Round Rock and El Paso will prepare for game three of the series on Thursday night. Chihuahuas LHP Jay Groome is scheduled to start against Express LHP Cole Ragans. First pitch at Dell Diamond is set for 7:05 pm. CT.

SERIES SITS EVEN

The Express fell to the Chihuahuas by a final of 8-4 on Wednesday. El Paso struck first after the first five batters reached and DH Brett Sullivan smacked a sacrifice fly to cap off the inning and made it a 3-0 game. In the home half, Round Rock answered back with a run from a double off the bat of LF J.P. Martinez. He eventually scored on a stolen base and an error. In the third, the Chihuahuas tacked on three more runs where C Kevin Plawecki capped off the inning with a single that scored Azocar and extended the El Paso lead to 6-1. Express DH Brad Miller launched a two-run home run after Martinez led off the third inning with a triple and pulled Round Rock within three runs. E-Train 3B Yoshi Tsutsugo led off the home half of the fourth inning with a solo shot to make it a 6-4 game. The Chihuahuas tallied a run in the eighth and in the ninth, C Kevin Plawecki doubled to put the visitors up 8-4 as Azocar scored and the score stood final as Round Rock went scoreless in the ninth.

COLE GETS THE CALL

LHP Cole Ragans will take the mound for Round Rock for the first time this season after he was optioned from Texas on Tuesday. With the Rangers this year, Ragans went 2-3 with a 5.92 ERA (16 ER/24.1 IP) in 17 relief appearances. He has walked 14 and tallied 24 punchouts.

ALL GAS, NO BREAKS

Express OF Elier Hernandez extended his hitting streak to 18 games on Wednesday after his 1-for-5 night against El Paso. Over his 18-game hitting streak, the righty is batting .468 (37-79) with eight doubles, two triples, six home runs, 31 RBI, 21 runs scored, nine walks and 17 strikeouts. The 18-game streak also remains the second longest in the Pacific Coast League, just one game behind Oklahoma City INF Jahmai Jones. The 18-game mark for Hernandez is tied for the fifth longest streak in club history and is the most since INF Josh Jung hit safely in 18 games in 2021.

BRAD BOMB

Texas Rangers rehabber DH Brad Miller went 2-for-5 with two hits, including one home run, and three strikeouts on Wednesday after going hitless on Tuesday night. Through two games in Round Rock, Miller is 2-for-7 with a home run, two RBI, one run scored and three strikeouts.

SCORELESS EXPRESS DEBUT

RHP Ryan Tepera made his Express debut on Wednesday night against the Chihuahuas and pitched a scoreless fifth inning that saw just one El Paso hit. It was his first Triple-A action since the 2019 season when he appeared in five games with the Buffalo Bisons, the Triple-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays.

NO CATCHING J.P.

Despite his 27-game on-base streak coming to an end on Tuesday, Express OF J.P. Martinez didn't bat an eye and went 2-for-3 with one double, one triple, two runs scored and two walks at the plate on Wednesday night. Martinez also recorded a season-high three stolen bases, which puts him at 19 on the year. He has the second-most stolen bases among players in the PCL despite missing nearly a month of play.

ON TO NEXT HALF

After Round Rock fell to El Paso yesterday, the Oklahoma City Dodgers clinched the PCL First-Half title and will host the PCL Championship Series. The second half of the season begins on June 28.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2023 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's Pacific Coast League debut. Davis spent the previous two years as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.

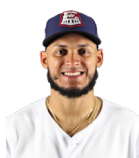
