Last season, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders came to Werner Park to play the Omaha Storm Chasers (August 22-28) for the first time since the Chasers moved to the International League in 2021. The two teams split the series 3-3, with the RailRiders winning the first three, but Omaha taking the last three, including a doubleheader sweep on Sunday, August 28.

Prior to last season, the teams met for 12 games in what was the Triple-A alliance (1988-1991) when the Omaha Royals played in the American Association and the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre Red Barons played in the International League.

Omaha played 5 of those 12 games at what was then known as Lackawanna County Stadium, winning 2 of 3 in 1989 and split two games August 7-8 1990. (h/t Adam Marco)

**PAPILLION, NEB.** - While the Omaha Storm Chasers jumped out to a 3-0 lead on homers from **Jakson Reetz** and **Franmil Reyes**, the Louisville Bats scored four runs between the seventh and eighth innings to take Sunday's series finale 4-3, also winning this week's series at Werner Park four games to two.

- Reetz opened the scoring in the bottom of the fourth with a solo homer, his third long ball of the season ... after **Samad Taylor** tripled in the fifth, Reyes brought him home with a two-run shot that put Omaha up 3-0 at the time.
- Those were the only runs the Storm Chasers could score in the game, as after the home run from Reyes, Louisville pitching retired 13 of 15 Omaha hitters, allowing just two to reach in the eighth inning.
- Daniel Lynch** started for Omaha, on Major League Rehab assignment, and pitched 3.1 scoreless innings, striking out three across 3.1 innings.
- Jonah Dipoto** followed Lynch and after balking an inherited runner to second base and walking his first hitter, retired his next five for 1.2 scoreless frames.
- Behind Dipoto, **Dylan Coleman** pitched a scoreless sixth with three strikeouts but Louisville finally got into the board in the seventh, as **Brooks Kriske** surrendered a two-run homer to Bats third baseman **Elly De La Cruz** to make the score 3-2.
- Kriske allowed his first two batters of the eighth to reach base and was replaced by **Nick Wittgren**, who got the first two outs but gave up the lead on a two-run double with two outs, putting the loss on Kriske.
- While Wittgren threw a scoreless top of the ninth, Omaha could not get a runner on in the bottom of the ninth, falling 4-3 to Louisville and giving the Bats a series win.

### NOTES AND NUGGETS

#### ROLLING IN THE DEEP

- Despite just 3.1 innings from Daniel Lynch on Sunday, Omaha starting pitchers have combined to throw 140.1 innings this season, the 4th-most among International League teams, however the 6.54 ERA ranks as the worst in the 20-team league.
- Omaha starters have thrown at least 5.0 innings in 17 of 31 games this season, including 15 of the last 18 ... in that 18 game stretch since April 18, the staff's 91.2 innings throw by Chasers starters are the most of any Minor League club (next closest: Tri-City Dust Devils, 90.1 IP).
  - The last 18 games have featured five quality starts, from **Mike Mayers** (4/18 and 5/5), **Jonathan Heasley** (4/19), **Austin Cox** (4/27) and **Drew Parrish** (4/28).
  - While they're generally going deep into games, Omaha starters are receiving an average of 2.39 runs of support per start ... they're 8-5 when getting at least 3 runs of support and 4-14 when getting 2 or less, with 7 games of 0 run support for the starter.

#### HELLO, MY NAME IS

With his start Sunday, Daniel Lynch became the 38th player to suit up for Omaha this season.

- Today, **Drew Waters** will become the 39th player to appear in a game for the team this year ... when he makes his storm Chasers debut, **James McArthur** will be the 40th.
- Of the 38 players that have played for the Storm Chasers this season, 272 of them previous played for the team prior to this year (71%) ... Waters played 31 games for Omaha last year, while McArthur will make his Royals organization debut.
- With 21 roster moves over the last 8 days, 30 different players have played in games this week for the Chasers in the last six games.

#### CATCH ME IF YOU CAN

Omaha went 13-for-15 in stolen base attempts last week, including two steals in two attempts on Sunday.

- Omaha's 56 steals are second both in the International League and in Triple-A, only trailing 64 steals from the Worcester Red Sox ... they're tied 10th (with Hudson Valley) among all Minor League teams in steals.
- 17 steals for **Dairon Blanco** rank tied 2nd in the International League and among all Triple-A basestealers, while tied 4th among all Minor League players in steals, trailing the MiLB leader with 21, **Victor Scott II** of the Peoria Chiefs (Cardinals High-A ... 16 steals for **Samad Taylor** rank 4th in the league and Triple-A, tied 10th in MiLB).

#### BIG LEAGUE BUSINESS

Omaha has two Major League rehabbers with the club right now: starting pitcher **Daniel Lynch** and outfielder **Drew Waters**, both opened the 2023 MLB season on Kansas City's 15-Day Injured List.

- Lynch suffered a left shoulder strain (rotator cuff) and left his Cactus League start on March 23 @ San Diego ... has made two rehab starts already, one for Double-A Northwest Arkansas on Tuesday, May 2nd and most recently, on Sunday, May 7th for Omaha, as he threw 3.1 scoreless innings for the Chasers.
- Waters begins his rehab assignment today after suffered a *left oblique strain* before Spring Training games began in February ... he began playing games in Extended Spring Training on April 17 before joining the Chasers today.



