#### **SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES**

<u>DON'T JUST HAVE A GREAT DAY, HAVE AN AMERICAN DAY</u>: Happy July 4th! Today marks Biloxi's second July 4th game in Pensacola over the last three years... The Shuckers previously lost in a 10-inning affair to the Blue Wahoos at Blue Wahoos Stadium in 2021... Today also marks the fifth straight July 4th that Biloxi has spent on the road... They last played at home on July 4, 2017 against Pensacola.

AWARD-WINNING PERFORMANCES: C/INF Wes Clarke was named the Brewers' Minor League Co-Player of the Month for June... Clarke became the third Shuckers player in 2023 to be honored by the Brewers' organization... In June, Clarke had a .404 on-base percentage, a .453 slugging percentage and drew 21 walks in 21 games... He also led the Brewers' organization in June in RBI (19), was tied for the lead in walks (21) and was second in home runs (5).

FAMILIAR FACES. NEW PLACES: Today marks Biloxi's first road game against the Blue Wahoos in 2023, and their first games at Blue Wahoos Stadium since OF Jackson Chourio made his Double-A debut at the ballpark during the final series in 2022... In 2023, INF Tyler Black (.321/.424/.643) and INF Felix Valerio (.345/.406/.483) have led the offensive charge for Biloxi against Pensacola... Black's 1.067 OPS against the Blue Wahoos this season is the third-best by any opposing batter in the Southern League (min. 30 PA).

YOU SHOOK ME ALL NIGHT LONG: RHP T.J. Shook set a new career-high with 11 strikeouts on Monday night against the Mississippi Braves... He broke his previous career-high of 10, set against the Beloit Sky Carp (MIA) in 2022 with the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers in High-A... His 11 strikeouts also tied the most by a Shuckers' pitcher in 2023.

<u>OFF TO SEATTLE</u>: On Monday, June 26, **C Jeferson Quero** and **INF Jackson Chourio** were both selected to the 2023 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game, set to be held in Seattle, Washington on Saturday, July 8... The pair are the ninth and 10th Shuckers players selected for the event... The pair also continues a streak that's seen a Shuckers player selected in every year of the franchise's history (since 2018).

RUNNING PAST 40: INF Tyler Black became the second player in Shuckers' franchise history (since 2015) to tally 40 stolen bases in a season, doing so on Sunday, June 25... Black enters today 13 away from breaking OF Johnny Davis' record of 52, set during the 2017 season in 133 games... Black enters today as the stolen-base leader in the Southern League and Double-A.
