"FUN IS GOOD" FACTOIDS

LAST TIME OUT: With a shorthanded lineup that included at least three position players out with illness, the St. Paul Saints managed three home runs, but fell short in a 7-5 victory in the series opener on Tuesday at Victory Field. Nick Cimillo put the home side in front with a solo homer to left-center in the second to make it 1-0. Another long ball increased the lead for Indianapolis in the third; after an infield single by Enmanuel Valdez, Rafael Flores Jr. belted a 466-foot shot to center, the second-longest tracked home run in baseball this year, to extend the lead to 3-0. Walker Jenkins responded with his first homer of the season to lead off the fourth, cutting it to 3-1; the Twins' top prospect finished 2-for-5. Indy took Mike Paredes deep a third time in his first Triple-A start when Ronny Simon chased him with a three-run blast in the third. Two-run round-trippers from Kyler Fedko and Gabby Gonzalez in the fifth got then within a run, but Tommy La Sorsa and Mike Burrows combined to blank the Saints over the final two.

CHICKS DIG THE LONGBALL: The Saints lineup has gone deep in seven of their last eight games since April 12 in Toledo, having hit multiple home runs in each of those seven games. St. Paul are tied with the Syracuse Mets for the most homers hit in Triple-A during that run (19), and are tied for 2nd in all of minor league baseball, behind only Double-A Reading (21). Eleven different Saints hitters have gone deep over that span with Kyler Fedko leading the pack with five round-trippers. Gabby Gonzalez, Royce Lewis, Alan Roden, and Emmanuel Rodriguez all have hit two apiece in that stretch.

DROPPING DOUBLE DIGITS: Tuesday's series opener in Indianapolis marked the 12th game this season in which the Saints pitching staff have allowed double-digits in the hit column, including in each of the last four. The Saints' 12 games allowing 10 or more hits mark the most in the International League and third in all of Triple-A, trailing just a pair of PCL clubs. The Saints are 4-8 in games in which they give up 10+ base knocks, having won 3-last-5 such games. Only the Salt Lake Bees have won more games when seeing their opponents collect 10+ hits in Triple-A this year, having gone 5-11 in those situations.

LUCKY LEFTIES: Two Saints pitchers are headed to the big leagues for their Major League debuts, with left-handers Connor Prielipp and Kendry Rojas each getting the call on Tuesday. Prielipp, the Twins' preseason No. 4 prospect by *Baseball America*, has struck out 35% of hitters faced to start the season while running a 2.30 ERA. Rojas, 23, the No. 10 ranked prospect in the organization, impressed in two outings after opening the season on the injured list, throwing 6.0 scoreless innings while sitting 96.8 mph with his average fastball velocity, top-20 in the International League to start the season and nearly three ticks up from his average velo of 93.9 last year. They become the fourth and fifth St. Paul Saints promoted to Minnesota this year.

SWEET, SWEET VICTORY (FIELD): The Saints make their return to Victory Field for the first time since sweeping Pittsburgh's Triple-A affiliate in three games on Opening Weekend. The wins in three days from March 27-29 marked their first-ever sweep in the ballpark in franchise history. The Saints went just 1-5 in their lone series in Indianapolis last year and were just 1-11 the year prior. Since winning the first four games of a series from April 11-14, 2023 at Victory Field, the Saints had not even won back-to-back games in the ballpark until Opening Weekend; St. Paul were 2-19 in their previous 21 games in Indy entering the season.

RODEN, RODEN, RODEN, KEEP THEM DOGGIES ROLLIN: Saints outfielder Alan Roden is now riding a current five-game hit streak where he's 10-for-his-last-21 with two doubles and two home runs. The Middleton, WI native has also reached base in ten consecutive games and holds a .975 OPS in that run. Roden homered and walked in two plate appearances on Friday to extend both streaks, but exited the game after injuring his shoulder on a slide home. He returned to the lineup Tuesday after two days off.

