TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue a six-game series at Erie, Altoona is 7-8 against the 'Wolves this year.

LAST TIME OUT: Erie scored 7 times across the 3rd and 4th innings to take a 9-2 win over Altoona on Thursday night. **Brad Case** tossed 2.2 scoreless innings in relief with a season-high 5 K's in the defeat.

PLAYOFFS?!?!?! With their fourth straight win and second in a row in Erie on Wednesday, September 7, Altoona stood just 3.5 games back of first place with 10 games to play in the regular season. With wins by Bowie, Erie and Akron on Thursday, all teams ahead of Altoona, the Curve stand 4.5 games out of first place with 9 games to play.

20/20 VISION: Infielder **Andres Alvarez** has recorded the first 20/20 season in Altoona's franchise history with his two-run home run on Sunday, September 4 against Akron. With Aaron Shackelford already hitting the total, Altoona has 2 players with 20 HR on the same team for the first time since 2005 (Jose Bautista/Josh Bonifay) and just the third time in 24 seasons of the franchise's history. Alvarez and Shackelford have recorded the 11th and 12th 20-homer seasons in franchise history.

ENDY'S POP: Catcher **Endy Rodriguez** homered from both sides of the plate in Altoona's 13-7 win over Akron on Thursday, September 1. It was just the 5th time in franchise history that Altoona had a player homer from both sides of the plate and first time at PNG Field. **Rodolfo Castro** last turned the trick on 6/5/21 at Richmond. Others to homer from both sides of the plate in the same game in franchise history include: **Shawn Garrett** 5/2/03 at Reading, **Hector Gimenez** 5/5/10 at Richmond, **Shelby Ford** 5/15/10 at Richmond.

In his 24 games since joining the Curve on August 9 at Binghamton, he's batting .363/.449/.736/1.185 with 10 2B, 8 HR, 25 RBI, 14 BB and 1-1 SB. Since his promotion he ranks T-3rd in XBH (18), 6th in SLG% (.736) and 8th in OPS (1.185) among all minor league players.

SHACK ATTACK: **Aaron Shackelford** leads Pirates minor leaguers with 25 home runs, matching **Josh Bonifay** for the second-highest single-season total in franchise history (**Adam Hyzdu** - 31, 2000). Shackelford and **Matt Gorski** are the first Pirates minor leaguers to homer at least 24 times in the same season since 2007 (**Jonel Pacheco** and **Steve Pearce** in 2007). **Shackelford's 27 extra base hits in the second half (6/28 - Present) are 3rd-most among Eastern League players.**

HAMMERIN' HANK IS BACK: Catcher **Henry Davis** has returned to Altoona's active roster after a 7-week stint on the IL. Davis, the No.1 overall selection in the 2021 draft out of Louisville, last appeared for Altoona on Saturday, July 2. In a four-game rehab assignment at Low-A Bradenton, Davis batted 3-for-9 with 1 HR and 2 RBI and he picked up 2 hits in his return to the lineup on August 30.

ACTIVE 1'S: For the first time this season, Altoona has 4 First Round draft picks on the active roster at the same time with **Connor Scott** (13th overall, 2018 by Miami), **Quinn Priester** (19th overall, 2019), **Nick Gonzales** (7th overall, 2020) and **Henry Davis** (1st overall, 2021) active for Altoona.

NICKY G IS BACK: After missing 10 weeks of the season with a right foot injury, Infielder **Nick Gonzales** has reached base safely in 19-of-21 games since his activation batting: .286/.423/.481 (22-for-77) with 9 2B, 2 HR, 13 RBI, 16 BB since his return.

STOLEN HEARTS: The Curve have stolen 150 bases on the season, on pace to break the franchise record of 159 (2014) with 11 games to play. Altoona has 3 players, **Jared Triolo** (24), **Liover Peguero** (23) and **Andres Alvarez** (20), with 20 stolen bases for the second time in franchise history: first since 2014 when **Keon Broxton** and **Alen Hanson** each had 25 and **Drew Maggi** stole 37 bases.

