2026 Media Notes – September 6th at Hub City (Rangers)

Last Game Recap... Kodey Shojinaga and Wuifredo Antunez both homered as the BlueClaws topped Hub City 7-5 on Saturday night to pull within three games to two in their season-concluding six game series...Tanner Gresham gave up two earned runs in five innings to earn the win while Titan Kennedy-Hayes gave up an unearned run in the ninth but still earned his fourth save.

State of the Claws... The BlueClaws have dropped three of the first five in South Carolina with Hub City...The BlueClaws sit at 47-82 on the year and 21-43 in the second half...They went 2-4 last week in Lakewood against Wilmington.

Lock It Down... Titan Kennedy-Hayes saved wins last Saturday against Hudson Valley, and Tuesday and Saturday this week against Hub City for the BlueClaws, giving him four on the season and one more than Wen-Hui Pan for the team lead...Gabe Craig, Keegan Batka, Danyony Pulido all have two for the BlueClaws this year.

Kodey Goes Yard... Kodey Shojinaga hit his second BlueClaws home run on Saturday night (6/23 at Brooklyn was the other) amid a three hit game...His home run was the third of his professional career after he hit one with Clearwater last year...He had been in a 2-26 slump before his three hit game on Saturday...A Honolulu native, Shojinaga was a 6th round pick of the Phillies in 2024 from the University of Kansas.

A Great Day... Brady Day had two hits and his 5th BlueClaws home run on Friday night... Day is 18-58 since being reinstated from the 60-day IL on August 18th and has six two-hit games as well, with his first home run...He had a 15 game hitting streak snapped on Wednesday when he went 0-5...He was 24-61 over that stretch, tying the longest streak by a BlueClaw as a High-A affiliate (Leandro Pineda and Zach Arnold in 2024), and tied for the 7th longest in team history (Jiwan James has the record at 24 from 2010)... He was hitting .292 in 19 games at the time of his injury, adding four home runs 12 RBIs, and 15 walks (.948 OPS).

Back in the Home Run Column... Nate Humphreys joined the BlueClaws in July and on July 31st, homered at Hudson Valley in his second BlueClaws at bat...His second Jersey Shore home run came on Friday at Hub City, his 14th overall home run this year after he hit 12 with Clearwater...Humphreys was a non-drafted free agent signing in 2025 from Dallas Baptist.

Four For Villa... Juan Villavicencio, the Phillies #20 prospect per MLB Pipeline, had four hits in the win Tuesday, his first stateside four hit game, the third by a BlueClaw this year, and the second of his career (7/14/2022 with the DSL-Phillies White)...Villavicencio added the go-ahead RBI single in the seventh and the game-winning RBI single in the 10th...He joined the BlueClaws from Clearwater on July 31st where he was hitting .298 with 13 home runs and 20 stolen bases.

A Return to Spartanburg... The BlueClaws are in Spartanburg this week to take on the Spartanburgers, marking the BlueClaws first visit to Spartanburg since the Phillies affiliation ended there following the 1994 season...The Spartanburg Phillies played in the Western Carolinas and the South Atlantic Leagues from 1963 through 1994 before moving to Kannapolis (Piedmont Boll Weevils) in 1995 and to Lakewood (as the BlueClaws) in 2001...Former Phillies to play in Spartanburg include (alphabetical order) Ricky Bottalico, Larry Bowa, Mike Liberthal, Mickey Morandini, Dickie Noles, Scott Rolen, Juan Samuel, Ryne Sandberg, Kevin Stocker, and Manny Trillo.

Great Eight... The BlueClaws stole eight bases on Sunday including three by Wuifredo Antunez and two each by Juan Villavicencio and Devin Saltiban...The eight stolen bases by the BlueClaws were the most of their season and one off the club record of nine set three times, most recently in 2024.

A New Team Record... The BlueClaws have now stolen 229 bases on the year on the year, a new club record (Devin Saltiban leads the team with 32 while Carter Mathison has 26)...They broke their previous team record of 210 set in 2009 (Anthony Gose led that team with 76, a club record)...They reached 200 for the first time as a High-A affiliate last year when Bryan Rincon led the team with 40...The 210 from the 2009 season led the South Atlantic League, though this year with 222, the BlueClaws rank seventh of 12).

