These two teams play 24 games against one another the season, and played 18 times during the regular season in 2021, with the Dragons winning the season series 10-8. The Whitecaps are a Detroit Tigers affiliate in their 28th season in professional baseball, while Dayton is in their 22nd year of professional baseball affiliation with the nearby Cincinnati Reds.

STORYLINES AND HEADLINES

LAST TIME OUT: The West Michigan Whitecaps amassed one hit as the Dayton Dragons posted a dominant pitching performance in a 10-1 loss Tuesday night at LMCU Ballpark. Whitecaps catcher Josh Crouch blasted his second home run of the season - the 'Caps only hit - as West Michigan failed to advance a runner into scoring position while striking out 13 times. Meanwhile, every Dayton batter reached base at least once as the Dragons advanced 23 runners into scoring position in the resounding victory. Austin Hendrick and Mat Nelson collected back-to-back hits to start the second inning before former Whitecap Nick Quintana pounded a two-run single to push the Dragons in front 2-0. Dayton starting pitcher Joe Boyle no-hit the Whitecaps through six innings with eight strikeouts, as the Dragons piled on six runs in the sixth - highlighted by a two-run double from Allan Cerda - extending their lead to 8-0. Crouch added the Whitecaps only run with a solo homer in the seventh before Garrett Wolforth cracked a two-run double in the bottom half to increase the lead to 10-1. Five out of the last seven 'Caps batters struck out as Dragons closer Evan Kravetz set the side down in the ninth to secure the 10-1 win. Boyle (2-0) collects his second win as Whitecaps starter Keider Montero (2-1) suffers his first loss, surrendering two runs through four innings with five strikeouts. The Dragons improve to a league-best 27-12 as the Whitecaps fall to 18-22. The last time the 'Caps were one-hit was against Boyle and the Dragons in a 3-2 loss on April 19th in Dayton, Ohio. The loss brings West Michigan's record to 1-6 against the Dragons this season.

COLT'S STAMPEDE TO SUCCESS: Infielder Colt Keith, the Detroit Tigers No. 13 prospect, collected the Midwest League's Player of the Week award on Monday, May 9. Keith hit .407 with 11 hits and 17 total bases during the team's trip to Laning from May 4-8.

2,000 SECURED: The West Michigan Whitecaps opened the 2022 regular season with a 5-1 victory over the Great Lakes Loons for their 2,000th win in club history at Dow Diamond on April 8. The Whitecaps finished the 2021 season one victory short of the franchise milestone, but wasted no time hitting the mark in 2022. West Michigan recorded their 1,000th win when they beat the Clinton LumberKings 5-0 in Comstock Park on April 14, 2007.

BACK TO THE MIDWEST: The Midwest League, founded in 1947 and temporarily ceased in 2020, has returned as the name of the 12-team league, replacing the infamous High-A Central moniker given to the league for one season.

PROSPECTS APLENTY: The Whitecaps hold five of the Top 30 Detroit Tigers prospects, via MLB Pipeline. Players include those mentioned above on this page.

HEALTH REPORT: The 'Caps injured list holds five players in pitchers Marco Jimenez, Chris Mauloni & Cleiverth Perez, plus catcher Eliezer Alfonzo and outfielder Ulrich Bojarski.

The 22-year old makes his profesisonal debut at High-A in 2022, as Marks bypassed multiple lower levels to get a spot with West Michigan out of spring training. Grandfather, Alan, is a huge Tigers fan. Lost his Grandmother, Frieda, just before the 2022 season.

LAST APPEARANCE: Marks tossed four solid innings allowing just two hits and an unearned run while striking out three as the Whitecaps picked up a 4-2 victory over the Fort Wayne TinCaps on May 19 at Parkview Field.

2021: Marks was tremendous in going 10-2 with a 2.54 ERA in 95.2 innings. He held batters to a .232 batting average against and walked just 20 in 95.2 IP. The righty also struck out 101 batters in the process.

Known for his control, in 258 college innings, he walked just 58 batters while striking out 230.

Throws: Fastball, Changeup, Slider

MORE: Also played hockey in Sarnia, but admitted he wasn't fast enough as a defenseman. Two older brothers, Jake, pitched at University of Maine, while Jesse pitched at Adrian College. Struck out Riley Greene in 2022 Spring Training before the MLB Lockout ended.
