LAST TIME OUT...

MOOSIC, Pa. (August 7, 2021) – Three Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders pitchers combined to strike out 14 Worcester Red Sox batters in a 2-1 loss on Saturday night at PNC Field.

Going up against seven-time American League All-Star and MLB rehabber Chris Sale, RailRiders opener Brian Keller turned one of his best outings of the season. He tossed 3.0 scoreless innings, scattering three hits while striking out five and not allowing a walk.

He was followed by Sean Boyle, making his Triple-A debut. Boyle turned in 4.0 scoreless frames, allowing four hits, striking out five and walking one. Before this year, the right-hander had never pitched in full season ball, and this season had only seven appearances above Low-A.

The RailRiders offense sputtered against the Red Sox, garnering just two hits against Sale – a double by Thomas Milone and an Andrew Velazquez triple – and nothing else until the ninth inning.

In the top of the ninth, Adam Warren (3-2) allowed a two-run home run to Tate Matheny after a 10-pitch battle to finally break the scoreless deadlock.

Donny Sands led off the bottom of the ninth with a double against Zack Kelly, and scored on an Armando Alvarez groundout to cut the deficit to 2-1. However, Kelly settled down to retire the side and seal his first save of the season.

NEWS & NOTES

ROUGH PATCH: The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders are mired in their worst stretch of the season, having lost three straight games and six of their last seven. The two three-game losing skids for SWB in the past week are only the second and third times this year that the RailRiders have dropped three in a row. Through 29 completed games, the RailRiders have not dropped four straight games. In 2019, SWB had three four-game losing streaks and one six-game losing streak. There was also one stretch where the team lost 11-of-12 games played from Aug. 6 - Aug. 17.

NUKE VOIT: For the third time this season, New York Yankees first baseman **Luke Voit** commences a MLB rehab assignment with the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders this week. Since being acquired in a trade with the St. Louis Cardinals in 2018, Voit has played in a total of 22 games with the RailRiders and has tormented opposing pitchers to the tune of a .359/.425/.718 batting line. The 2020 American League home run champion has clubbed seven doubles and seven homers in his time with SWB, and has 16 RBI, 8 walks and 17 strikeouts to add to his totals.

THEY'RE HAVING A FIRE!...SALE: The Worcester Red Sox pitching staff has put up some gaudy strikeout numbers in the first five games of the series. After striking out 15 batters on Tuesday, the WooSox fanned 11 on Wednesday, 18 on Thursday, 15 more on Friday and only 11 on Saturday for a total of 70 punchouts in 47.0 innings (13.40 K/9). Tonight, the Sox turn to Kutter Crawford, who fanned nine batters in 5.0 innings of work on Tuesday.

RECORD-SETTING CLUB: Following Thursday night's game in which RailRiders hitters struck out 18 times in 11 innings, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has already set or tied five single-game franchise records this season. Some are dubious, such as Longest 9-Inning Game (4:09, 5/6 @ SYR), Most Walks Issued (16, 7/28 @ SYR) and Most Strikeouts (18, 8/5 vs WOR), while others are positive, like Most Stolen Bases (7, 6/29 @ WOR) and Fewest Hits Allowed, 9-Inning Game (0, 7/21 vs ROC).

DON'T STOP THE STEAL: RailRiders INF **Andrew Velazquez** enters play leading Triple-A East with 26 stolen bases on the season, while only being caught three times for an outstanding 89.7% success rate. Through 68 games, Velazquez has tied the RailRiders Era (2013 - Present) record for steals in a season, drawing even with **Tyler Wade** (2017) and **Antoan Richardson** (2014). The Yankees-Era (2007 - Present) franchise record belongs to **Brett Gardner**, who swiped 37 bags in 94 games in 2008. The all-time SWB record stands at 44 steals by **Tommy Barrett** in the inaugural 1989 Red Barons season. Velazquez stole a career-high 50 bases in 2014 with the South Bend Silver Hawks. He has stolen three bases in a game twice this season, both coming against Worcester (6/27 & 8/5).

