### TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express get set for game four of their six-game series at Sutter Health Park with the Sacramento River Cats (San Francisco Giants) on Friday. Round Rock RHP Gerson Garabito is slated to take the mound against River Cats RHP Hayden Birdsong. First pitch is scheduled for 8:45 p.m. CT.

### THURSDAY NIGHT W

Round Rock beat Sacramento 5-3 on Thursday night. The River Cats took an early 3-0 advantage in the bottom of the first inning after 3B David Villar launched a three-run homer over the left field fence. Round Rock answered with a four spot in the top of the third inning to take a 4-3 lead. C Andrew Knapp plated 1B Justin Foscue on a double to the gap before Knapp later scored on a wild pitch. SS Jonathan Ornelas tripled home CF Dustin Harris to tie the game at three. Ornelas scored the go-ahead run on a bloop double down the left field line by 2B Jax Biggers to round out the frame. Knapp provided an insurance run in the seventh inning, blasting a solo homer to increase the Express lead to 5-3.

### GO TIME FOR GARABITO

Round Rock RHP Gerson Garabito is making his eighth appearance and fifth start of the year on Friday night. Garabito appeared in 11 games and six starts for the River Cats in 2021. His last appearance at Sutter Health Park came on August 8, 2021 against El Paso. He went 2.0 innings with one earned run out of the bullpen.

### FIVE-RUN FEVER

The Express have scored five runs in each of the first three games of the series after scoring only 15 runs total in the previous six-game series with Tacoma. This month, Round Rock is last in the PCL in runs scored (66), batting average (.216) and slugging percentage (.332).

### BULLPEN SHOVS AGAIN

Last night, RHP Kyle Barraclough, LHP Grant Wolfram and RHP Daniel Robert combined for 5.0 shutout innings out of the Round Rock bullpen. E-Train relievers have allowed three earned runs in 11.0 innings with two walks and 15 strikeouts. All three runs and the two walks were allowed by Texas Rangers rehabber RHP Josh Sborz on Wednesday in 0.2 innings. Express relievers have a 3.97 ERA (58 ER/131.1 IP) on the road this year.

### FOSS GETS ABOARD

Rangers 1B Justin Foscue is rehabbing an oblique injury he suffered with the Texas Rangers on April 7. Foscue went 0-for-2 with two walks and a run scored yesterday. The former 14th overall pick is now riding a 37-game on base streak at the Triple-A level, dating back to August 18, 2023.

### BIG-TIME BIGGERS

Express INF Jax Biggers is 5-for-11 with two doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, three runs scored, two walks and two strikeouts in the first three games of this series. The lefty has an on-base percentage of .412 which is fifth in the PCL. He leads the league with an 18.3% walk rate.

### BACK AT HOME

Round Rock C Andrew Knapp grew up only 30 minutes from Sutter Health Park. In the 10 games before this series, he owned a .140 batting average (6-40). In two games this series, he is 3-for-9 with a double, a homer, two RBI, two runs scored and a walk. Knapp homered for the first time yesterday since May 15.

**ALCS EXPRESS REUNION**

The 2023 ALCS between Houston and Texas featured 22 players that appeared in a game for the Express. The Express reunited as the Rangers Triple-A affiliate in 2021 after spending eight seasons as the club's top affiliate from 2011-2018. Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. From the Rangers, LHP Cody Bradford (2023), OF Evan Carter (2023), C Mitch Garver (2022, 2023), OF Travis Jankowski (2023), INF Josh Jung (2021, 2022), RHP Jose Leclerc (2016, 2018, 2022), LHP Martin Perez (2011, 2012, 2013, 2015, 2018), RHP Josh Sborz (2022, 2023), INF Josh Smith (2022), OF Leody Taveras (2021, 2022, 2023) appeared in the ALCS. For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

**EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS**

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.



Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
