**ABOUT YESTERDAY AFTERNOON:** RHP **Luis Moreno** allowed two runs in the first inning but settled down to toss seven innings of two-run ball en route to Brooklyn's 5-2 victory over Winston-Salem on Wednesday afternoon. The Cyclones offense woke up for a five spot in the top of the third inning when the 'Clones rallied to take a 5-2 lead. OF **Matt Rudick's** RBI triple cut the deficit to 2-1, OF **Alex Ramirez's** RBI double to centerfield tied the game 2-2. 1B **JT Schwartz** and INF **Jose Peroza** hit back-to-back home runs to plate the next three runs. RHP **Franklin Sanchez** and RHP **Dylan Hall** tossed scoreless innings to end the game.

**DIVISION ON THE LINE:** Including today, the Cyclones have four games remaining in the 2022 regular season. Brooklyn is vying for a playoff spot with a second half division title in the North Division of the South Atlantic League, sitting in first place a game and a half ahead of the New York Yankees affiliate the Hudson Valley Renegades who are playing Wilmington this week at Frawley Stadium.

**SEND ME A POSTCARD:** Brooklyn travels down to Winston-Salem for the first time in team history. After the realignment of the Minor Leagues, the Cyclones and Dash joined the South Atlantic League in 2021. Brooklyn hosted the Dash in August in Coney Island and heads to Truist Stadium for the first time. Brooklyn has still not matched up with league opponents Rome or Hickory since the realignment.

**BEST STRETCH:** Brooklyn is currently 12-2 in its past 14 games, outscoring opponents 95-42 (+53). Brooklyn's offensive is averaging 6.7 runs per game and the pitching staff and defense has allowed 3.0 runs per game over the stretch.

**JT JOLTING:** Since returning from injury on August 17, 1B **JT Schwartz** is hitting .355 with a .931 OPS, going 27-76 with seven doubles, two home runs in 18 games. Coincidentally, Schwartz's first game

**vs. WINSTON-SALEM:** The Chicago White Sox High-A affiliate is currently in last place in the South Division in the second half. The Dash host none of the White Sox Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. Brooklyn split a six-game series with Winston-Salem in Coney Island August 2-7. The Dash has played at Truist Stadium since 2010. Baseball in Winston-Salem dates back to 1905 and even the Brooklyn Dodgers had a farm team in WS in 1938.

back from injury was also the day he fell from the No. 19 spot in MLB Pipeline's Top 30 Mets list to being out of the rankings completely.

**PEROZA PRODUCING:** Since August 1, INF **Jose Peroza** is hitting .339 with a .435 OBP and a .931 OPS. In the stretch, Peroza has 23 strikeouts and 20 walks. On June 29, Peroza's batting average sank down to .199 and currently sits at .258.

**SUPERSTAR IN THE MAKING:** OF **Alex Ramirez**, the Mets No. 4 prospect, leads the entire organization in hits (134) and doubles (29) in 2022. The 19-year-old Dominican is in the midst of his second season since signing with New York.

**LUGO LAUNCHING:** Over his past six games, 3B **William Lugo** has two doubles, one home run, and five RBIs, hitting .474 (9-19). Lugo has blasted four home runs with Brooklyn and has a career-high 14 overall after 10 long balls with Low-A St. Lucie.

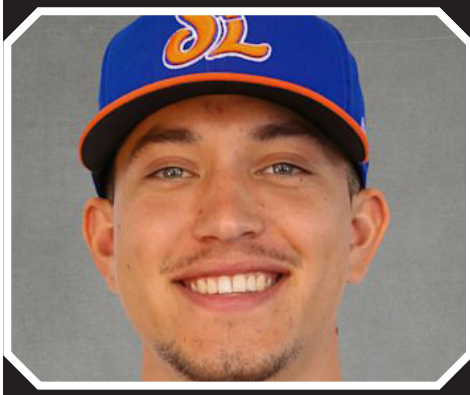
**MASTERS OF THEIR DOMAIN:** The Cyclones have allowed the fewest runs in the league and are tied for the second-fewest in Minor League Baseball, having allowed 501 runs in 128 games (3.9 runs/game).

**THAT'S OFFENSIVE!:** The Cyclones have scored just 539 runs in 128 games (4.2 runs/game) which ranks second-to-last in the South Atlantic League and tied for ninth-worst in MiLB in fewest runs.

**RANKINGS:** Dominic Hamel ranks as the No. 12 prospect in the New York Mets organization and the No. 5 pitching prospect in the system.

**MASTERY:** Last week in Coney Island, Hamel struck out nine with no walks over a career-high seven scoreless versus Wilmington, putting together his best Brooklyn start. Prior to that outing, Hamel had a walk rate of 21% over the three previous appearances.

**PROMOTED:** Dominic Hamel, who is the Mets No. 12 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, earned the promotion from Low-A St. Lucie, joining the Cyclones on the Fourth of July.

**ST. LUCIE:** With the Low-A St. Lucie Mets, Hamel made 14 appearances and 13 starts, posting a 3.84 ERA in 63 1/3 innings. Hamel posted a 27% strikeout rate, 11% walk rate, and a 3.91 FIP.

**DOM-INANT JUNE:** Hamel posted a 2.84 ERA in June, making five starts. He struck out 30 and walked 10 in 25 1/3 innings.

**BEGINNINGS:** The Arizona native was drafted by the Mets in the third round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Dallas Baptist, signing for \$755,300 and made two appearances for the Florida Complex League Mets last year.

**COLLEGE DAYS:** Hamel pitched at Dallas Baptist in 2020 and 2021 after two seasons at Yavapai College. At Dallas Baptist in his senior season, Hamel set a school record with 136 strikeouts in 91 2/3 innings.
