between the two clubs this season, and the ninth of 15 would snap a 10-game losing streak in series finales (last won 6-5 on 5/8 vs. CLT) and sweep a series for the first time since 7/13-18, 2021 (6-game series at CLT).

VS. MEMPHIS: Gwinnett is 4-0-3 in seven series all-time vs. CAN'T TOUCH TONKIN: Michael Tonkin locked down his (.600) in 20 games all-time at AutoZone Park, including 5-3 (.625) in eight games so far this season.

JULY TRENDS: The Stripers are 2-0 since returning from the All-Star Break, improving their July record to 10-7 (.588) through 17 games. Gwinnett has a +3 run differential (outscoring 57-54) this month, and has played in 13 games in 31.1 IP), 0.96 WHIP, and .167 BAA in 30 games. decided by three runs or less (GWN is 8-5).

- Dominant Arms: Gwinnett pitchers lead Triple-A in July DEMERITTE DELIVERS: Travis Demeritte led the Stripers in ERA (3.18), WHIP (1.11), BAA (.213), fewest runs allowed (54), and fewest hits allowed (114).
- Struggling Bats: Even after scoring 15 runs on 25 hits and tallying three home runs in the last two games, Gwinnett hitters still rank last in Triple-A in July in runs scored (57), homers (8), and total bases (185).

STRIKEOUT ARTISTS: The Stripers rank second in the International League in strikeouts with 910 in 92 games (9.89 SO/game), just three behind Worcester (913 SO in 92G) for the top spot. Gwinnett has not led the IL in strikeouts since 2011 (club record 1,223 SO in 143G). Entering play, Kyle Muller (1st, 117), Tucker Davidson (4th, 89), Huascar Ynoa (T-10th, 77), and Bryce Elder (T-18th, 71) all rank among the IL top 20 in strikeouts.

THE ELDER STROLLS: Today's scheduled starting pitcher Bryce Elder is 2-0 with a 1.74 ERA (4 ER in 20.2 IP), 1.02 WHIP, .219 BAA, and two quality starts over three outings in July. In his last start on 7/15 vs. Durham, he turned in his MULLDOZING: Kyle Muller notched his team-leading ninth second scoreless outing of the year (7.0 IP, 6 H, 0 BB, 5 SO) in a no-decision, throwing just 81 pitches.

• IL Leaderboard: Entering play, Elder leads the circuit in GO/AO ratio (2.27) and ranks among the top 10 in WHIP (6th, 1.19) and BAA (8th .237).

DIFF'RENT STREAKS: Hernan Perez enters play riding a five-game hitting streak, batting .500 (9-for-18, 1 2B, 1 HR, 6 R. 2 RBI, 1 SB, 1,293 OPS) with three multi-hit efforts in that span. Preston Tucker enters play looking to extend a five-game RBI streak that dates back to 7/13 (has 7 RBI in TUI AT THE FUTURES GAME: On 7/17, Stripers manager that span, batting .333, 6-for-18).

POWER UP: After hitting just three home runs during a 12game homestand from 7/4-7/17, the Stripers have tallied three homers in the last two games at Memphis. Braden Shewmake (solo on Friday, #6, first since 7/2 at NOR), Hernan Perez (solo on Friday, #4, first since 5/28 at NOR), and Chadwick Tromp (solo on Saturday, #10, first since 5/26-G2 at NOR) have all gone deep in this series.

DESHIELDS AMONG LEADERS: Delino DeShields Jr. ranks among the IL top 15 in stolen bases (T-8th, 19) and walks (13th, 44). He has reached base safely in 51 of 63 games (80.6%) with a plate appearance this season, batting .250 (46-for-184, 6 2B, 1 HR, 28 R, 18 RBI, .697 OPS).