TJaying... TJay Walton, who had two hits on Saturday and two more on Tuesday, is 10-32 in his last nine games...He hit his first High-A home run on August 23rd vs Hudson Valley...Walton joined the BlueClaws on August 4th from Clearwater where he was hitting .238 in 22 games with two home runs...Walton has drawn 16 walks in 86 BlueClaws plate appearances and had 24 in 88 Threshers plate appearances...He was originally a 4th round pick of the Phillies in 2023 from IMG Academy in Bradenton and hails from Emporia, Virginia.

Salt It Up... Devin Saltiban homered on Tuesday at Hub City and had two, two-hit games last week...He is now 22-70 in his last 20 games with three home runs (two hit on August 19th), seven walks and 12 runs scored...He has seven home runs on the year and 32 in his career...His two home run game on August 19th was the third of his career, and first since May of 2024 with Clearwater...On August 12th at Brooklyn, Saltiban threw out the go-ahead run at the plate in the bottom of the eighth inning with a throw from right field.

Youth Movement... Until recently, Devin Saltiban was the only 21 year old on the BlueClaws, but they have added several more over the last few weeks...IF Romeli Espinosa (18), C Alirio Ferrebus (20, on the IL)...OF Griffin Burkholder (20, turns 21 on August 30th) C Angel Mata (21), IF Juan Villavicencio (21), and OF TJay Walton (21) have all joined Saltiban as players ages 21 or younger on the BlueClaws.

Extra, Extra... The BlueClaws are now 7-9 in extra innings after their win on Tuesday at Hub City...They dropped two extra inning games against Hudson Valley (August 18th and 22nd)...The BlueClaws played five extra inning games by May 2nd, and three in a row against Brooklyn from April 9-11 in Lakewood, going 1-2 in those games...They have played nine extra inning games in Lakewood this year (the team record is 14 in 2010).

Mr. 900...The BlueClaws entered the season having used 894 different players in their club history, and technically, RHP Danyony Pulido, who threw a scoreless eighth inning on 4/4, was the sixth player to appear in a game this year that had not yet done so before the season, making him the 900th player to play in a game for the BlueClaws.

Going Deep...BlueClaws starters have thrown six innings in a game 10 times this year – once by Sam Highfill on June 9th at Hudson Valley, six by Reese Dutton (most recently on July 7th at Frederick) and three by Ryan Dromboski (including May 26th vs Frederick)....The last BlueClaw to throw seven innings in a game was Braydon Tucker on September 7, 2024 at Aberdeen.

Second Half Underway...The SAL Northern Division Second Half Champion will play Frederick in the first round of the post-season...Bowling Green won the Southern Division First Half title...In 2023, Jersey Shore made the playoffs despite a 7-14 start to the second half, going 30-15 the rest of the way to clinch on the final day of the season.

Extra, Extra...The BlueClaws have played 65 home games, and nine have gone to extra innings (4-5 at home, 6-9 overall in extra innings)...The BlueClaws played 10 extra inning games all of last year (two at home)...Extra Inning Home Games By Year: 2021 (3), 2022 (3), 2023 (8), 2024 (3), 2025 (2)...Since 2005, the most extra inning games they have played at home is 14 (7-7) in 2010...They have reached double-figures four times, most recently in 2012.

Things in 10s...The BlueClaws have already reached 10+ runs in a game nine times this year (most recently on 7/12 at FRE), and scored 19 on Opening Night in Wilmington, a new club record...Last year, the BlueClaws scored 10+ runs in a game seven times...After their 13-2 win on April 18th, the BlueClaws have won by 10 runs or more three times already this year...They did so twice all of last year, four times in 2024, once in 2023, and once in 2021 (8 times as a High-A affiliate from 2021-2025).

Familiar Faces...Of the 30 players on the BlueClaws Break Camp Roster, 22 are returning to the BlueClaws and only eight are making their BlueClaws debuts...By comparison, last year, 13 players on the Break Camp roster made their BlueClaws debuts...The new faces: LHP Juan Amarante, RHP Ryan Degges, RHP Adilson Peralta, RHP Danyony Pulido, RHP Giuseppe Velasquez, IF Brady Day, IF Raider Tello, and OF Carter Mathison.

