Under Gardenhire (since '21)... 259-237 LAST TIME OUT: The Saints fell down 3-0 before Brooks Lee gave the LAST TIME OUT: The Saints fell down 3-0 before Brooks Lee gave the Saints the lead with a grand slam en route to a 5-4, rain-shortened victory in six innings on Tuesday. Adam Plutko gave up five of his seven hits in the first two innings as the Saints trailed by three headed to the bottom of the second inning. After two outs were recorded, seven straight Saints reached, including a grand slam from Lee, giving the Saints a 5-3 lead. Plutko went on to retire 12 of the next 14 Mud Hen hitters before allowing a solo home run to Eddys Leonard in the sixth inning. They also got their first complete game in franchise history, as Adam Plutko threw all 5.1 innings in the shortened contest.

It marks the 11th complete game in the IL this season, but it is the second-shortest complete game this year. lowa's Thomas Pannone was credited with a complete game after 5.0 innings of work on May 15.

PUT IT ON THE MANTLE: Not only did the Saints sweep Louisville last week, they also swept the International League weekly awards. Randy Dobnak and Matt Wallner were named the IL Pitcher and Player of the Week, respectively, on Monday. They are the first weekly award winners for the Saints in 2024.

\$Wallner hit a league-best .519 across six games in Louisville, going 14-27 with two doubles, pacing the league with both five home runs and 11 RBI. He also led the league in hits, slugging percentage (1.148), OPS (1.700), total bases (31) and runs (11).

> WALLNER WARMING UP: In his 13 June games, Matt Wallner has hit .383/.448/.900 sporting a 1.248 OPS. He's hit a league-high nine home runs in his this month, averaging a 94.5 mph exit velocity and owns a .534 ISO in that span. He's also the league leader in June in RBI (19), slugging percentage, total bases (54) and extra-base hits (13).

NO WALKS FOR YOU!: Over the last 10 games, the Saints have walked just 16 batters. The 224 walks issued by the Saints are the fewest in Triple-A, in addition to their 2.92 strikeouts per walk which also leads the circuit. The next closest is Durham at 2.75. Over the last 10 games, the Saints have struck out 99 batters to their 16 walks, a 6.19 K/BB ratio, the best in all of baseball.

GO, DIEGO, GO!: Diego A. Castillo has surged again over his last 14 games, hitting .386 (17-44) with three doubles and two home runs with a 1.114 OPS. Over that 14-game span, Castillo has walked 10 times and struck out only find times.

KEMP KRUSHING: Tony Kemp has turned it on over his last 20 games since May 22, hitting .351 (27-for-77). In that stretch he has hits in 14 of those 20 games, nine multi-hit games and four three-hit nights. In his last 81 plate appearances, Kemp has drawn three walks and struck out nine times, sporting a .370 on-base percentage and a .519 slugging percentage.