TODAY: The Stripers play the finale of a three-game series **FERGUSON FIRING ZEROES:** 28-year-old **Tyler Ferguson** against the Memphis Redbirds (St. Louis Cardinals) at has posted a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 4.0 IP) over four outings AutoZone Park. It is the 15th of 27 games to be played (2 H, 2 BB, 7 SO) since joining Gwinnett for his Triple-A debut on 7/12. He has not allowed a run to his own line games to be played in Memphis. With a win, Gwinnett over his last 12 outings (12.2 IP, 2 H, 1 HB, 4 BB, 21 SO) since 6/16 with Double-A Mississippi. Ferguson is the eighth player to make his Triple-A debut with the Stripers this season (full list under "Players Used" on Page 2).

Memphis since first meeting in 2021. The Stripers are 12-8 team-leading eighth save (T-6th in IL) on Friday, pitching a perfect ninth (1.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 2 SO). He is now riding a 16.2-inning scoreless streak over his last 15 games since 6/5, the fourth-longest scoreless streak in the IL this season. In that span, Tonkin is posting a 0.54 WHIP (6 H, 3 BB), .107 BAA, 14.04 SO/9.0 IP ratio (26 SO), and five saves (5-for-5). Overall, he's 3-0 with a 1.72 ERA (6 ER

> to a come-from-behind 7-6 win on Friday, driving in the tying and winning runs with a two-out double in the eighth. It was just his third multi-RBI game with Gwinnett this season (first since 4/14 vs. NAS, 1-for-5, 1 HR, 2 RBI).

• GWN Career: Demeritte has reached base safely in 175 of 208 career games (84.1%) with Gwinnett since 2019. batting .274 (197-for-720, 53 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 131 R, 142 RBI, 17 SB, .904 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Mejia.

quality start of the season on 7/14 vs. Durham, working 6.0 innings (7 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 0 BB, 7 SO) in a no-decision (GWN lost 5-3). Over his last eight starts since 6/2, Muller is 3-2 with a 2.25 ERA (13 ER in 52.0 IP), 0.88 WHIP, .202 BAA, 10.56 SO/9.0 IP (61 SO), and seven quality starts.

IL Leaderboard: Muller leads in strikeouts (117, 7th in MiLB) and ranks among the top 10 in WHIP (2nd, 1.08), innings (T-2nd, 94.1), CG (T-2nd, 1), ERA (3rd, 2.96), BAA (3rd, .223), and GO/AO ratio (8th, 1.28).

Matt Tuiasosopo served as the third base coach for the National League in the 2022 SiriusXM MLB All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium in Los Angeles. He was the first Gwinnett coach ever to participate in a Futures Game. The NL, led by former MLB manager Mike Sciocia, lost 6-4 to the American League (OAK's Shea Langeliers was MVP). Coach Devon Travis guided the Stripers to a 2-1 record as acting manager in Tuiasosopo's absence.

PROSPECTING: Gwinnett's active roster features six listed on the MLB.com Atlanta Braves Top 30 Prospects list: LHP Kyle Muller (1), RHP Bryce Elder (2), INF Braden Shewmake (3), LHP Tucker Davidson (5), RHP Freddy Tarnok (6), and RHP Victor Vodnik (10). None are currently ranked on the MLB.com Top 100 Prospects list.

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) . In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... On 6/9/22 at Jacksonville, he became the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 career wins ... On 7/16, he served third base coach for the NL Team for the 2022 SiriusXM MLB All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium ... Began his career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for MiLB Manager of the Year.

- <u>GWN Career:</u> Makes his 21st career start with Gwinnett ... Is 7-7 with a 3.97 ERA (51 ER in 115.2 IP), 1.14 WHIP, .209 BAA, and 8.64 SO/9.0 IP ratio (111 SO) since 2021 ... When he debuted last season, was the first of Atlanta's 2020 draft class to reach Triple-A.

PROSPECTING: Elder is ranked the Atlanta Braves' No. 2 prospect by MLB.com ... He is the second-highest ranked pitcher on Gwinnett's roster (**Kyle Muller** is No. 1).

2022 WITH GWINNETT: Was on Gwinnett's Opening Night roster, but did not appear before having his contract selected by Atlanta on 4/12 ...