Walk-Off This Way...The BlueClaws have six walk-off wins this year...Trent Farquhar had a 12th inning walk-off single on 7/23 vs Brooklyn...Nick Biddison hit a walk-off home run on 7/22 against Brooklyn...Tyler Pettorini hit a walk off home run on Father's Day (6/21) against Greenville (the third walk-off home run by the BlueClaws as a High-A affiliate – Felix Reyes in 2023 and Kehden Hettiger in 2025)...They beat Brooklyn 5-4 in 10 innings on June 4th on an RBI single from Luis Caicuto...They beat Hudson Valley on 5/2 on a strikeout/passed ball...They picked up their first walk-off win in 2026 on 4/9 vs Brooklyn on an 11th inning RBI single from Devin Saltiban...The BlueClaws had three walk-off wins last year – a 9/4 win over Brooklyn when Dante Nori scored on a 10th inning wild pitch, an 8/7 win over Hub City on a 9th inning single from Avery Owusu-Asiedu and a 5/6 win over Aberdeen on a home run by Kehden Hettiger.

The Big Five...The BlueClaws have used two pitchers from Big Five schools in Philadelphia...RHP Luke Gabrysh went to St. Joseph's and RHP Ryan Dromboski went to the University of Pennsylvania.

College Teammates...The BlueClaws have one pair of college teammates in C Kodey Shojinaga and RHP Tegan Cain, who played together at Kansas.

Just Grand...Nick Biddison hit a grand slam on August 2nd at Hudson Valley...Luis Caicuto hit a grand slam in Rome on April 17th...Bryan Rincon's grand slam on May 20, 2025 vs Brooklyn was the BlueClaws first since Jordan Dissin's on June 11, 2024 at Greensboro...The BlueClaws hit three grand slams between 2021 and 2023, but they hit three grand slams in two weeks in 2024 – one by Justin Crawford (May 30th), one by Emaarion Boyd (June 9th), and one by Jordan Dissin (June 11th)...These were the only three grand slams hit by the BlueClaws in 2024.

From The Shore to the Show...136 players have now gone *From the Shore, to the Show* including two to debut Opening Week with the Phillies and nine total this year...**Justin Crawford** (2023-24 BlueClaw) made his debut in the March 26th season opener while **Andrew Painter** (2022 BlueClaw) debuted on March 31st in the fifth game of the season...RHP **George Klassen** (2024 BlueClaw) debuted on April 6th with the Angels...IF **Hao-Yu Lee** (2022-23 BlueClaw) debuted on April 17th with the Tigers...UT **Felix Reyes** (2023-24 BlueClaw) debuted on April 18th with the Phillies and homered in his first at bat...C **Rodolfo Duran** (2018 BlueClaw) debuted on May 7th with the Padres...OF **Gabriel Rincones** (2023 BlueClaw) debuted on June 12th with the Phillies...RHP **Julian Garcia** (2018 BlueClaw) debuted on June 24th with the Reds...RHP **Alex McFarlane** debuted on July 22nd with the Phillies...Two former BlueClaws made debuts in 2025 – RHP Mick Abel (2022 BlueClaw) and UT Otto Kemp (2023-24 BlueClaw).

Mycal Jones Takes Over...Mycal Jones, in his seventh year in the organization, takes over for Greg Brodzinski as the new BlueClaws manager and is the 18th manager in BlueClaws history...Jones was a coach with Reading last year and with Clearwater the two years prior...He played in the Braves system and was originally a fourth round pick in 2009.

On the Staff...Ryan Buchter returns the BlueClaws as the pitching coach...Buchter went to Highland Regional High School in Blackwood, New Jersey...Darnell Sweeney, with the FCL Phillies last year, is the hitting coach...Ryan Wrobleksi makes his coaching debut after playing four years in the Astros organization, serving as the position coach and assistant hitting coach...Orlando Munoz returns to the BlueClaws position coach...Marissa VanHassel is the Athletic Trainer, Sam Cartier is the Assistant Athletic Trainer, and John Sweeney is the Strength & Conditioning Coach.

Going Deep – Since the BlueClaws became a High-A affiliate in 2021, they have had 22 starts in which their starting pitcher threw at least seven innings. The following players did so multiple times: Matt Osterberg (3, 2023), Jean Cabrera (2, 2024), Ben Brown (2, 2022), Andrew Painter (2, 2022), Braydon Tucker (2, 2025)

- Cabrera (4/30 and 5/7/24) and Painter (8/6 and 8/13/22) are the only ones to do it in back to back starts.