LABORING EARLY, COMING ON STRONG LATE: Entering play Wednesday, the St. Paul Saints staff have thrown the most pitches in the International League as a team so far (3,553), including having exceeded 200 pitches thrown as a staff three times already this year (no other team in the International League has more than two). Tuesday's series opener in Indy marked the second-fewest bullets fired by the Saints staff this year (127). Over the first 16 games of the season, the Saints had the 3rd-fewest strikeouts (138) and the most walks issued in the league (97), but in the five games since then, they've combined for a 63:18 (3.50) strikeout-to-walk ratio, the 3rd-best in the league in that span (their 1.42 over the first 16 games was the worst).

VARIETY IS THE SPICE OF LIFE: In his first 21 games as Saints manager, Brian Dinkelman has turned in 21 unique lineup cards. No Saints hitter has batted from the same spot more than 10 times (Kaelen Culpepper leadoff) and only Culpepper (SS), Orlando Arcia (2B), Walker Jenkins (CF), and Alex Jackson (C) have started at least ten times at a given position.

TWINS OF TOMORROW: The Saints opened the season with nine of the Twins' Top-30 ranked prospects according to MLB.com, marking the most players listed on MLB's Minnesota Top-30 list to open a campaign in the Saints' history as a Triple-A franchise. Between Walker Jenkins, Kaelen Culpepper, Emmanuel Rodriguez, & Connor Prielipp, they touted four prospects on either the MLB.com or Baseball America Top-100 list, surpassing last year's total of three when Rodriguez, Luke Keaschall, and Zebby Matthews all began the year with the Saints. The remaining ranked prospects included Gabriel Gonzalez (7/10), Andrew Morris (13/13), Marco Raya (18/21), and John Klein (20/23). LHP Kendry Rojas (10/8) also opened the year on the Saints' injured list. Morris, Prielipp, and Rojas all have since joined the big league staff.

- Enters his first season as Twins farmhand...originally a 30th-round pick by the Angels in 2019...was released in May 2020 and signed with Toronto over a year later...spent the last 5 years in Jays system
- Has produced a sub-3.00 ERA in three straight seasons & owns a 2.66 ERA from 2023-25, which ranks 7th in MiLB among pitchers with at least 200 IP

2025

- Named the Warren Spahn Award Winner as the Triple-A Buffalo Most Valuable Pitcher for second year in-a-row

- Spent the entire season with Triple-A Buffalo, going 6-2, 2.57 ERA (24 ER, 84.0 IP) with 72 strikeouts (20 K%) and 36 walks (10 BB%) in 40 app. (5 GS)

- Ranked 7th in the International League in ERA (min. 50 IP)...threw a scoreless outing in 20-of-40 appearances, mostly in relief

LAST APPEARANCE: Started Saturday at home against Lehigh Valley...allowed three straight hits to open and base knocks to four of the first five batters faced...allowed two runs in the first and pitched around traffic to record four more outs with no further damage...threw 28 sweepers (41%), 22 four-seamers (32%), 11 sinkers (16%), and 8 changeups (12%)...recorded 7 swings-and-misses, led by five on the sweeper.

TROY PERCIVAL, YOU'RE MY HERO: A Southern California native, Bash's family were Angels season ticket-holders while Bash was growing up. He attended Game 7 of the 2002 World Series, where the Angels beat the Giants for the Commissioner's Trophy. Bash would go on to eventually be drafted by the Angels in the 30th round of the 2019 Draft. He would spend just one year with the Halos organization before being released in May of 2020, signing with the Missoula Paddleheads in Indy Ball for the start of 2021, and eventually latching on with the Blue Jays.

IT AIN'T MUCH, BUT IT'S HONEST WORK: Following the cancellation of the 2020 minor league season, Bash was working as a groundskeeper at his old college, California Baptist. In 2021, he got the call from the Missoula Paddleheads (Independent, Pioneer League) in 2021 and signed with them.

THE INVINCIBLE ONE: Spending most of the last two seasons with Triple-A Buffalo in the Toronto system, Andrew Bash is the back-to-back Warren Spahn Award winner, granted to the Bisons' Most Valuable Pitcher each season. Bash ranked 7th in the International League in ERA last season (min 50 IP) with a 2.57 mark, his second straight year throwing up a sub-3.00 ERA. The award is of course named for the Hall-of-Famer, who although he didn't ever play for the Bisons, is a South Buffalo native. Nicknamed "the Invincible One," Spahn won 363 games and threw 382 complete games in his illustrious 21-year career.
