LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox allowed more than nine runs in a game for the first time in 2022 on Thursday, as they dropped the third game of their six-game series with the Reading Fightin Phils 11-6. While Bowie did take an early 2-0 lead, Reading exploded for five runs in the third inning against Antonio Velez, and a grand slam by Jhailyn Ortiz in the sixth inning pushed the game out of reach. Bowie did make a late push despite trailing by nine. Hudson Haskin led off the seventh inning with his fifth home run of the season, and Jordan Westburg followed shortly after with his sixth of the year, a three-run shot.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

One of the most tenured teams in the entire league, Reading is running into many of the same struggles that plagued them in 2021, as they have been at least five games back in the Northeast Division standings for 12-straight games. The Fightins are batting a league-worst. 203 at the start of this series. Opponents have made the most against Reading pitching this season, as their 5.04 ERA is the third-highest in the league. Despite playing in a notably hitter-friendly stadium, Reading pitchers have allowed only 22 home runs, the fourth-fewest in the league, with 12 coming at home.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Jack Perkins was off to a very tough start to the year, but looks to be finally turning the corner. While getting roughed up over his first four outings, and seeing his ERA inflate past 10, Perkins rebounded to throw five strong innings against Portland in his last start, only allowing one run. Perkins is not a heavy strikeout arm, only picking up 14 in 18.2 innings of work so far this season. Bowie could turn on a few pitches of Perkins', he's given up home runs in both of his home starts, and sports a fly ball rate of 69%

QUICK ATTACK

While Altoona does lead the league in batting average at the start of innings this season, 39 points above Bowie's .235, the Baysox have the highest OPS in the league from the first batter in an inning at .797. The contrast is mostly thanks to both Bowie's walks and power. Bowie has drawn ten walks at the start of innings this season, as well as hit 10 leadoff home runs, both numbers lead the league. Hudson Haskin hit a leadoff home run in the seventh inning of Thursday's game, already his third of the season.

SUGAR SHAYNE

Bowie outfielder Shayne Fontana has broken through for consistent contact at the plate after a slow start to 2022. While Fontana did open the year on an 0-for-11 stretch, things turned around halfway through April. Since April 17th, Fontana is hitting 16-for-50 (.320) at the plate with a double, two home runs, nine RBI, and 10 runs scored.

PULL AWAY EARLY

Bowie has ran into plenty of trouble this season in the middle of their games. Bowie has only scored six runs in the fifth inning all season, the lowest tally in the League. Their -17 run differential in the frame is understandably their worst in any inning this season, and is the worst in the Eastern League in the fifth inning. Things don't get much better in the sixth inning, as Bowie has only scored 13 runs in the sixth, tied for the second-fewest, and allowed 24 runs, the most.

TOP GUNNAR

Infielder Gunnar Henderson was named the Eastern League Player of the Week on Monday, after going 9-for-17 at the plate with a double, a home run, four RBI, and five runs scored. While he did go 0-for-2 on Wednesday, he extended his on-base streak to 28 consecutive games thanks to three walks. He's reached base in every game this season for the Baysox, the longest stretch in the league. Gunnar has increased his walk rate from just 12.1% across three levels played last season up to over 20% so far this season. Henderson is ranked as the Orioles #3 prospect and Minor League Baseball's #64 overall prospect entering the 2022 season according to MLB Pipeline. Listed as #4 for the Orioles and #57 in MiLB by Baseball America. He was named the Orioles Organization All-Star at third base by MiLB.com for his 2021 season.
