### WHITE FIRES QUALITY START, RIDERS FALL VIA WALK OFF:

Owen White tossed a quality start, but the Frisco RoughRiders dropped game five of the six-game series to the Midland RockHounds 5-4 in 10 innings on Saturday night from Momentum Bank Ballpark. White threw six innings, allowing just two runs on five hits while striking out five and walking two, but the Frisco (13-13) bullpen could not hold their late lead. The Riders jumped out in front early when Luisangel Acuña lifted a solo home run to right in the first, his second of the season, to make it 1-0. Acuña then added on in the third with an RBI double and Kellen Strahm punched a two-run single to right, pushing the advantage to 4-0. The RockHounds (14-12) found the scoreboard in the fourth inning on a two-run homer from Logan Davidson and scored a run in the seventh and eighth to tie the game. In the top of the ninth, Frisco had back-to-back singles from Thomas Saggese and Strahm to put two aboard with no one out, but Jax Biggers popped up a bunt that turned into a triple play, ending the inning. In the bottom of the 10th, Darel Hernaiz singled Lawrence Butler home with the winning run against Theo McDowell (0-2). Chase Cohen (3-0) earned the win for the RockHounds, throwing two scoreless innings in relief.

### IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

RoughRiders outfielder Kellen Strahm has been on fire on this road trip after getting off to a tough start this season. Through his first 13 games, he was hitting just .125/.250/.146/.396, but since April 25th to begin the series in Amarillo, he is batting .371/.463/.600/1.063 with three doubles, a triple, a home run and five RBIs while walking six times and just striking out five times. He is riding a five-game hitting streak, batting .500 (10-for-20) during those games. Over the last nine games, he has raised his average 104 points and his OPS 281 points. It was very similar to last season as Strahm was hitting just .136/.337/.226/.563 on May 14th last season through his first 22 games before slashing .305/.406/.445/.851 over his last 82 games of the season.

### MAKE THOSE HITS COUNT:

The RoughRiders have shown up where it counts with runners in scoring position this season. In those situations, they are hitting .256/.360/.418/.778 while being second in the league in home runs (nine) and RBIs (114). This compares to a regular slashline of .249/.359/.404/.763. Evan Carter is ninth in all of MiLB (min. 30 PA) with a .458 average with runners in scoring position this season.

### ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder Luisangel Acuña has been on fire to start his 2023 season. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .316 (37-for-117)/.362/.462/.824 through the first 26 games while ranking second in the Texas League in hits (37), tied for third in doubles (9), sixth in total bases (54) and second in stolen bases (14). Over his last 22 games, he is batting .343/.394/.515/.909. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (118).

### LOAD UM UP:

The RoughRiders have had a league-high 32 RBIs with the bases loaded this year, which is also second most in Double-A (Biloxi, 34). As a team, they are hitting .370 (10-for-27)/.364/.963/1.327 with four grand slams and 32 RBIs. They are one of two teams in Minor League Baseball with four grand slams this season already (Triple-A Norfolk) as Trevor Hauver hit one on Opening Day, Dustin Harris added another in San Antonio, Luisangel Acuña blasted one against Arkansas and Jax Biggers slugged one in Amarillo. The Riders have had one grand slam in each of the four series they have completed this season.

### DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

The RoughRiders have just committed 12 errors through 26 games. On Thursday in Midland, they had their first multi-error game of the year. The team's .987 fielding percentage is the second-best in Minor League Baseball. Their 12 errors are the second-fewest in the minors.

### WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 145 walks is third among non-Triple-A teams while their .359 team OBP is first in Double-A. Evan Carter has the Double-A lead with 25 walks and Dustin Harris is fourth with 23 (second in the Texas League) while Carter is first in OBP (.466) in the league and in Double-A.

### EVAN ALMIGHTY:

Outfielder Evan Carter has reached safely in 20 of his 23 games this season, batting .303 (27-for-89)/.466/.461/.927 with two doubles, four home runs, 25 walks, 20 RBIs and four stolen bases. Carter is first in the Texas League in OBP (.466), tied for seventh in RBIs (20), first in walks (24) and 11th in OPS (.927). The No. 1 prospect in the Rangers system won a MiLB Rawlings Gold Glove in 2022. The reigning Tom Greive Rangers Minor League Player of the Year, Carter joined the RoughRiders for the last week of the 2022 season and the playoffs. Carter also opened the season as the second-youngest player in the Texas League this season, trailing on 19-year-old Deyvison De Los Santos of Amarillo. Since going 0-for-4 for the first time this season on Saturday in San Antonio, Carter has walked 20 times to nine strikeouts over 15 games with a .474 OBP.

### ABOUT WYATT

-Wyatt pitched for Aurora (Mo.) High School. The team won state championship in 2018, going 30-1 with Sparks going 11-1 with a 0.93 ERA and 143 strikeouts to 14 walks in 75 innings. He also hit .357 with 26 runs scored on the offensive side.

-Aurora High School's mascot is the Houn Dawg. The school adopted its mascot decades ago when the armory — it sits just east of the football field — adopted a dog.

-Sparks was committed to Missouri State University (in Springfield, Mo.) before being drafted by the Rangers.

### 2023 SEASON

-Joined the RoughRiders from Extended Spring Training in Midland on May 2nd and threw three scoreless innings of relief to earn the victory that same day. In his first action since 2021, Sparks entered with the bases loaded a two outs in the first inning and retired the first batter he faced.

### 2022 SEASON

-Sparks missed the entire 2022 season recovering from "Tommy John" surgery.

### 2021 SEASON

-Allowed one or zero runs in seven of his 10 games for Low-A Down East.

-Placed on Injured List on July 13th with elbow injury.

-Underwent "Tommy John" surgery on August 4th.

-After making debut with Spokane, missed the rest of the season (June 21st on) with a bone spur in his right elbow.
