### RIDERS FALL IN FINALE TO HOOKS, SPLIT SERIES:

The Frisco RoughRiders dropped the series finale to the Corpus Christi Hooks 7-5 on Sunday afternoon from Whataburger Field. Frisco (14-13) continued their first-inning run scoring theme this season with a three-run **Keith Jones II** home run to put the Riders ahead 3-0. It was Jones' fourth homer of the year. The Hooks (13-14) answered with two unearned runs in the bottom of the first against **David Davalillo** (1-3), who surrendered six runs, four earned, over 4.0 innings while striking out eight and walking two in his start. After **Marcus Lee Sang** increased the Frisco lead to 5-2 with a two-run homer in the 4th, the Hooks struck back with four runs in the bottom of the fourth, taking the lead on a three-run Yamal Encarnacion double. Tommy Sacco Jr. added his second home run of the day in the fifth for Corpus Christi, padding the lead at 7-5. Alex Santos II (1-1) earned the win for Corpus in relief, throwing 1.1 innings, and Railin Perez threw a scoreless ninth to capture the save.

### THAT TAIL IS WAGNERING:

**Max Wagner** has introduced himself well to his new teammates in his first series, homering 4 times in his first 3 games with the Riders. In the 4 games, he is hitting .267 (4-for-15)/.313/1.067/1.380 with 4 homers, 5 RBIs and a walk. Wagner was signed as Minor League free agent by the Rangers on April 22nd. In 2025 with Double-A Chesapeake, Wagner hit just five homers in 87 games, batting .218/.301/.339/.640. A former second rounder by the O's out of Clemson in 2022, the Green Bay, Wisconsin native played four seasons in the Baltimore organization before his release in Spring Training of 2026.

### AN AMAZING MONTH IN THE BOOKS:

With the first month of the season done, the Riders can look back at an extremely successful April on offense. Frisco's 33 home runs in the month were the most since May of 2022 (44 home runs in 26 games, the most in recorded franchise history since 2005), while they slashed .276/.362/.458/.820 and averaged 6.5 runs per game (recorded franchise record, min. 24 games in a month) with an RoughRiders April record 156 runs. Their .820 OPS was the third-best full month in recorded franchise history, trailing just June of 2007 (.892) and April of 2008 (.846). **Keyber Rodriguez's** 29 hits came within 1 of the April RoughRiders record of 30 (done 6 times, most recently by **Luisangel Acuña** in 2023). **Frainyer Chavez** scored 24 runs in the month, setting a new recorded franchise record in April (breaking the previous record of 21 by **Alejandro Osuna** in 2025). **Orlando Martinez's** 10 doubles are a Riders April recorded franchise record and tied for the fifth-most in a month ever.

### GIMME THAT OFFENSE EARLY AND OFTEN:

The RoughRiders have been swinging the bat well in their last 9 games, going 6-3. During the stretch, it's been the Frisco offense that's helped them to victory, scoring 67 runs to lead the league (7.4 R/G), slashing .268/.375/.463/.838 with 14 home runs. Frisco's 34 runs in the first inning this year are the second in the minors and the best among non-Triple-A teams, hitting a MiLB best .345 (38-for-110) in the first with 7 home runs. They have scored in the first inning in 13 games and have scored multiple runs in the first inning in 10 games this season.

### WATCH OUT FOR THE LONG BALL:

Frisco's 39 homers are the most in recorded franchise history (since 2005) through 27 games and 4th in Double-A this year. The Riders and Tulsa Drillers are the only two Double-A teams with 8 players who have three or more home runs. The Riders have hit a home run in 6 games in a row, totalling 13 in their last 6 games.

### LEE SANG IT AND BANG IT:

**Marcus Lee Sang** has helped to carry the Frisco offense in the last three weeks. In his last 16 games, he has slashed .375 (21-for-56)/.470/.714/1.184 with 4 doubles, 5 home runs and 15 RBIs. In a two-home run game in Amarillo on April 16th, he hit a laser that was 113 mph off the bat and a moonshot over the batters' eye, which went an estimated 466 feet. The former Phillies farmhand is now hitting .314/.392/.535/.927 in 24 games to start the season while ranking 5th in the league in batting average (.314) and 4th in runs scored (22).

