This Afternoon: The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the rubber match in a three-game season-opening series at the Dayton Dragons, the High-A affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds. The Nuts won the season opener Friday, but the Dragons struck back with a matinee victory yesterday.

Yesterday Afternoon: Dragons 8, Lugnuts 5. James González, Mitch Myers and Colton Johnson (making his first MiLB appearance in 945 days) combined on a four-hit shutout and Cameron Masterman doubled home Will Simpson with two outs in the sixth inning, helping the Lugnuts spoil Rhett Lowder's professional debut on Opening Night at Day Air Ballpark.

LUG NOTES

2023 Retrospective: The Lugnuts finished the season with a 60-71 record... catcher **Daniel Susac** won the Midwest League batting title with a .303 average... 11 former Lugnuts (**Ryan Noda**, **Hogan Harris**, **Mason Miller**, **Garrett Acton**, **Samad Taylor**, **Tyler Soderstrom**, **Lawrence Butler**, **Hagen Danner**, **Drew Millas**, **Joey Estes** and **José Espada**) made their Major League debuts, bringing the total to 184 MLB Lugnuts all-time... **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.** who played in the 2016 Crosstown Showdown, won the 2023 All-Star Home Run Derby... reliever **Kumar Nambiar** represented the Minor League Baseball Players' union in a panel of new labor unions with President Biden and Vice President Harris at the White House; Nambiar retired at the end of the season and now works in the Baltimore Orioles' analytics department... the World Series was won by the Texas Rangers, with assistant hitting coach **Seth Conner** (2013-14 with Lansing), over the Arizona Diamondbacks, starring 2019 Nuts catcher **Gabriel Moreno** and 2014 pitcher **Miguel Castro**.

A Good First Impression: The Lugnuts played the Michigan State Spartans on Wednesday in the 16th Crosstown Showdown exhibition, winning easily 18-0. Pitchers **Grant Judkins**, **Hunter Breault** and **Yehizon Sanchez** combined to hold the Spartans to two base runners on a pair of base hits while the offense blasted four home runs: a solo shot and a grand slam from **Will Simpson** and three-run homers by **Joshwan Wright** and **Henry Bolte**. Wright reached base in all four plate appearances (single, homer, two walks), but was outdone by **Colby Halter**, who reached base five times thanks to two singles, two walks and an HBP.

Prospecting: The Nuts' Opening Day roster includes two MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 12) and first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 30). Bolte, the A's No. 2 outfield prospect, was selected 56th overall in 2022 from Palo Alto High School, where he led all California high schoolers with 13 home runs. He spent the 2023 season with Single-A Stockton, where he slashed .257/.356/.421 in 112 games, collecting 17 doubles, five triples, 14 home runs and 32 stolen bases. Simpson, the A's No. 2 first base prospect, impressed with a .319/.367/.543 line in his professional debut after he was drafted in the 15th round from the University of Washington last year.

Familiar Faces: Lansing returns 17 players from the 2023 ballclub, not including second-year manager **Craig Conklin** and fourth-year pitching coach **Don Schulze**. The returners include **James Gonzalez**, **Euribiel Angeles**, **Brayan Buelvas**, **Jonny Butler** and **Joshwan Wright**, each of whom appeared in games for the Lugnuts in both 2022 and 2023, as well as lefty **Jack Owen**, who has pitched effectively for the Lugnuts during each of the last three seasons.

Come Together: The Lugnuts' Opening Day roster includes players representing 10 states, Puerto Rico, and six countries: Canada, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Panama and Venezuela.

Pure Fire: On Tuesday, 2022 Lugnut **Mason Miller** delivered the five fastest pitches clocked in the Majors this year in a two-inning scoreless stint vs. Boston, ranging from 101.4 mph to 102.4 mph. Miller's third and final appearance for the Lugnuts was on September 10, 2022, vs. the Dayton Dragons, whiffing seven batters in three hitless innings. He made his Major League debut seven months later.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2011: Due to field conditions, the Lugnuts had Opening Day postponed against West Michigan at Cooley Law School Stadium – the first of three straight games that would be postponed due to swampy field conditions because of the melting of permafrost.

2017: In their Lugnuts debut, on a snowy day at Great Lakes, Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., and Bo Bichette both hit oppo homers to help the Nuts beat the Loons, 6-3, in Game 1 of a season-opening doubleheader. In Game 2, Tayler Saucedo (2 2/3) and Geno Encina (4 1/3) combined on a four-hit shutout in a 2-0 victory.

