season. Arkansas reliever Ben Onyshko (1-0) struck out three batters and gave up one hit. Travelers starter Connor Jones allowed two runs on seven hits in his 4.2 innings, walking seven batters. Frisco struck early in the bottom of the first inning with a **Dustin Harris** base hit to score **Justin Foscue**. With the bases loaded, **Trey Hair** walked to send a 2-0 game into the second. Arkansas quickly answered with a sacrifice fly from Patrick Frick, trimming the Riders lead to 2-1. The Travelers tallied four runs in the top of the fourth inning off Bradford with four-consecutive extra-base hits. Jake Scheiner and Zach DeLoach both homered to give Arkansas a 5-2 lead. The Travelers plated one more run in the top of the seventh to cement the 6-2 score.

WALK THIS WAY:

The RoughRiders have walked the fewest times on offense in the Texas League (81) and have walked the second-most batters in the league (128) on the mound this season. Despite this, the Riders still have the third-best ERA in the league (4.34) and the sixth-best OPS in the league (.769)

AYYY, IT'S THE FOSCE:

Riders infielder **Justin Foscue** has caught fire for Frisco. After starting in Extended Spring Training because of back tightness, he joined the club on April 19th. Foscue went 1-for-7 in his first two games, but in his last 12, the former Mississippi State Bulldog has hit .318 (14-for-44)/.412/.591 with seven doubles, a triple, a home run, seven RBIs, seven walks and seven runs. He is riding a 10-game on base streak, where he owns a .442 OBP.

ROAD WARRIORS:

The RoughRiders have played 13 games at home and 12 games on the road so far in 2022. While they are just 5-8 at home, Frisco is 10-2 on the road this season, the best road record in all of Minor League Baseball. Pitching has been dominant away from Riders Field, owning a 3.94 ERA on the road and holding opponents to just a .223 BAA and five home runs over the 12 games. The Riders have the third-best road ERA in the Texas League and the fourth-best road OPS (.805) in the league. At home, Frisco's pitching staff has a 4.69 ERA (fourth in the Texas League) and the Riders have given up 17 home runs in 13 games.

J.P. STANDS FOR JUST PERFORM:

Outfielder **J.P. Martinez** exploded for three-straight games with a home run and collected his back-to-back three-hit games for Frisco before going 1-for-4 with a double on Thursday. Over his last 16 games, Martinez is hitting .313 (20-for-64)/.413/.484 with two doubles, three home runs, seven RBIs, 14 runs, nine stolen bases and 10 walks. Martinez was placed on the 7-Day Injured List on May 6th.

JONNY ON THE SPOT:

Riders infielder **Jonny Ornelas** has been tearing the cover off of the baseball in recent days. On Wednesday in Midland, he tied his career-high with four hits and has batted .388 (31-for-80)/.417/.500/.917 in his last 20 games and .431 (22-for-51) with 1.071 OPS over his last 13 games. He has five games with at least three hits this season to lead the club. Ornelas is also the youngest player on the Riders and the 21-year-old is the 10th-youngest in the Texas League. Ornelas owns a .364 average on the season, which is fourth in Double-A and the best in the Texas Rangers organization.

THE VIPER STRIKES AGAIN:

Known as "The Viper" since his college days at Alabama, Frisco reliever **Chase Lee** has struck quickly and often this season. Over his nine outings, Lee has allowed just four hits (.121 BAA) while not allowing a run and going 3-for-3 in save opportunities. In his 10.2 innings, Lee has whiffed 14 while walking just five.

ALLOW ME TO REINTRODUCE MYSELF:

Riders reliever **Seth Nordlin** was flat out dominant in his outing against Northwest Arkansas on two Fridays ago. Nordlin threw four shutout innings, retiring all 12 batters he faced with four strikeouts. After throwing a first-pitch ball on his very first offering, Nordlin threw 22-straight strikes over the next three innings. Overall, he threw 34 pitches, 29 for strikes. Ever since his first game of the season when he allowed four runs, Nordlin has gone 2-0 with a 1.04 ERA over 17.1 IP. During that span, opponents are just hitting .091 (5-for-55) against him while he has whiffed 18 and walked five.

REARVIEW MIRRORS:

Since the 2019 season ended and the standings reset on September 3rd, 2019, the RoughRiders have not been in second place for 976 days. From the season-opening game in 2021, the RoughRiders held first place the entire season and have now been in first place for every game in 2022 as well.

LOOK AT ALL THAT TALENT:

While RHP **Jack Leiter** headlines the top 30 prospects talent on the squad as the No.1 prospect, the Riders back up him with plenty of players to watch. INF **Ezequiel Duran** slots in as the No. 4 prospect in the organization after the Rangers acquired him from the Yankees as part of the **Joey Gallo** deal at the 2021 deadline. INF **Justin Foscue**, who joined the club after sustaining an injury during spring training, is the No. 5 prospect. OF **Dustin Harris** is the No. 6 prospect after his incredible 20-20 campaign a year ago. Another trade piece, Harris came to the Rangers when they dealt **Mike Minor** to the A's in 2020. LHP **Cody Bradford** is the No. 20 prospect. Bradford, a former Baylor Bear from Aledo, Texas, led all Rangers farmhands in strikeouts last season. RHP **Zak Kent** slots in as the No. 21 prospect by MLB.com.

ABOUT JACK

-Leiter was drafted in the first round (No. 2 overall) in 2021 by the Rangers out of Vanderbilt University. With the Commodores, Leiter was a unanimous First Team All-American and a finalist for both the Golden Spikes Award and the Dick Howser Trophy.

-Threw first regular-season, complete-game no-hitter to start SEC play since 1971 against No.16 South Carolina on March 20th, 2021. He walked the first batter of the game before retiring the last 27 he saw with 16 strikeouts on 124 pitches. Followed up that no-hitter with 7.0 no-hit innings in his next start (20.2 consecutive no-hit innings over three starts from March 20th - April 2nd).

-Drafted in 20th round in 2019 by NYY out of Delbarton School (NJ). Named 2019 New Jersey Gatorade POY, striking out 95 in 57 innings as a senior.

-The family lineage is strong with Jack. His father, Al, pitched in 19 MLB seasons (1987-2005), making two All-Star teams and winning both the 1993 and 1997 World Series. His uncle, Mark, played 11 seasons in the majors (1990-99; 2001) and his cousin, Mark Jr., pitched two seasons (2017-2018) with Philadelphia and Toronto. Al now works as an analyst for MLB Network.

2022 SEASON

-Leiter entered the 2022 season as the No. 17 prospect in baseball according to MLB.com. He is listed as the No.1 prospect in the Rangers organization as well.

-Leiter dazzled in his professional debut, striking out seven over his three innings against the Arkansas Travelers on April 9th. The righty helped draw the largest crowd since 2019 at Riders Field for the debut (9,322).

2021 SEASON

-After being drafted second overall in the 2021 draft, Leiter did not pitch in the minor leagues. Instead, he returned to Vanderbilt to workout, continue college and prepare for 2022. Did not finish degree, but got closer.

MORE INFO

-Leiter was high school teammates with Yankees No. 1 prospect (No. 8 in baseball) Anthony Volpe at Delbarton School (NJ).
