### INDY BITS

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Canaan Smith-Njigba launched a go-ahead home run in the seventh inning, but the Louisville Bats responded with two runs in the bottom half to defeat the Indianapolis Indians on Saturday night at Louisville Slugger Field, 6-5. The Indians jumped out to an early lead courtesy of an RBI single off the bat of Henry Davis and run-scoring groundout by Gilberto Celestino. That lead didn't last long, either, with the Bats plating two in their first trip to the plate. Louisville then took its first lead in the sixth when P.J. Higgins singled home Edwin Rios. Two batters later, Austin Wynns doubled to bring home Higgins. A pair of walks in the fifth inning began Indianapolis' comeback, with Billy McKinney singling home Smith-Njigba to cut the deficit to one run. After a leadoff double by Celestino in the sixth, Matt Gorski punched a soft grounder through the right side of the infield to tie the game. With the game knotted at two runs apiece after six innings, Smith-Njigba launched his first home run of the campaign to right field to give Indianapolis its first lead since the top of the first. The lead was short-lived, however, when Rios matched the effort with a two-run shot in the bottom of the seventh, scoring the series-clinching run.

**HOME V. ROAD:** While racking up the second-most home wins in the International League this season (13), the Indians also have the least number of road wins (4) out of all 20 teams in the league. They are now 3-3 in series decisions this season, with all three series victories coming at home (vs. Memphis, St. Paul and Buffalo) and all three losses coming on the road (at Louisville [2x], Toledo and Omaha).

**CANAAN CRANKS ONE:** Canaan Smith-Njigba launched his first home run of the 2024 campaign in the seventh inning last night, breaking a 2-2 tie to give Indianapolis its second lead of the game, first since the top of the first inning. The left-handed hitter homered a career-high 15 games with Indianapolis last season, besting his previous career-high of 11 with Yankees-affiliate Single-A Charleston in 2019. He went 2-for-3 last night with three runs, a home run, RBI and two walks, marking his second consecutive multi-hit game and third in the month of May. In 23 total games with Indy this season, he is hitting .270 (20-for-74) with 13 runs, six extra-base hits, eight RBI, 15 walks and 19 strikeouts.

**WELCOME TO TRIPLE-A:** Outfielder Matt Fraizer, who was promoted to Indianapolis from Double-A Altoona on Tuesday, went 2-for-4 in his Triple-A debut last night at Louisville. He singled off starter Lyon Richardson in the top of the fourth inning for his first Triple-A hit, and then contributed a single to an Indians rally attempt while trailing by one run in the top of the eighth inning. He appeared in 24 games with Altoona to start the season, logging a .197 batting average (15-for-76) with 12 runs, five extra-base hits and five RBI. In 298 career games with the Curve from 2021-24, he hit .239 (259-for-1084) with 155 runs, 49 doubles, 13 triples, 19 home runs and 117 RBI.

**GAU WOWED:** Righty reliever Chris Gau made his second appearance with Indianapolis after being promoted from Double-A Altoona earlier this week and spun 4.0 one-hit, shutout innings in relief of starter J.C. Flowers last night to stave off the Louisville offense as Indy mounted a comeback. Previously, he made seven appearances (two starts) with Altoona and went 0-3 with a 2.45 ERA (4er/14.2ip) and 15 strikeouts. The 27-year-old has appeared in 14 total career Triple-A games (three starts) between Indy and Durham from 2022-24, going 0-2 with a 4.37 ERA (11er/22.2ip) and 18 strikeouts.

**HANK ON BASE:** Catcher and University of Louisville product Henry Davis went 1-for-3 with an RBI and two walks last night to extend his on-base streak to all five games at Louisville this week. He was hit by pitches four times in his first three games with Indianapolis this season after being hit once in 23 games with Pittsburgh. His on-base percentage currently sits at .435 through his first five games with Indy after being optioned by Pittsburgh last week. In 14 Triple-A games with Indy last season, he hit .375 (18-for-48) with seven runs, six extra-base hits, a .516 on-base percentage and 1.120 OPS.

**JAKE ON BASE:** Jake Lamb extended his current on-base streak to 16 games since April 18 after being hit by a pitch in the sixth inning on Friday night. During that streak, he is hitting .377 (20-for-53) with 10 runs, seven doubles, one home run, 12 RBI, .456 on-base percentage and 1.022 OPS. He has now reached base safely in 27 of 28 games this season and leads the International League in batting average (.359, 33-for-92) while also ranking sixth in on-base percentage (.452) and eighth in OPS (.995).

**TODAY:** The Indians will try to leave Louisville with two wins in the six-game series in today's finale at Louisville Slugger Field, with first pitch scheduled for 1:05 PM. The Bats took two of three meetings during the opening series between the two teams from 3/29-3/31 and lead the season series, 6-2, with four wins this week. In a rematch of the series-opener on Tuesday, LHP Eric Lauer (2-1, 3.95) will take the mound against RHP Carson Spiers (2-1, 2.86). On Tuesday, Spiers got the win after tossing 6.0 shutout innings, while Lauer gave up three with seven strikeouts over his 4.1 innings.

**THIS DATE IN 2007:** With a double vs. Ottawa in a 5-2 win at Victory Field, Rajai Davis began a Victory Field era record 21-game hitting streak that lasted through June 3. The streak tied Eduardo Perez's streak from 1996 for third all-time in Indians history, trailing Frank Sigafos (38 games, 1933) and Ed Stevens (33 games, 1951). Davis was recalled by Pittsburgh before he could extend his hitting streak and spent the remainder of the season at the major league level.

## TODAY'S PITCHER

**Eric Lauer:** Right-hander Eric Lauer is set to make his second start of the series today at 1:05 PM at Louisville Slugger Field.

**Last Outing:** Lauer took the bump for the Indians on Tuesday to begin the series and fanned seven batters across 4.1 three-run innings to take the loss.

**Against the Bats:** Lauer has made two career appearances against Louisville, going 0-1 with a 7.71 (6er/7.0ip) and eight strikeouts. Both of those appearances have come this season.

**Lauer Power:** Eric Lauer split the 2023 season between the Milwaukee Brewers, Triple-A Nashville Sounds and the ACL Brewers. He made 23 total appearances (19 starts) while having his season shortened by right-shoulder impingement.

**Miscellaneous:** Lauer was selected by San Diego in the 1st round (25th overall) of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Kent State. He had his contract first selected by the Padres on April 24, 2018 and made his MLB debut that night at Colorado. He was signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent on March 22, 2024.
