SPRINGDALE, AR – The Northwest Arkansas Naturals could not keep up with the Springfield Cardinals Thursday night, dropping a third straight game this series, 11-2.

- The Naturals' lone runs of the game, came in the bottom of the third inning, on a two-run homer from **Brhet Bewley**, his second of the season, as the time bringing the Naturals within two, a 4-2 deficit.
- Maikel Garcia** doubled to lead off the bottom of the first inning, while **Nick Loftin** singled in the fifth, the only other hits for Northwest Arkansas in the loss. Springfield pitching retired the Naturals in order over the final 13 batters of the night, the last batter reaching base being Loftin's fifth inning single.
- After Bewley's homer, while the Naturals put a couple of runners on, the Cardinals scored seven runs unanswered, too many to come back from.
- Alec Marsh** worked around trouble multiple times, pitching into the sixth inning for the second time this season, as he allowed five runs (three earned) on six hits with six strikeouts.
- Zack Phillips** was charged with one unearned run in 1.1 innings, while **Yefri Del Rosario** surrendered five runs in the ninth inning.

### THIS DAY IN NATURALS HISTORY

#### The Naturals are 2-5 all-time when playing on June 24

On June 24, 2016, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals beat the Tulsa Drillers, 7-1 at ONEOK Field. Starting pitcher **Eric Skoglund** pitched 7.0 innings, allowing just four hits without a walk, surrendering just one unearned run while striking out five. Shortstop **Jack López** capped a four-run second inning with a three-run homer, the first baseman **Frank Schwindel** drilled solo home runs in the fifth and eighth inning. Schwindel led the way offensively with three hits, though four other Naturals offered two-hit games and eight of nine starters in the lineup had at least one hit.

**FOLLOW THE LEADER**

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 16 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 8 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: **Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Jake Means, Noah Murdock, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter** and **John Rave**.

**EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM**

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring seven runs or more, the Naturals are 25-2, while when scoring six runs or less, just 6-32.
- The Naturals are 19-7 when recording 10 hits or more, but when they get nine hits or less, are just 12-27.
- The Naturals are 29-10 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 2-24 when out-hit by their opponent.
- When the Naturals score first, they are 20-10, whereas 11-24 when the opponent scores first.

**ONE RUN GOES A LONG WAY**

The Naturals are 3-13 in one-run games this season, meaning 13 of their 34 losses this season have been decided by just one run.

- Nine of the Naturals' last 20 losses have been by just a run.
- The Naturals have had the winning run at the plate in eight losses this season (six one-run losses) and had the tying run at the plate or on base in 15 losses this season (including 10 of their one-run losses).

**RIGHT WHERE THEY BELONG**

The Northwest Arkansas Naturals have generally hovered around .500 for most of the season, but the loss yesterday brought the team down to three games under .500 with a 31-34 record ... the Naturals have been at or within a game of .500 after 40 of 65 games this season (62.5%).

- The team has peaked at two games above .500, at a 15 - 13 record after the game May 10, but with a low-point of four games under .500 on two occasions.
- After 14 of 65 games this season, the Naturals have ended the day with an even .500 record.
- After 26 of 65 games this season, the Naturals have ended the day within a game of .500, either one game over or under.

**Yo, You Wanna See Some Real Speed?**

Through 65 games, the Naturals have stolen 90 bases in 106 attempts (average 1.38 steals/game, 84.91% success rate).

- 90 steals ranks tied second in the Texas League, tied fourth in Double-A and tied 23rd in the Minors.
- Maikel Garcia's** 22 steals (in 24 attempts) ranks tied third in the Texas League and tied fifth in all of Double-A.
- The Naturals have pulled off a double steal 12 times, meaning 24 of 90 steals this year (26.7%) have come on a double-steal.
- The Naturals have stolen at least one base in 42 of 65 games this season, including 24 games with two or more steals ... there have been three occasions where the team has stolen five bases, with perfect 5-for-5 steal efforts as a club on 5/13 vs. Wichita and 5/21 @ Arkansas.

**GAR-SEE YA ON BASE**

Shortstop **Maikel Garcia** has reached base in 55 of the 62 games he has played in this season, reaching base multiple times on 36 occasions, including a team-best 20 multi-hit games.

- In 293 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 110 times (74 hits + 36 walks), for a .378 on-base percentage.
- Garcia has walked 36 times and struck out 47 times, a 0.77 K/BB rate.
- The shortstop places among the Texas League leaders in several categories, ranking third in hits (74), and tied third in stolen bases (22), fourth in doubles (19) and tied ninth in runs scored (46) ... he ranks among the Double-A leaders in hits (fifth), steals (tied fifth) and doubles (tied sixth).
- Maikel's 19 doubles lead all Royals Minor League hitters ... he is tied for the organization lead with 36 walks and ranks 2nd in hits (74), runs scored (46) and steals (22), while fourth in on-base percentage (.378), fifth in batting average (.292) and fifth in total bases (101).
- His 14-game hitting streak between April 27 and May 12 is the longest on the Naturals this year, tied for the 15th-longest in club history and tied for the second-longest in the Texas League this season ... in those 14 games, he hit .397 (23-for-58) with six doubles and a .970 OPS.

**PUSHIN P(ORTER)**

Catcher **Logan Porter** has quietly flown under the radar as one of the top hitters in the Royals system so far in 2022.