## MANAGER: MIKE JIRSCHOLE • #23

- Mike Jirschele returns for his 15th season as Omaha's manager, his 18th season managing in Minor League Baseball and 32nd season overall with the Royals organization, named to the position of Storm Chasers manager on January 13, 2023, after previously managing Triple-A Omaha from 1995-97 and 2003-13.
- Jirschele served on the Kansas City Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015. Jirschele most recently served as the bench coach under manager Chris Widger during the 2022 season with the Double-A Northwest Arkansas Naturals. He spent the 2021 season as Widger's bench coach for the High-A Central champion Quad Cities River Bandits and served as Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020.
- In his second stint as Omaha's manager, over 11 years from 2003 to 2013, he led the team to four division titles, three consecutive trips to the Pacific Coast League Championship Series (2011-2013), two PCL titles (2011, 2013) and the team's first of two Triple-A National Championships in 2013.
- He earned the 2011 Mike Coolbaugh Award for *outstanding baseball work ethic, knowledge of the game and skill in mentoring young players on the field* and he is a four-time recipient of the Dick Howser Award (1992, 1994, 2005, 2011), recognizing outstanding work in player development within the Royals organization.
- Prior to his time with Omaha and Kansas City, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years, from 1998-2002, and he held managerial positions with Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).
- He appeared 999 games in the Minor Leagues across 13 years, between 1977 and 1990, including 22 games with the Omaha Royals between 1988 and 1989.



## PITCHING COACH: DANE JOHNSON • #59

- Dane Johnson enters his fourth year in the Royals organization and as the Storm Chasers pitching coach, after joining Kansas City ahead of the 2020 season. 2023 marks his 24th season coaching overall.
- He previously spent one season in the Miami Marlins organization (2019) as a Pitching Consultant and 19 seasons with the Toronto Blue Jays as a Minor League Pitching Coach from 2000-03, Pitching Coordinator from 2004-14 and Major League Bullpen Coach from 2015-18.
- Prior to entering coaching, spent 15 years as a player, including over 280 games in the Minor Leagues and parts of three seasons in the Majors with the Chicago White Sox (1994), Blue Jays (1996) and Oakland Athletics (1997), also playing two seasons (1990-1991) in the Chinese Professional Baseball League.
- Johnson and his wife, Gina, reside in Palm Harbor, Florida. They have two children: a daughter, Madison (31), and son, Cobi (27).



## HITTING COACH: BIJAN RADEMACHER • #52

- Bijan Rademacher (*bi-ZHON RAH-de-moch-err*) joins the Royals as the Omaha Storm Chasers Hitting Coach this year after spending the last two years with the Arizona Diamondbacks as their Minor League Hitting Coordinator (2021) and ACL Hitting Coach (2022).
- Prior to coaching, he spent eight years playing professionally (2012-2019), spanning seven seasons in the Chicago Cubs organization (2012-18) and slashed .280/.361/.402 over 702 career MiLB games, reaching as high as Triple-A. He also played one season in independent baseball (2019) with the New Britain Bees in the Atlantic League, in addition to an offseason in the Mexican Pacific Winter League.
- Over 243 career Triple-A games with the Iowa Cubs, he played 11 games at Werner Park and was a .378 hitter (14-for-37) with one homer and 5 runs batted in while playing in Omaha.
- Rademacher lives in Tempe, Arizona with his wife Melissa.



## BENCH COACH: DAVID NOWORYTA • #33 (3RD BASE COACH)

- David Noworyta (*Nova-REE-tah*) enters his second year in the Royals organization and first as Omaha's Bench Coach, after making his coaching debut in 2022 as the Assistant Hitting Coach for the River Bandits Kansas City's High-A affiliate.
- Prior to coaching, he spent four years playing professionally (2018-21), including three minor league seasons in the Detroit Tigers organization (2018-20), and one with the Independent Pioneer League's Billings Mustangs in 2021. Before signing with Detroit in 2018, Noworyta graduated from the University of Hawaii with a bachelor's degree in communications and journalism, and played in parts of three seasons for their baseball team.
- Noworyta attended Holy Cross Academy (N.J.), where he played baseball and basketball, and was selected by the Royals in the 37th round of the 2014 MLB Draft. He resides in Hainesport, N.J. in the offseason.



## CERTIFIED ATHLETIC TRAINER: JAMES STONE

- James Stone is entering his fifth season as the Certified Athletic Trainer for the Storm Chasers after serving the previous seven seasons with the Wilmington Blue Rocks (Royals High-A), including the 2015 season, in which he was named Carolina League Athletic Trainer of the Year.
- He joined the Kansas City organization in 2010 as the athletic trainer for the Class-A Burlington Bees. He came to the Royals after spending one season with the Central Valley Coyotes (Fresno, California) in Arena Football 2.
- Stone worked three seasons in the Florida Marlins organization, with stops in Jupiter (2008), Greensboro (2007) and Jamestown (2006), winning New York-Penn League Trainer of the Year honors in 2006.
- He was the Strength and Conditioning Coach for the Baltimore Orioles Class-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, in 2005.
- Stone graduated with a bachelor's of science in kinesiology from Cal State-Northridge. He resides in Simi Valley, California with his dog, Ozzie.

## STRENGTH & CONDITIONING COACH: YANNICK PLANTE

- Yannick Plante is entering his third season as the Strength & Conditioning Coach for the Storm Chasers, after being slated to serve in that role with Northwest Arkansas in 2020.
