### LAST GAME

The Baysox evened their series with the Richmond Flying Squirrels last night by a 6-2 final. Left-handed starter Cade Povich led the way for Bowie, as the southpaw struck out a career-high 13 batters, including the first six he faced on the night. Povich retired 18 in-a-row to start the evening, taking a perfect game into the seventh before a Wade Meckler single led off the frame. That hit was the lone baserunner allowed by Povich through his seven shutout innings. Offensively, Coby Mayo notched a pair of extra-base hits and RBI with a solo home run in the first, along with a run-scoring double in the fifth. Billy Cook notched an RBI single in the fourth to extend his hitting streak to nine games, while TT Bowens mashed a solo home run to right field in the sixth. John Rhodes and Zach Watson would also each drive in a run for Bowie, as part of a two-run seventh inning in the Baysox victory.

### TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Richmond Flying Squirrels enter today with a record of 27-33 - fifth place in the Southwest division and 1.5 games ahead of the Baysox. Since entering their series in Bowie against the Baysox in late April atop the division standings, the Flying Squirrels are 14-26, having lost three of their series, while splitting the other three, and dropping five games out of first place in the process. Richmond has the third-fewest errors (42) in the Eastern League and the fewest home runs hit away from home (21) of any team in Double-A, but are going against a Baysox team with the third-most errors (57) and home runs allowed at home (58) in the league. The Flying Squirrels roster includes 10 of the Giants' top 30 prospects (via MLB Pipeline) - INF Marco Luciano (No. 2 SF/No. 18 overall), OF Vaun Brown (No. 5 SF), LHP Carson Wisenhunt (No. 8 SF), RHP Mason Black (No. 10 SF), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 13 SF), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 17 SF), RHP Randy Rodriguez (No. 25 SF), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 26 SF), RHP Jose Cruz (No. 29 SF), and OF Wade Meckler (No. 30 SF).

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Carson Seymour is set to get the ball tonight for Richmond. The No. 17 prospect in the Giants' system, per MLB Pipeline, Seymour has allowed just a single home run across 45.2 innings this season, while walking only 19 and holding opponents to a .238 average. Seymour last pitched this past Sunday against Altoona, where the right-hander went four frames, allowing a run on three hits and striking out three. Seymour scattered five hits and a pair of runs across three innings against the Baysox on 4/25. Seymour is originally a 6th round pick of the Mets in 2021, but was traded over to the Giants this past August in the Darin Ruf deal. Seymour was drafted out of Kansas State University, where he pitched for two seasons after one season at Dartmouth. He only pitched 84.2 innings through his whole collegiate career due to transfer rules and the COVID-19 cancellation for the 2020 season. Seymour's fastball can climb as high as 99 mph, partnered with a turbo sinker in the mid-90s, along with a high-80s slider/cutter, high-80s changeup, and an inconsistent low-80s curveball.

### DOUBLE THE MAYO!

INF Coby Mayo has been a balanced mix of power, patience, and run production at the plate for the Baysox. Mayo sits second at the Double-A level with 21 doubles and 32 extra-base hits. The No. 8 Orioles' No. 99 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, has hits in nine of ten games, batting .351 (13-for-37) with seven extra-base hits. Mayo also leads the Baysox with 36 walks, 31 RBI, a .412 OBP, and a .956 OPS. Mayo has crushed Richmond pitching particularly well in 2023, hitting .393 (11-for-28), with eight of his hits going for extra bases (six doubles, one triple, one home run).

### LET HIM COOK

Billy Cook is currently riding a season-long, nine-game hitting streak. During that stretch, Cook has hit .343 (12-for-35) with four doubles and two home runs. Cook has hit particularly well at Prince George's Stadium this season, where he is hitting .261, compared to just .211 on the road. Cook has nine extra base hits at home this season, including all six of his home runs.

### HOBBLING AT HOME

Despite a strong showing each of the past two series on the road, the Baysox are still looking to get back on track at Prince George's Stadium. Bowie's 12-21 record at home this season is second-worst in the Eastern League. The Baysox have yet to win a series at home this season and have only split at home on one occasion this season in five attempts. This, in part, stems from a staff ERA that jumps to 4.92 at home (third-highest in the league), compared to 3.42 away from home (lowest in Double-A). 50 of Bowie's 73 home runs allowed this season have come at home - the second-highest mark in the league.

## QUICK HITS

- Set a franchise record in 2022 for most home runs allowed (27). Currently tied for third-most home runs allowed in Baysox history (38).
- Record the fifth-most strikeouts and the second-most starts in the Orioles' system in 2022, all while throwing the second-most innings and giving up the most hits.
- Was a part of the 11th no-hitter in Baysox history on 5/8 against Harrisburg, alongside Morgan McSweney – pitched six of the seven innings in what was the front end of a doubleheader, allowing just two walks.

## CAREER NOTES

- Gave up the second-highest batting average and slugging percentage amongst Baysox arms with at least 30 innings.
- Shifted to the bullpen in July from the rotation after allowing 43 runs in 17 innings from 5/27-6/26. Proceed to win Orioles Minor League Pitcher of the Month in July, pitching to a 1.46 ERA in 5 appearances (1 start), which included a career-high 10 strikeouts in 4 innings against Richmond on 7/2.
- Held right-handed hitters to a .236 average, as opposed to a .345 average for right-handers. Held opponents to a .176 average in 19 innings as a reliever.
- Began 2021 season in High-A Aberdeen with a 4.39 ERA in 80 innings before being promoted to Bowie on 8/17.
- Traded to the Orioles in December of 2020 in the Jose Iglesias deal alongside fellow Orioles farmhand Jean Pinto.
- Never made an appearance for the Angels' organization after being drafted by them in the fifth round of the 2020 draft.
- Orioles EVP/GM Mike Elias had targeted Stallings in the 2020 draft but was taken earlier by the Angels.
- Threw two complete game shutouts in his junior season at Tennessee. He earned two SEC Pitcher of the Week awards, and was also named to the 2019 SEC All-Defensive team

## NOTES BY OUTING

- Struck out three of the first seven batters faced, but allowed a single and home run to the first two batters of the third inning. Later allowed a triple, but a double play at home prevented a run.
- Thanks to a double play, faced the minimum over his 14 batters. Both hits were singles, and neither reached second base.
- Two of three hits allowed were home runs, including one to the second batter of the game.
- Relieved Peter Van Loon in second game of a DH. After retiring the first batter, gave up four-straight hits, including a triple and two-run home run. Allowed first three batters to reach in the following inning as well.
- Relieved Van Loon again, allowed seven hits to the first eight batters he saw, including another home run.
- Retired the first seven batters, and only allowed one hit through four innings.
- Relieved Van Loon. Allowed four runs in first two innings, but none in final three, while striking out five.
- Allowed two base hits in the third, but a baserunning mistake saved him from allowing a run.
- Relieved Van Loon. Only allowed one baserunner, a two-out single in his second inning.
- Allowed four base hits in the second inning, including a three-run home run to Frankie Toastado that limited his outing
- Relieved Van Loon. Thanks to a double play and caught stealing, did not allow a runner to reach third base.
