TONIGHT: The Stripers begin the second leg of a 12-game road trip with game one of a six-game series vs. the Norfolk Tides (Baltimore Orioles) at Harbor Park. It is the 13th of 18 meetings between the two clubs this year, and the seventh of 12 games Gwinnett will play in Norfolk.

AT NORFOLK: The Stripers are 63-66 (.488) in 129 games all-time at Norfolk's Harbor Park, including 3-3 (.500) in six games this season. Gwinnett is 6-6-0 in 12 season road series against the Tides all-time (2009-current), including 4-2-0 over the last six years (2015-current).

ROSARIO ON REHAB: Atlanta Braves' OF Eddie Rosario is batting .300 (3-for-10, 2 RBI) in two games since joining Gwinnett on a rehab assignment on 6/25. He is on the 10day IL following a procedure to correct blurred vision and swelling in his right retina. Rosario, the 2021 NLCS Most Valuable Player (.560, 3 HR, 9 RBI, 1.647 OPS in 6G vs. the LA Dodgers), is rehabbing with Gwinnett for the second time in his career (13G from 8/11-26, 2021).

KINGS OF THE "K": Stripers pitchers lead Triple-A in strikeouts with 742 in 72 games (10.31 SO per game). That's 11 more than Sacramento of the PCL (2nd, 731 SO in 72G). Gwinnett last led Triple-A in strikeouts for a full season in 2011 (team-record 1,223 SO). Kyle Muller (1st, 99), Tucker Davidson (7th, 66), Bryce Elder (T-13th, 59), and Huascar Ynoa (T-13th, 59) all rank among the International League's top 15 in strikeouts.

POWER UP: The Stripers recorded their seventh game with at least three homers this season on Sunday in Nashville, but fell to 5-2 in such games with the 9-8 loss. Grevson Jenista (solo, #8) and Preston Tucker (2-run, #6) both homered off RHP Josh Lindblom as Gwinnett built a 5-2 lead, and Alex Dickerson (2-run, #6) hit a game-tying shot in the ninth off RHP Zack Brown to send the game to extras. Overall, Gwinnett is 21-14 (.600) with at least one homer.

SHEW-MAKING IT HAPPEN: Braden Shewmake is riding a season-best eight-game hitting streak since 6/7, batting .344 (11-for-32, 2 2B, 1 HR, 4 R, 4 RBI, 1 SB, .871 OPS) in that stretch. In 51 games overall on his Triple-A debut with Gwinnett, he's batting .272 (52-for-191, 10 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR. 27 R, 12 RBI, 5 SB, .723 OPS).

RISING WATERS: Over his last eight games since 6/18, Drew Waters is batting .303 (10-for-33, 2 3B, 1 HR, 5 R, 4 RBI, 2 SB, .910 OPS) with three multi-hit efforts. In 38 games overall this season, he's batting .257 (38-for-148, 6 2B, 3 3B, 4 HR, 21 R, 14 RBI, 3 SB, .728 OPS).

- Start it With a Bang: Waters has three XBH on the first pitch of the game this year (leadoff homers on 5/3 vs. CLT and 5/11 at DUR, leadoff triple on 6/11 at JAX).
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2019. Waters is batting .249 (164-for-659, 33 2B, 4 3B, 17 HR, 108 R, 62 RBI, 34 SB, .714 OPS) in 167 games.

TUCK TERRIFIC IN JUNE: Tonight's starting pitcher Tucker Davidson has logged three quality starts in four outings in June, going 1-2 with a 3.08 ERA (9 ER in 25.0 IP). 1.18 WHIP, .248 BAA, and 10.93 SO/9.0 IP ratio (32 SO). He tossed 6.2 scoreless innings (6 H, 0 BB, 9 SO) in his last start on 6/22 at Nashville, his second win of the year. It was his second scoreless start this year, first since 5/17 with Atlanta at Milwaukee (5.0 IP. 3 H. 3 SO in 3-0 win).

CAN'T TOUCH TONKIN: Michael Tonkin fanned a seasonhigh five batters over 2.0 scoreless innings (1 H, 0 BB) on Sunday in Nashville. The outing extended his scoreless innings streak to 8.1 spanning his last seven outings since 6/5. In that stretch, he's posting a 0.48 WHIP (3 H, 1 BB), .107 BAA, 16.20 SO/9.0 IP ratio (15 SO), and two saves (2-for-2). In 22 games overall with Gwinnett, Tonkin is 3-0 with a 2.35 ERA (6 ER in 23.0 IP), .186 BAA, 15.26 SO/9.0 IP ratio (39 SO), and five saves (5-for-6).

