Syracuse Mets RHP Justin Hagenman (0-1, 6.97) vs. Worcester Red Sox RHP Cooper Criswell (0-0, 1.50)

Home Show – The Worcester Red Sox – winners of 6 of their last 7 games and back over the .500 mark for the second time this season (currently 10-9 on the year) – begin their longest homestand of the season tonight with the opener of a 7-game series vs. the Syracuse Mets at 6:05 pm at Polar Park. The 13-game homestand runs tonight (on undeniably the nicest night of the home schedule thus far) through Sunday, May 4 and starts with these 7-games vs. Syracuse (including a make-up doubleheader tomorrow afternoon at 12:05 pm) through this Sunday afternoon. After an offday on Monday, the homestand resumes one week from tonight with the opener of a 6-game set vs. the Toledo Mud Hens. Tonight's game is live on NESN+ and can be heard on NASH 98.9 FM and The Pike 100.1 FM.

HomeGoods – We may regret saying this, but the weather forecast for this week/weekend looks like the best possible stretch since last September. And if anyone is owed nice spring weather it's WooSox fans who thus far have endured one rain-out (March 29), one freeze-out (April 8), and one snow-out (April 12) among the first nine scheduled home dates at Polar Park this season. Furthermore, the temperatures during the games that were played averaged in the 40's.

Record Breakdown - Worcester is 10-9 overall this season...3-4 here at Polar Park and 7-5 on the road. They have also played nearly as many day games (5-4 in those) as night games (5-5 in those) thus far. During this 7-game series vs. Syracuse they will play four day games and three night game.

Last Series – The WooSox are now 1-2-1 in their first four series of the young season after a dominating series in Rochester last week/weekend when Worcester won 5 of the 6 games. The WooSox doubled-up the Red Wings in runs, out-scoring Rochester, 49-24 combined during the six games. Worcester had wins by scores of 7-2, 8-0, 4-3, 20-7, and 7-0 with their only loss a 12-3 defeat on Saturday. The WooSox have won 29 of their last 38 games played in Rochester. They go back to Rochester one other time this season for another 6-game series from July 8-13.

Lucky Seven – Worcester has won 6 of their last 7 games that included a 5-game winning streak from April 13-18. They are hitting .331 during those 7 games (83-for-251) with 29 2B, 10 HR, and 57 runs scored while Sox pitchers are 6-1 with a 4.12 ERA (27 ER in 59 IP) giving up 29 runs with 11 HR allowed.

Take Home a Dozen or More – This current 13-game homestand is the longest in terms of games this season while the WooSox do have another double figure homestand from July 29 – August 10 that will be 12-games vs. Lehigh Valley (for 6) and Buffalo (for 6). Worcester has played seven extended homestands of 12 games or more - featuring two series each - during their first four years of existence. They have had four winners and three losers during their seven "long" homestands in WooSox history (the first two of which included Syracuse)...

This Season vs. Syracuse – The WooSox and Mets met for what was originally to be a 3-game weekend series to begin the 2025 season here at Polar Park from March 28-30. Syracuse spoiled Worcester's home-opener on March 28 with a 4-3 victory, the clubs were rained out the next day (thus tomorrow's make-up doubleheader), and then played a single game on March 30 with the WooSox gaining a split of the series with a 12-0 whitewashing of the Mets.

Last Season vs. Syracuse– The WooSox won the 2024 season-series over Syracuse by a 13-11 margin going 5-4 vs. the Mets here at Polar Park and finishing 8-7 in Syracuse. Worcester pitchers posted a 5.07 ERA with 29 HRA vs. Syracuse last year while Sox batters hit .250 with 27 HR. The WooSox out-scored the Mets, 133-122 in the 24 games.

All-Time vs. Syracuse - Pawtucket/Worcester leads the all-time series over Syracuse by a 482-465 count.

Where Things Stand – Worcester (10-9) comes into play tonight alone in 5th place in the International League East division and 4-games behind Jacksonville who is atop the league with their 15-6 record. Syracuse, meanwhile, is 10-10 on the year and in 6th place in the IL East just a ½-game back of the WooSox.

Where Things Rank – Worcester is 3rd in Team Batting (.263) while Syracuse is 17th (.231). The WooSox have 20 HR on the season which ranks 8th in the league while their 108 runs scored are tied for 3rd in the IL. Worcester pitching is 9th in the 20-team International League with a 4.12 Team ERA while Syracuse is 6th with their 3.87 ERA.

