**Tonight's Game:** The Nashville Sounds and Toledo Mud Hens wrap up a six-game series tonight at Fifth Third Field. The Sounds need a win to avoid their first series loss of the season. Right-hander Alec Bettinger starts for Nashville against right-hander Garrett Hill for Toledo.

**Alec Bettinger:** 26-year-old Alec Bettinger starts for Nashville tonight. The right-hander is making his third start and fourth appearance overall in 2022. He is 0-0 with a 7.88 ERA (8.0 IP/7 ER). He last pitched in a relief role on May 21 vs. Louisville and allowed four runs (three earned) on four hits. Bettinger spent the majority of his 2021 season with Nashville and went 3-7 with a 4.75 ERA (96.2 IP/51 ER) in 21 games (18 starts). He also made four appearances (one start) with Milwaukee. He began his 2021 season with Milwaukee and was optioned on May 9 for the first time. Bettinger entered the 2022 season as the No. 24 prospect in the Brewers organization according to Baseball America and the No. 23 prospect according to MLB Pipeline. Milwaukee drafted Bettinger in the 10th round of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Virginia.

**Garrett Hill:** 26-year-old Garrett Hill starts for the Mud Hens tonight. The right-hander is making his second career Triple-A start. He began the season with Double-A Erie and went 2-0 with a 2.25 ERA (32.0 IP/8 ER) in seven starts before joining Toledo on May 18. He last pitched on May 22 in a start against Indianapolis. He worked 5.0 innings and allowed three runs (two earned) on three hits and four walks. He threw 72 pitches and struck out four batters in the loss. Hill has a career minor league record of 16-9 with a 2.43 ERA in 48 games (all starts). The Tigers drafted him in the 26th round of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of San Diego State University.

**Superlatives...**Yesterday the Sounds improved to 27-0 when leading after 8 innings...24-4 when scoring first...13-9 on the road...22-11 against a right-handed starter...22-4 when the opponent scores 3 or less and 1-1 when a starter goes 7+ innings.

**The Nashville List:** Last night's win for Rick Sweet was his 178th as manager of the Nashville Sounds. Sweet is tied for sixth-most with Carl "Stump" Merrill who managed the Sounds to a 178-108 record during a two-year stretch of 1980 and 1981. Pete Mackanin is fifth on the Sounds all-time managerial win list with 186.

**Shutouts Galore:** Sounds pitchers notched their fourth shutout in May and seventh overall in 2022. The seven shutouts is tied for the most in Minor League Baseball. Advanced-A Dayton and Single-A Fort Myers have also tossed seven shutouts.

**Grand Finale:** The Sounds are 7-0 in series finales going into tonight's finale against Toledo.

**Boushley's Gem:** Last night's starter Caleb Boushley turned in the second performance by a Nashville pitcher of at least 7.0 innings in a game this year, joining Jason Alexander's 7.0 innings in the second game of the series. It was the fifth time Boushley has gone at least 7.0 innings in his career, and first since he tossed 7.2 innings on August 1, 2021 with Triple-A El Paso at Sugar Land.

**He Gets On Base:** Jonathan Davis reached base safely in his 12th-straight game on Friday, going 1-for-4 with a run and RBI. During the 12-game streak, Davis is hitting .283 (13-for-46) with 9 runs, 2 doubles, 2 home runs, 6 RBI, 11 walks and 4 stolen bases. It's the 10th-longest active streak in the International League.

**Earn It:** Nashville's team ERA sits at 3.07 (404.2 IP/138 ER) after yesterday's shutout. The 3.07 ERA is the best mark across Triple-A Baseball, far ahead of Toledo with a 3.77 ERA. Nashville's seven shutouts also leads Triple-A Baseball.

**How Sweet It Is:** Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his third season overall and second consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. Sweet led the Sounds to a 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season.

**The Future Brew Crew:** Nashville has five players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 4 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 7 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 20 prospect, right-handed pitcher Alec Bettinger is the No. 22 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 24 prospect.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** Bettinger has faced Toledo once in his career - a start at First Horizon Park on August 6, 2021. He did not factor into the decision but allowed six runs (all earned) on eight hits. He allowed three home runs and struck out five batters.