DESHIELDS STOPPED AT 11: Delino DeShields Jr. saw his 11-game on-base streak snapped on Saturday at Nashville (0-for-3). He hit .414 (12-for-29, 1 2B, 1 HR, 10 R, 5 RBI, 5 SB, 10 BB) on the streak from 6/3-6/23. Overall with Gwinnett, DeShields has reached base safely in 41 of 49 games with a plate appearance (83.7%), batting .275 (38for-138, 5 2B, 1 HR, 24 R, 15 RBI). He ranks among IL leaders in stolen bases (T-9th, 15) and walks (13th, 35).

MULLDOZING: Kyle Muller produced his fifth consecutive quality start on Saturday in a loss at Nashville (7.0 IP, 3 H, 2 ER. 2 BB. 7 SO. 1 HR. season-high 105 pitches). Over that five-start span, he is 2-1 with a 1.87 ERA (7 ER in 33.2 IP), 0.77 WHIP, .171 BAA, and 11.49 SO/9.0 IP ratio (43 SO).

- IL Leaderboard: Muller leads the league in strikeouts (99) and is among the top 10 in ERA (2nd. 2.96), innings (2nd, 76.0), WHIP (2nd, 1.08), and BAA (3rd, .215).
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2021, he is 9-8 with a 3.18 ERA (55 ER in 155.2 IP), .219 BAA, and 192 strikeouts (11.10 SO/9.0 IP ratio) in 30 starts.

CASTEEL IN THE CLUTCH: Ryan Casteel lifted an oppositefield two-run homer (#6) to right off RHP Alec Bettinger on Thursday at Nashville, leading the Stripers to a 4-1 win. Of Casteel's 15 hits this season, 10 have gone for extra bases (3 doubles, 1 triple, 6 homers). For his Gwinnett career, 48.0% of his hits have been for extra bases (24 of 50), including nine doubles, one triple, and 14 homers.

DEMERITTE RETURNS: Travis Demeritte is batting .158 (6for-38, 4 R, 1 RBI, 2 SB) in 10 games with Gwinnett since being optioned by Atlanta on 5/28. He hit .213 (19-for-89, 2 2B, 3 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI) in 26 games during his first career stint with the Braves from 4/22-5/27.

• GWN Career: Demeritte has reached base safely in 169 of 199 games (84.9%) with the Stripers since 2019, batting .277 (191-for-689, 49 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 130 R, 138 RBI, 15 SB, .917 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Mejia

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) . In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... On 6/9/22 at Jacksonville, he became the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 career wins ... Began his managerial career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for MiLB Manager of the Year ... Coached at the Braves' Alternate Training Site in 2020.

TONIGHT'S START: Tucker Davidson makes his 10th Triple-A start of the season in the opening game of a six-game series at Norfolk.

- IL Leaderboard: Entering play, ranks seventh in the league in strikeouts (66)
- GWN Career: Makes his 18th career start with Gwinnett ... Is 5-6 with a 2.95 ERA (31 ER in 94.2 IP), .222 BAA, and 106 strikeouts (10.08 SO/9.0 IP ratio) since 2019.
- On the Road: Makes his ninth career Triple-A road start ... Is 3-2 with a 1.80 ERA (9 ER in 45.0 IP), .193 BAA, and 55 strikeouts (11.00 SO/9.0 IP ratio).

PROSPECTING: Davidson is currently ranked the Atlanta Braves' No. 7 prospect by MLB.com. He is the third-highest ranked pitching prospect on Gwinnett's active roster, behind LHP Kyle Muller (No. 3) and RHP Bryce Elder (No. 4).

2022 WITH GWINNETT: Has had two stints with the Stripers, 4/12-5/16 (1-1, 4.44 ERA, .214 BAA in 5 starts) and 5/29-current (1-2, 3.08 ERA, .248 BAA in 4 starts) ... 6/11 at JAX: Set a career high with 11 strikeouts over 7.0 IP (5 H, 3 ER) in a 3-2 loss ... 6/22 at NAS: Earned second win with 6.2 scoreless IP 6 H, 0 BB, 9 SO) in 7-2 win.

2022 WITH ATLANTA: Made the Atlanta Braves' Opening Day roster for the first time in his career ...