- Among full-season Minor League hitters, Porter ranks third in on-base percentage (.994) ... he places second among Double-A hitters in OBP, seventh in batting average (.325) and OPS (.994) ... in the Texas League, he is second in OBP, fifth in OPS, seventh in batting average and 10th in slugging percentage (.529).
- Among qualified Royals minor league hitters, Porter has the highest batting average, on-base percentage and OPS and ranks third in slugging percentage behind Omaha's Vinnie Pasquantino (.588) and teammate Tyler Gentry (.535) ... his 36 walks are tied for the most in the system, with teammate Maikel Garcia.
- Porter has reached base in 44 of 47 games he's played this season, with hits in 31 of 47 and 17 multi-hit games, nine of which came in May.
- In the month of June, Porter is hitting .340 (17-for-50) with three home runs and 10 runs batted in, along with a 1.140 OPS. His batting average this month ranks ninth in the Texas League, while his OPS ranks as the fifth-highest.
- In the month of May, Porter hit .343 (24-for-70) with a team-best 1.017 OPS and he had drove in 13 runs with 11 walks.

**TYLER, THE CREATOR (OF RUNS)**

Since joining the Naturals at the start of last week from High-A Quad Cities, outfielder **Tyler Gentry** has not skipped a beat from his hot start with the River Bandits.

- Through his first eight games with the Naturals, Gentry is hitting .258 (8-for-31) with five extra base hits (two doubles, three home runs) and seven runs batted in ... his five RBI last week were tied for the team lead.
- Gentry ranks as one of best hitters in the Royals' system this season, ranking second among qualified hitters in the organization in batting average (.321), on-base percentage (.414), slugging percentage (.535) and third in OPS (.949), trailing teammate Logan Porter in every category except, slugging percentage, where he trails Vinnie Pasquantino and in front of Porter.
- While he played in just 10 games in April, the 2020 Draft Pick had a ridiculous start to the season, hitting .471 (16-for-34) with five extra-base hits and seven runs batted in for Quad Cities ... he had hits in his last seven games with the River Bandits before being promoted to Northwest Arkansas, each of his first seven games in the month of June.

**Pitchers of the Month (1)**

\* **May: LHP Drew Parrish** ... started five games and went 3-1 with a 0.59 ERA (2 ER in 30.2 IP) ... only allowed 15 hits and four walks, while striking out 29 opposing hitters ... among qualified Texas League pitchers, threw the most innings and had the lowest ERA and WHIP (0.62), while holding opponents to a .144 average.

**Players of the Week (2)**

\* **April 25 to May 1: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit .417 (10-for-28) across six games with a league-best 19 total bases and nine runs batted in, while tied for the Texas League lead with 10 hits. His 1.221 OPS ranked third among players with at least 20 at-bats, while his .417 average tied for second among that same group.

\* **May 23 to May 29: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit a league-best .481 (13-for-27) across six games in Midland, while tied for the league lead with 19 total bases. He drove in nine runs as well, doubling three times with one home run, a go-ahead grand slam on May 24 and collected multiple hits in each of the first five games of the series.

**Pitchers of the Week (3)**

\* **May 2 to May 8: LHP Drew Parrish** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 7 @ Springfield ... held the Cardinals to just two hits and one walk while striking out four. He retired the first eight he faced and the final five, with five 1-2-3 frames.

\* **May 9 to May 15: LHP Drew Parrish** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 13 vs. Wichita ... held the Wind Surge to just three hits and no walks while striking out nine. Between the second and sixth innings, he retired 13 straight batters, retiring the side 1-2-3 in the first inning, as well as the third through sixth.

\* **June 6 to June 12: LHP Anthony Veneziano** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings in a complete-game shutout on June 9 @ Tulsa ... held the Drillers to just three hits and one walk while striking out five, on 79 pitches. Retired the final eight hitters he faced and 11 of the last 12, only needing five pitches for a 1-2-3 seventh inning to end the night.


## #36 CHRIS WIDGER • MANAGER

- Widger and his wife, Whitney, reside in Pennsville, N.J., with their children: C.J., Ashlynn and Skylar.




## #43 DERRICK LEWIS • PITCHING COACH

- Abraham Núñez enters his fourth season as Northwest Arkansas' hitting coach after serving in the same capacity with High-A Wilmington (2015-2018), Class-A Lexington (2014), Rookie Advanced Burlington (2013) and the Dominican Royals (2012).
- Núñez played for parts of 12 seasons in the Majors with the Pirates (1997-2004), Cardinals (2005), Phillies (2006-2007) and Mets (2008). A switch-hitter, he owns a career average of .242 as a utility infielder in the big leagues, primarily playing third base, but could play all four infield positions.

- Born in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic, he now resides in Hudson, Massachusetts.



## #27 CHRISTIAN COLÓN • ASSISTANT HITTING COACH

- Christian Colón returns to the organization as the Naturals Assistant Hitting Coach in 2022, following a 12-year professional career.
- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
- After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... in 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices (21), while leading the team in at-bats (491) and hits (126). His 21 sacrifices that season are the most a Naturals player has ever recorded in a single season, while 28 overall are tied for the club record.
- During his playing career, he made stops in Miami (2017) and Cincinnati (2019-20) ... spent 2021 with the Rich Baseball-owned Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto) before announcing his retirement.
- He also played in parts of four seasons in the Puerto Rican Winter League.
- Christian lives in Cave Springs, Ark. (15 minutes North of Arvest Ballpark) with his wife, Kayla, and three daughters, Marley, Mia and Lucy.



## #23 MIKE JIRSCHOLE • BENCH COACH

- Mike Jirschele enters his first season as the Bench Coach for Northwest Arkansas after spending last season in the same role for Manager Chris Widger in Quad Cities.
- He served as a Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020 and was on the Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015.

- Jirschele was originally selected by the Texas Rangers in the fifth round of the 1977 MLB Draft and played in 999 minor league games over 13-plus seasons in the Rangers and Royals systems.

- Mikkelsen earned his bachelor's degree in exercise and wellness from Arizona State University in 2016. He resides in Desert Hills, Arizona.