A Winning Tradition – The 2024 Worcester Red Sox went 79-71 to post a winning season for the fourth time in as many years of existence and for the third year in a row under manager Chad Tracy. Trace is only the second Red Sox Triple-A manager to ever post three consecutive winning seasons. Darrell Johnson did so from 1971-73 (the first two years when the Red Sox Triple-A club was in Louisville before moving to Pawtucket in 1973). Worcester finished 35-40 during the first half last year but then improved to 44-31 in the second half. Overall the 2024 WooSox went 40-34 at home and 39-37 on the road. The 2021 WooSox had a 74-54 record during their abbreviated inaugural season, the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73, and the 2023 club posted a 79-68 mark.

2024 WooSox Batters Led the Way – Worcester led all 20 International League clubs in a host of team offensive categories last season. The WooSox led the league with 869 runs scored (Scranton/Wilkes-Barre was next with 846 runs scored). The Sox also led the IL with 786 walks (Toledo was a distant 2nd with 676 walks). Worcester paced the league by a wide margin with an impressive .369 on-base pct. as the WooSox were the only team in the IL with an OBP of over .359 (Scranton/WB was 2nd at .358). Furthermore, Worcester had the 2nd best OPS in the league at .795 (Columbus was 1st at .804).

2024 Rankings – Worcester finished 5th in the IL in team batting with a .259 average. On the pitching side, the Sox were 10th in team ERA (4.84). Sox pitchers allowed the 2nd fewest HR in the league (141 HRA while Nashville had 139 HRA). Defensively, the WooSox were 11th with a .979 field pct. (107 errors in 5126 total chances).

Players Aplenty - The 2024 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records (previously set by the 2023 WooSox) as they made 281 player transactions during the 2024 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used 84 different players in 2024 (37 position players and 47 pitchers) to better the mark of 79 players in 2023. Ironically, the 2021 WooSox broke a long-standing Red Sox Triple-A record when they used 72 different players to beat the 1995 Pawtucket Red Sox (during a strike year when replacement players were used for the first month+ of that season) and the 2006 PawSox who each employed 70 different players. When Chad Tracy made his Worcester debut in 2022, the WooSox quickly set a new record using 75 different players (that was immediately topped first in 2023 and again in 2024).

WooSox to BoSox - The WooSox sent 28 different players to Boston during the 2024 season (not counting rehab players). Those 28 do not include OF Rob Refsnyder, RHP Nick Pivetta, OF Tyler O'Neill, OF Masataka Yoshida, RHP Chris Martin, OF Wilyer Abreu, 1B Triston Casas, INF Trevor Story, and RHP Lucas Sims who were all injury rehab recalls from Worcester to Boston in 2024.

Sea Dog to Woofsters – A total of 22 different players were promoted from Double-A Portland to Triple-A Worcester last season.

PORTLAND SEA DOGS (AA) GAME RECAP – The Portland Sea Dogs (7-6) will look to snap their 4-game losing streak when they return home to face the Reading Fightin' Phils in the opener of a 6-game series tonight.

WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES – The WooSox today will add INF **Nick Sogard** and RHP **Hunter Dobbins** back on to their roster following their stints in Boston last week. Sogard was recalled to Boston last Wednesday when Red Sox INF Alex Bregman was placed on the Paternity Leave List but did not play and was optioned back to Worcester Friday night when Bregman was reinstated. Dobbins was recalled to Boston Friday for the second time this season and he earned his second victory in as many starts for the Red Sox on Friday vs. the White Sox with 6 strong innings before being optioned to Worcester on Saturday.

The WooSox today also transferred RHP **Jack Anderson** back to Double-A Portland and reinstated RHP **Austin Adams** from the Development List. Adams, who will turn 34 on May 5, has pitched in 188 Major League games with Washington (2017-19), Seattle (2019), San Diego (2020-22), Arizona (2023), and Oakland (2024). He was signed by the Red Sox as a Minor League free agent in January, 2025. In 188 career games in the big leagues (186 in relief), Austin has posted a 7-7 record with a 4.10 ERA along with 223 strikeouts in 155.2 innings. In 277 Minor League appearances (all in relief), he has compiled a 17-14 mark with a 3.32 ERA and 502 SO in 352.2 IP. The Florida native pitched at the University of South Florida before being chosen by the Angels in the 8th round of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft.

Since the start of the season (3½ weeks) the WooSox have sent RHP Hunter Dobbins (twice), RHP Robert Stock, C Blake Sabol, RHP Josh Winckowski, RHP Michael Fulmer, and INF Nick Sogard to Boston (although Stock, Sogard & Dobbins are back with Worcester and Fulmer elected to become a free agent following his outright assignment); RHP Quinn Priester was traded; and OF Corey Rosier and C Enderso Lira were sent to Double-A Portland (although Rosier rejoined the WooSox on April 20). All are from the WooSox 2025 Opening Day Roster.
