**MIDDLE INNING SURGE LEADS TO SIXTH STRAIGHT WIN FOR 'CATS:** The Fisher Cats put up six runs in the sixth inning and held Bowie hitless in innings six through nine, as they won game three of the series 10-2. Vinny Capra launched his fourth home run of the season, setting a career high, as eight Fisher Cats drove in runs to deliver the sixth straight victory for New Hampshire. It is the first six game winning streak since the perfect playoff run that delivered the Eastern League Championship in 2018.

**FISHER CATS ON THE LEADERBOARD:** Reigning Double-A Northeast player of the week Gabriel Moreno leads all of Double-A with his .385 average and 44 RBI and a 1.122 OPS. Otto Lopez is third in Double-A with an average .354. Samad Taylor leads all of Double-A with 42 runs, as he is T-1<sup>st</sup> in Double-A with 17 steals and is T-4<sup>th</sup> with 12 homers. The Fisher Cats as a team are hitting a whopping .300 in the month of June, far and away the best mark in all of Double-A.

**BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY:** June 25, 2017- Gunner Heidt (hite) went 3-for-4 with a two-run homer as the Fisher Cats topped Binghamton 5-3 at Delta Dental Stadium. Richard Urena also went deep for New Hampshire. Both longballs came off Rumble Pony knuckleballer Mickey Jannis. Connor Greene went five innings to earn his fourth win and Andrew Case picked up the save. Jannis made his MLB debut for the Orioles, at the age of 33, on Wednesday night against the Blue Jays.

**MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS:** One of the most productive days in single-system history, Blue Jays affiliates went 7-0 yesterday, combining for 73 runs. The Blue Jays put up nine runs in the first three innings to win their fifth straight, 9-0. Buffalo swept Syracuse in their double-header, winning 5-4 and 8-5. Zach Logue is on the mound for the Bisons this evening. Dunedin won twice against St. Lucie, 16-7 and 12-11. Vancouver defeated Eugene 13-9 in a game which took over four hours to complete.

**COMING UP:** The Fisher Cats take on Bowie for the first and only time this season, before returning to Manchester for their fourth series of the season against the Portland Sea Dogs.

**ROSTER MOVES: June 23:** RHP Reilly Hovis signed minor league contract with Toronto Blue Jays and assigned to New Hampshire. Hovis went 1-2 with a 2.96 ERA in six games (three starts) with Atlantic League Gastonia Honey Hunters (Independent). 27-year old was originally drafted by the Marlins in the 9<sup>th</sup> round of the 2015 draft (North Carolina). Advanced as far as Double-A Jacksonville in 2018 before release.

## STARTERS:

Maximo Castillo gets the start for the Fisher Cats, as he looks to become the first New Hampshire pitcher to reach the five-win plateau. His last outing was a six-inning relief appearance on Saturday, when he pitched innings three through eight against Hartford following Elvis Luciano's 1.2 inning start on his return from injury. He holds a record of 4-1 with a 5.21 ERA.

For the Baysox, Mike Baumann will be on the mound for his sixth start this season in Bowie. He spent part of 2019 with the Baysox as well. He has not thrown for more than four innings in any game this season, and is coming off of a three hit, two run performance in four innings against Akron on June 19<sup>th</sup>. Baumann was a third-round selection in 2017 out of Jacksonville, and he is a native of Mahtomedi, Minnesota.
