Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Pedro Avila** to the mound tonight, looking to avoid the first 3G losing streak since 4/8-4/10. Toledo will counter with RHP **Grant Homan**. Columbus is 14-7 (.667) versus right handers this year. Holman has pitched against Columbus once in his career, on Tuesday (1.0IP, 4H, 2R, 2ER, 0BB, 0K).

vs. the Mud Hens

Columbus was 10-11 opposing Toledo last year (have not won a season series since going 11-10 in 2022), including a 4-5 mark at Huntington Park (lost each of last 4G). Individually, **Stuart Fairchild** has hit .341 (14x41) with 2HR and 6RBI against the Mud Hens in his career (11G), while **Nolan Jones** has hit 4HR and collected 14RBI in 33G. **Juan Brito** has 2HR and 16RBI in 25G.

Gone Cold

Like the infuriating weather that has rolled into Columbus, the bats have iced out with 0HR in the first 3G of the series (second time, 4/7-4/9 at Worcester). The lineup pounded 13HR in the last 5G of the Iowa series, but has 5HR in the 9G since (.325SLG, 20th in the IL). Last night was the second straight game in which the lineup produced 0XBH (third time this season, tied for 7th most in the IL).

Treading Water

Columbus is in danger of fall below .500 with a loss tonight, for just the second time all season (started the year 0-1, then had 5G win streak). After starting last season 12-5, the Clippers dipped under .500 on 4/30, at 13-14, and sank underwater for good on 5/2 (14-15, closest to .500 after that was 40-41). Columbus is +1 in run differential this year, spending the entirety of the season between -9 and +9.

On a Roll

Though he struggled in Buffalo (2x13 in 3G), **Kahlil Watson** is hitting .326/.482/.674 with 8XBH in his last 13G (1XBH in first 12G). He drew a walk last night, but has just 3BB in his last 5G (23PA), following three straight efforts with 2BB apiece (4/18-4/21, 15PA). When posting up in centerfield, as he is tonight, Watson is hitting .361/.500/.611 in 10G (46PA; .182/.333/.364 in all others, 68PA).

Familiar Surroundings

Juan Brito is slotting into the second spot in the batting order tonight for the 161st time in his Clipper career (74G and 340PA more than any other player in the IL since his Triple-A debut on 9/19/23). Brito is 0x7 in 2G since getting optioned earlier in the week, and is hitting .167/.286/.200 with a double and 3RBI in 8G since opening weekend (.500/.533/.833 with four doubles and 2RBI in first 3G).

Georgie Boy

George Valera was optioned to Columbus yesterday, starting his first official stint on the active roster. Valera appeared in 8G of a rehab assignment at the start of last month (left calf strain), hitting .294 (10x34) with 2HR and 12RBI (4x5 with 6RBI on 4/7 at Worcester). Upon activation, Valera hit .216/.237/.297 with 6RBI in 13G (37AB) for Cleveland, but was 4x27 (.148) in his last 10G (4/17-4/28).

Doesn't Go to Eleven

Nolan Jones couldn't get that extra push over the cliff last night, as his on base streak was snapped at 10G (.489OBP, 4/16-4/29; was 0x11 with a walk in previous 3G). Still, Jones is hitting .316 (12x38) over the last 11G, drawing 9BB to 9K. Only three Clipper streaks have gone over 10G and, though all are active, none of the batters are (**Petey Halpin**- 16, **Cooper Ingle**- 15, **Travis Bazzana**- 13).

Still Dominating

Stuart Fairchild was hitless in his last 2G at Buffalo, but is still 11x31 (.355) with 4XBH (.548SLG) over his last 8G (hitless in 16AB of 5G prior, 4/8-4/14, following a 14x33, .424, start to the season; 5XBH and .727SLG in first 9G). At home this year, he owns a 1.165OPS (.664 on the road), hitting safely in 10 of 12G (six multi-hit). Last night he became the eighth Clipper to reach 100PA (most in the IL).

No Experience Necessary

Maick Collado has hit safely in every game (7x18 with 3XBH and 3RBI in 5G) since skipping over Double-A to make his Triple-A debut on Sunday. His stolen base on Sunday was the 20th of his career (successful on 16 of 17 since 2023). He is the only Triple-A rookie in the lineup tonight, as rookies account for only 7% of plate appearances (**Juan Benjamin**- 48, **Collado**- 19, **Kevin Rivas**- 16).

This Date in Clipper History

5/1/2007

Brandon Watson singled off of Rochester's **Jeremy Cummings** in the 5th inning to start what would become the longest hitting streak in International League history (43 games). Watson's exploits during the streak (.360, 63x175, 15 multi-hit games) would earn him a promotion to the Majors, as his contract was purchased by Washington on 6/20 after the streak ended. He was named the '07 Clipper of the Year.

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,421 to 1,368).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 42-39 (.519) in pitch reviews, with batters going 27-29 (.482) and pitchers/catchers going 15-10 (.600). They have run out of challenges in 16G and have not challenged in 2G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 1-2 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 51-35 when playing past regulation (.593, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 86G to require extra play, 69 have been resolved after one frame (including eight DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

Didn't Add Up

The first half of the 2025 season saw the Clippers finish 12th with a 34-38 record (.472), despite ranking 10th in run differential (+3), 10th in pitching (4.61ERA) and 2nd in defense (.984; ranked 13th in batting, .250). Such a result was the product of a league-high 27 losses by three runs or fewer (22-27, .449, 13th), as they played in the fewest games decided by at least four runs (12-11, .522, 9th). In the second half, they went 19-21 in close games, while going 11-22 in blowouts.

Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 76 grand slams and 1,872RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

Not So Fast

On the basepaths, the 2024 Clippers established a franchise record of 200SB, (80% success rate) with four players topping 20 for the first time in club history. As a team, they were successful on 30 consecutive attempts (6/16-6/30/24) and 36 straight tries (7/23-8/7/24, including 8SB on 7/31/24 vs. Syracuse). Last season was a different story entirely, as they finished with the worst stolen base percentage in the IL (72%, 127SB and 49CS).

Three True Outcomes

While not breaking records last season, the Clipper pitching staff topped 660BB for the third time ever (all in last three years, franchise record of 767BB in 2023) and cleared 1,300K for the fourth time (all in the last four years, franchise record of 1,392K in 2024). The homer rate was down considerably last year, but the three true outcome rate still ended around 39% (the 2024 season saw franchise high of 40.5%; last six seasons have all been at least 37.0%, no seasons above 33.4% prior).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 12th in the IL this year (.978), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 18G this season (9-9, .500), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

Good Baseball

Stuart Fairchild moved a runner into scoring position with a sac bunt on 4/26 at Buffalo and that runner came around to score in a rare loss. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 84-23 (.785) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 1-2 (.333, blew 7-run lead in on of the losses) mark this season (went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses this season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 401-421 (.488), 371-375 with Columbus (.497).

Through his first 5GS, Avila has topped out at 79 pitches (4/19 vs. Iowa, only game with more than 4.0IP) and is the only Clipper with at least 5GS that has not yet reached 80 pitches. He is averaging 18.6 pitches per inning, more than all Clipper starters except Ryan Webb (20.1; 5th most among 14 Clippers with at least 9.0IP).

Avila pitched six times for Cleveland in spring training, turning in a 3.24ERA (8.1IP, 10H, 4R, 3ER, 1BB, 4K). He was released on 3/17, then signed a new minor league deal on 3/22 and assigned to minor league camp.
