BRADFORD STRIKES OUT 11 IN SHUTOUT WIN:

The Frisco RoughRiders posted their fourth shutout victory of the season on Friday night with a 1-0 win over the Midland Rock-Hounds at Riders Field. Frisco starter **Cody Bradford** tallied a season-high 11 punch outs in the win, tossing 5.1 scoreless innings. In the month of June, Bradford (5-3) has surrendered one earned run in 15 innings on four walks and 21 strikeouts. **Trey Hair** slugged his 12th home run in the bottom of the second inning to tie **Blaine Crim** for most homers by any RoughRiders (31-30) hitter this season. Friday's action delivered a pitcher's duel, as Midland (28-33) starter Jeff Criswell (0-1) made his Double-A debut with one run on eight hits in six innings, striking out five and walking two batters. Three hits from Frisco right fielder **Kellen** Strahm tied his season-best on May 28th against San Antonio. Shortstop **Jonathan Ornelas** also finished with three hits, his 13th time this season doing so. The RoughRiders' 1-0 win is their lowest-scoring win this season and their first since a 1-0 win in Corpus Christi on June 17th, 2021. Riders reliever **Triston Polley** made his Double-A debut with 1.1 scoreless innings out of the bullpen. Reliever Joe Corbett delivered the final two outs in the eighth inning with a strikeout and Nick Starr locked down the 1-0 with a strikeout in the ninth for his third save of the year.

JONNY ON THE SPOT:

Riders infielder **Jonathan Ornelas** has been on fire at the plate all season long, but recently, he has been even better. Over his last 11 games, Ornelas is hitting .404 (19-for-47)/.444/.660 with a double, a triple, three home runs, 12 RBIs and four runs. On a season-long six-game hitting streak, he is batting .560 (14-for-25)/.571/.920/1.491 with four three-hit games. This season, he leads the Riders with 25 multi-hit games and 13 games with three or more hits. Ornelas is leading all active hitters in Double-A with a .352 batting average while he is second in hits (80). His batting average is the fourth-best in the minors and he is tied for the second-most hits in MiLB.

BEING THE BIGGER(S) MAN:

Since coming back from the Injured List, Jax Biggers has been on fire for Frisco. While reaching safely in all 13 games that he has played in, Biggers has also hit safely in his last 11 games, batting .381 (16-for-42)/.409/.524 with three doubles, a home run, four RBIs, four runs, one walk and two stolen bases. Biggers played 91 games with Frisco in 2021, hitting .224/.287/.321 with 12 doubles, four home runs and 14 steals.

GOT IT BY MORE THAN JUST A HAIR:

Trey Hair has been crushing the baseball in June. He has homered in five-straight games in Amarillo, a franchise record for consecutive games with a home run. Hitting home runs in four straight been done five times, most recently by J.T. Wise from August 28-31, 2014 prior to Hair. On Monday, Hair won the Texas League Player of the Week award. Over his last 12 games, Hair is batting .304/.360/.826 with three doubles, seven home runs and 14 RBIs. His seven homers in June are tied for the most in the Texas League during the month.

SENDIN' IN BRENNAN:

Riders pitcher Tim Brennan has been lights out since coming to the RoughRiders from Extended Spring Training. After joining the team in mid-May, Brennan is 1-1 with a 1.20 ERA over 15.0 innings. In his six outings, including a start on Tuesday, Brennan has allowed just two runs on 10 hits with 16 strikeouts and just one walk. Opponents are hitting just .189 against him while a ridiculously high 65.8 percent of balls put in play against him have been on the ground, leading to a .243 BABIP.

IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

Riders outfielder **Kellen Strahm** started off slowly, but he has started to turn his offensive game around. Over his last 16 games, Strahm is hitting .429 (21-for-49)/.525/.612 with three doubles, two home runs, 10 walks, 10 runs and five RBIs. In that stretch, Strahm has raised his average from .148 to .253 and his OPS from .528 to .754. In his last 22 games, he is batting .352/.452/.479/.931. Among those with at least 160 PA in the Texas League, Strahm is fourth in walk rate (16.8 percent).