CHANGE IS THE ONLY CONSTANT: Tuesday's contest with Worcester marked the first games back in Scranton/Wilkes-Barre for **Rob Brantly** and **Estevan Florial** following their respective stints with the Yankees due to a rash of injuries and a COVID-19 outbreak at the MLB level. Brantly responded with a 3-for-4 game, including his first triple since 2019, and Florial was 0-for-3 with a walk. Owing to another COVID-19 outbreak on the Yankees roster, RHPs **Luis Gil**, **Stephen Ridings** and **Brody Koerner** were all added to the Yankees on Tuesday, with all three making their MLB debuts in a 13-1 win over the Baltimore Orioles. Gil went 6.0 scoreless innings for the win, and was returned to the RailRiders following the game. OFs **Ryan LaMarre** and **Greg Allen** have also been returned to SWB after time spend filling in at the MLB level. However, Brantly was recalled by the Yankees on Thursday as a COVID replacement player.

FALLING BEHIND: The RailRiders have made a habit of notching comeback wins this season, but the flip side is that is predicated on the team falling behind in many games this season. Through 78 games this season, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has allowed the first run in 43 games, notching a 23-20 record in those contests. The RailRiders have been out-scored 83-69 (-14) in the first two innings of games this season, a shocking number considering the team is +101 in run differential this season, the second-best mark in Triple-A East (Durham, +174). Most of the damage has been done in the middle innings, with SWB sporting an impressive +89 run differential in innings four through six.

IT'S THE FINAL STRETCH (DA NA NA NA): In lieu of a traditional playoff in Triple-A Baseball, MLB announced last Wednesday that all Triple-A teams will compete in a 10-game postseason tournament called the Triple-A Final Stretch from Sept. 22 through Oct. 3. Each league will have a regular season champion, crowned for having the best record across 120 games, and a Final Stretch champion, crowned for having the best record in the added 10 games. Unlike any tournament you may be familiar with, the Triple-A Final Stretch has a set schedule of opponents and you continue to play even if you are eliminated from contention. MLB announced the RailRiders will play Syracuse from 9/22-26 at PNC Field and finish the Final Stretch at Rochester from 9/28-10/3. MLB also announced it will give a prize to the winners.

LAST TIME OUT: Krook struggled in the series opener with the WooSox, walking five batters in 2.0 innings of work, ultimately getting tagged with the loss in a 7-2 Red Sox win. He has walked 11 batters in only 5.0 innings across his last two outings, while striking out three total batters. The left-hander allowed three runs on four hits, but needed 63 pitches to get through his innings. In his last three starts, Krook has given up 11 runs in 10.0 frames, elevating his season ERA from 2.37 to 4.97.

2021 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season with the Double-A Somerset Patriots break camp roster.
- Promoted to Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on June 15, the first mid-season promotion of his career.
- Posted a 44:11 K:BB ratio, 0.89 WHIP in 29.1 innings with Somerset before the promotion, including 17 strikeouts in 10.0 innings in his last two starts.
- Had a streak of 18.2 IP without allowing an earned run from 5/18 - 6/12.

PERSONAL/CAREER:

- Selected by the Yankees in the first round of the Triple-A phase of the 2020 Rule 5 Draft.
- Full name is Matthew Edward Krook.
- Drafted in the 1st Round of the 2013 MLB Draft (35th overall) by the Miami Marlins, but did not sign (Competitive Balance Round A). Agreed to a contract with the Marlins, but failed his physical and Miami withdrew its offer.
- Underwent Tommy John surgery performed by Dr. James Andrews on April 22, 2014, during his freshman year of college. Did not pitch in 2015 collegiate season, but did return to pitch with the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League in the summer of '15.
- Drafted by the San Francisco Giants in the 4th round of the 2016 MLB Draft.
- Traded by the Giants to the Tampa Bay Rays on December 20, 2017 along with RHP Stetson Woods, INF Christian Arroyo and OF Denard Span in exchange for 3B Evan Longoria.
- During the COVID-19 pandemic, Krook traveled around the country as different locales began opening up to train with teammates and find open gyms. He mostly stayed in Washington, DC and Charlotte, NC in different AirBNBs. Krook trained and lived for a while with Durham Bulls pitcher Tyler Zombro, whom he describes as a close friend and pitching mentor.