THE 'WOLVES: Managed by Gabe Alvarez, Erie is on the doorstep of their first playoff berth since 2013. With their win over Bowie on Sunday, Erie holds the tiebreaker over Bowie and enters this series tied for first in the division. Erie's roster features some of the top Tigers prospects: RHP **Wilmer Flores** (#3), RHP **Ty Madden** (#4), RHP **Reese Olson** (#9), C **Dillon Dingler** (#10), INF **Wenceel Perez** (#15), OF **Parker Meadows** (#17), LHP **Brant Hurter** (#22), RHP **Elvis Alvarado** (#26).

THE FIRST INTO THE SEA: **Ty Madden**, the 32nd overall pick in the 2021 draft out of the University of Texas, takes the ball for Erie tonight. Madden is ranked as the #4 prospect in the Tigers system by MLB.com and has already picked up 35 strikeouts in 27 innings across 5 starts with the SeaWolves, recording a 2.33 ERA. Madden hails from Cypress, Texas and attended Cypress Ranch HS where Orioles prospect **Colton Cowser** patrolled Center Field and White Sox prospect **Matthew Thompson** (2nd round, 2019) shared the pitching staff. Cowser is currently at Triple-A Norfolk, while Thompson recently arrived at Double-A Birmingham. Madden made his pro debut this season after throwing 113.1 IP for the Longhorns in 2021.

2005 - Facing elimination in the playoffs, Tom Gorzelanny fans 13 and pitches a complete-game shutout at PNG Field vs. Akron as the Curve won 3-0 in Game 3 of the ELDS

2015 - Curve tie team record by overcoming 7-run deficit in Game 1 of the ELDS vs. Bowie, win 8-7; Barrett Barnes hit the first postseason grand slam in franchise history in the fifth innings, Austin Meadows hit game-tying two-run homer in the ninth and Jacob Stallings delivered the first walk-off hit, a single, in franchise postseason history to earn the win.

CAREER NOTES

2022: Was a non-roster invitee to Pirates Spring Training... Ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 22 right-handed pitching prospect in all of minor league baseball entering the season... Suffered an oblique injury at the end of spring training and missed all of April and May before returning for a rehab assignment beginning on Thursday, June 9 with Bradenton vs. Clearwater in which the Marauders threw a combined no-hitter (Priester 3.0 IP, Anthony Solometo 4.0 IP, Jake Sullivan 1.0 IP, Yunior Thaibo 1.0 IP), game was caught by rehabbing Curve C Henry Davis... Bradenton's no-hitter was the first he's ever been part of in his life... Completed his rehab assignment on 6/14 with Greensboro: allowed five runs on six hits in 2.2 innings...EL Ranks in July: 5th in ERA (1.69), 6th in IP (26.2), 9th in WHIP (1.05), 10th in BAA (.216)... His 1.69 ERA in July ranked 8th among Double-A Pitchers... His **2.37 ERA** since his debut (6/19 - Present) ranks 4th among qualified Double-A Pitchers...

2021: Entered the season ranked by *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline as the fourth-best prospect in the Pirates system...Was also ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 58 prospect in all of baseball and the No. 17 right-handed pitching prospect... Was listed as having the "Best Curveball" in the Pirates minor league system by *Baseball America* entering the 2021 campaign... CAREER TRANSACTIONS: Drafted by the Pittsburgh Pirates in the first round (18th overall) of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Cary-Grove High School in Cary, Illinois...Signed on June 10, 2019

CURVE CUTS: Charles Quinn Priester... Was committed to play collegiately at Texas Christian University before his selection in the 2019 draft... Signed for a bonus of \$3,400,000 by Pirates scout Anthony Wycklent... Is a 2019 graduate of Cary-Grove (IL) High School, where he posted an 8-2 record and 1.00 ERA as a senior... Was named the 2018-19 Gatorade Illinois Player-of-the-Year... Was a two-sport athlete in high school; also played wide receiver and defensive back on the high school's football team that went 14-0 and won a Class 6A state championship in 2018 where he caught a 3-year touchdown pass in the championship game against Crete-Monee HS... Played quarterback as an underclassman before moving to receiver during his senior year of high school... Turned down an offer of a dual scholarship from Northwestern University to play football and baseball for the Wildcats... Was named a 2019 Rawlings Perfect Game pre-season All-American... Was also ranked as the 19th-best prospect by MLB Pipeline in the 2019 draft... Became the first high school player from the state of Illinois to be selected in the first round since Houston's Mike Foltyniewicz in 2010...