THREE IS A MAGIC NUMBER:

Frisco has played a lot of close games this season and when scoring or allowing three runs, the Riders have seen a pretty predictable result. This season, the Riders are 3-19 when scoring three runs or fewer and 15-2 when allowing three runs or fewer

NO ONE MAN SHOULD HAVE ALL THAT POWER:

The RoughRiders have relied heavily on the home run ball this season. Through 61 games, Frisco has hit 88 long balls (1.4 per game) which is the second-most in the Texas League and ninth in Minor League Baseball. At this rate, the RoughRiders would finish the season with 199 home runs, a mark which would be the most in franchise history (topping 2007 when Frisco hit 176 home runs). Out of their 61 total games, the Riders have hit home runs in 44 games, which means that when they hit a home run, they are averaging 2.0 home runs per game when they hit them. In the 17 games that the Riders have not hit a home run, Frisco is just 7-10. **Blaine Crim** and **Trey Hair** are tied for the team lead while being tied for sixth in the league with 12 home runs. The power surge has ballooned the Riders team OPS to .812, the seventh-best mark in the minors.

ABOUT JACK											

-Leiter was drafted in the first round (No. 2 overall) in 2021 by the Rangers out of Vanderbilt University. With the Commodores, Leiter was a unanimous First Team All-American and a finalist for both the Golden Spikes Award and the Dick Howser Trophy.

-Threw first regular-season, complete-game no-hitter to start SEC play since 1971 against No.16 South Carolina on March 20th, 2021. He walked the first batter of the game before retiring the last 27 he saw with 16 strikeouts on 124 pitches. Followed up that no-hitter with 7.0 no-hit innings in his next start (20.2 consecutive no-hit innings over three starts from March 20th - April 2nd).

-Drafted in 20th round in 2019 by NYY out of Delbarton School (NJ). Named 2019 New Jersey Gatorade POY, striking out 95 in 57 innings as a senior.

-The family lineage is strong with Jack. His father, Al, pitched in 19 MLB seasons (1987-2005), making two All-Star teams and winning both the 1993 and 1997 World Series. His uncle, Mark, played 11 seasons in the majors (1990-99; 2001) and his cousin, Mark Jr., pitched two seasons (2017-2018) with Philadelphia and Toronto. Al now works as an analyst for MLB Network.

2022 SEASON

-Leiter entered the 2022 season as the No. 17 prospect in baseball according to MLB.com. He is listed as the No.1 prospect in the Rangers organization as well.

-Leiter dazzeled in his professional debut, striking out seven over his three innings against the Arkansas Travelers on April 9th. The righty helped draw the largest crowd since 2019 at Riders Field for the debut (9,322).

-Threw the Riders first quality start of the season on May 7th against Arkansas. Leiter retired the last 15 batters he saw, allowing just two hits (one in the first and one in the second inning).

-Leiter came out of the bullpen is a "start" to finish a suspended game on May 31st (game was finished on June 1st) and recorded a career-best eight strikeouts against Wichita over 5.2 innings. The game resulted in a 3-0 win for Frisco, the Riders second shutout win of the season to that point.

-The righty allowed just one home run over his first nine outings before allowing two against Amarillo on June 7th. The two home runs were a grand slam and a two-run shot in a 7-4 loss to the Sod Poodles.

2021 SEASON

-After being drafted second overall in the 2021 draft, Leiter did not pitch in the minor leagues. Instead, he returned to Vanderbilt to workout, continue college and prepare for 2022. Did not finish degree, but got closer.

MORE INFO

-Leiter was high school teammates with Yankees No. 1 prospect (No. 8 in baseball) Anthony Volpe at Delbarton School (NI).