In a Nutshell: Watters first appeared for the Lugnuts on August 31, 2022, pitching against Cubs rehabber Wade Miley at South Bend in his second professional appearance... he then spent the full 2023 season for the Nuts.

Entering Draft Day: Rated Keith Law's No. 68 draft prospect for The Athletic, with Law writing, "Watters started the year in the Mountaineers' bullpen, where he hit 99 mph a few times, so the team moved him to the rotation around midseason, where he struggled more with control (37 walks in 50.2 innings) but also showed enough that some scouts think he can start in pro ball. Watters sits 94-97 mph with a power slider in the mid-80s that can miss bats ... when he locates it. It's not a bad delivery, with a reasonably short arm stroke and strong finish, so that's not the reason he doesn't throw strikes, but it's true across all of his pitches. It's much more likely he ends up a power reliever with two plus pitches. But with enough of a changeup to start and a delivery that looks like it should work, I wouldn't be surprised to see a pro team keep him in the rotation."... Fangraphs' No. 96 draft prospect.

Inked: Selected 124th overall by the A's in the 4th round and signed for \$491,750... highest pitcher taken by the Athletics in 2022 (following first-round catcher Daniel Susac and three straight outfielders in high schooler Henry Bolte in the second round, Michigan Wolverine Clark Elliott in the compensatory round B, and Mercer slugger Colby Thomas in the third round).

WVU to the Pros: First of three Mountaineers selected in the 2022 draft... the 2021 Fort Wayne TinCaps featured two WVU teammates in 2021 draftees Jackson Wolf (4th round) and Ryan Bergert (6th round); pitched against Bergert on May 26 and tossed 5 2/3 scoreless innings, allowing only one hit... the last WVU player taken in the first round was Alek Manoah by Toronto in 2019, who in 2022 joined John Means as the only Mountaineers to be named MLB All-Stars... the last West Virginia player to suit up for the Lugnuts was Ryan McBroom, who won the 2015 Midwest League Most Valuable Player award.

Glory Days: Starred for the Bland County HS Rockets as an all-state baseball player as well as in basketball (where he regularly posted double-doubles and topped out at 45 points in one game) and football.

Off to College: Did not receive much notice before his high velocity was discovered at a tryout in Morgantown... named to the Academic All-Big 12 Rookie Team as a freshman (5 G, 4.70 ERA, 7 2/3 IP, 4 R, 6 BB, 11 K)... as a sophomore, made 19 appearances: 3.33 ERA, 27 IP, 15 H, 11 R, 32 BB, bullpen-leading 53 K, .165 avg. allowed, tied for team lead with four saves; named Academic All-Big 12 Second Team; NCBWA Stopper of the Year Midseason Watch List... made first college start in the 2021 Big 12 Championship vs. Texas: 3 IP, 0 H, 1 R, 4 BB, 8 K... as a junior in 2022, named preseason All-American; dominated early as team closer and was moved into role as Friday starter; struck out 15 Texas Longhorns in 6 1/3 IP on May 7; overall: 18 G, 11 GS, 3-7, 6.22 ERA, 59 1/3 IP, 64 H, 44 R, 41 BB, 75 K; named All-Big 12 Honorable Mention.

Hometown Hero: Home city of Rocky Gap, Virginia, is in the Ridge-and-Valley Appalachians, located near the West Virginia border... neighboring city: Bluefield, home of the Bluefield Ridge Runners, previously known as the Bluefield Orioles and Bluefield Blue Jays, which fed such stars as Alejandro Kirk and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. to the Lugnuts when both were part of the Jays' system... cousin is Jason Michaels, who played 11 years (2001-2011) in MLB.

Prospecting: MLB Pipeline had ranked Watters the No. 26 prospect in the A's organization and the No. 12 pitching prospect until midseason 2023... his grades: Fastball 60, Curve 60, Changeup 45, Control 45, Overall 40... his scouting report: "Watters is a strong presence on the mound at 6-foot-4. His fastball was up to 99 mph during his junior year and touched triple digits in his time as a reliever. He also possesses a plus pitch in his power curve, missing plenty of bats as a true 12-to-6 that sits in the mid-80s. There's also a mid-80s changeup in there, though it's less polished compared to his other two offerings. Command will need to improve for Watters to have a chance to start at the next level. While the stuff was high-octane in college, he usually had little idea of how to locate it. Given his track record as a reliever, there's a strong chance he ends up back in the bullpen, where he can rear back and overpower hitters with two plus pitches."