### YOU WANT THE HITS, WE GOT UM:

Through 27 games the RoughRiders are 1st in the Texas League with 251 hits. They are first in the league in batting average (.273) and 1st in runs (174, 6.4 runs per game). The RoughRiders have not led the Texas League in batting average since 2014. Frisco has scored 8 or more runs in 37 percent of their games (10-of-27). The Riders are 2nd in the Texas League in homers (39) while they are 1st in SLG (.458) and 1st in OPS (.821). For perspective, the Yankees led MLB last year with a .787 team OPS.

### VS NORTHWEST ARKANSAS NATURALS:

Frisco went 9-3 against the Royals affiliate in 2025 and, since 2021, the Riders are 31-28 against the Naturals. **Juremi Profar** has the most hits (36) against the Naturals, while **Milke Olt** killed NWA pitching, hitting 6 homers and slashing .522 (12-for-23)/.593/1.348/1.941 in 6 career games. Most recently, **Josh Hatcher** hit .413 (33-for-62)/.453/.638/1.091 with 4 home runs and 17 RBIs in 18 games.

### ABOUT JOSH

-Mills Godwin High School in Virginia, where he helped guide the Eagles to a VHSL state finals berth during his 2019 junior season. Same high school as former RoughRiders pitcher and current Major Leaguer **Reed Garrett**.

-College of Southern Idaho. Was named Region 18 Pitcher of the year and NJCAA All-American after leading the country with 16.0 K/9. His junior season, he went 8-3 with a 2.04 ERA and set single-season record with 118 K at CSI over his 66.1 IP.

-Before being drafted by the Rangers, he was committed to transfer to Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU) for baseball.

-Enjoys fishing, playing basketball and eating sushi in his free time.

### 2026 SEASON

-No. 23 prospect in the Rangers organization.

-Made one relief appearance on Friday, 4/3 before starting the home opener on 4/7.

### 2025 SEASON

-Dominated for High-A Hub City, owning a 1.15 ERA over 15 outings.

-Among those who threw at least 50 innings in the South Atlantic League, he led the league in ERA (1.15) and batting average against (.147), while he was third in strikeout rate (33.6%), second in WHIP (0.84), and second in LOB rate (82.3%).

-As a starting pitcher with Hub City, he went 0-2 with a 0.74 ERA over nine starts while holding opponents to a .128 batting average. As a reliever, he owned a 2.00 ERA in six appearances.

-In his last nine games (six starts) with Hub City, he owned a 0.83 ERA, striking out 48 to 12 walks in 32.2 innings while allowing just a .118 batting average.

### 2024 SEASON

-Spent all season with Low-A Down East Wood Ducks as a swingman. As a starter, owned 7.01 ERA while he garnered a 3.00 ERA as a reliever.

## CHAD COMER

Years with Rangers: 10

Years with RoughRiders: 2 (1st as manager)

Comer returns to Double-A Frisco in 2026 after managing at the High-A level over the last three seasons. The native of Mansfield, Texas will enter his 10th season with the Rangers and his second in Frisco.

In 2022, Comer helped pilot the Riders to their second Texas League Championship in franchise history, serving as a development coach. Over the last three seasons, Comer managed High-A Hickory (2023-2024) and High-A Hub City (2025), going 197-191 (.508).

Prior to Frisco, Comer was the hitting coach for the High-A Hickory Crawdads in 2021, after serving as a coach at various levels of the Rangers system from 2016-2019.

The former University of Texas at Arlington catcher played two seasons in the Atlanta Braves organization, reaching High-A Lynchburg in 2012. He was drafted by Atlanta in the 29th round of the 2011 draft after four seasons at UTA.

## THOMAS ST. CLAIR

Years with Rangers: 5

St. Clair joins the Riders as the pitching coach after leading a Hub City staff that finished third in the SAL with a 3.50 ERA in 2025. St. Clair also will serve as the assistant pitching coordinator in the Rangers farm system in 2026.

Initially, St. Clair came to the Rangers as a coach in the Dominican Summer League in 2022 before serving as a pitching coach for the ACL Rangers from 2022-23. Before professional baseball, he spent two and a half years as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College.

The right-hander pitched three professional seasons in the St. Louis Cardinals system from 2017-19 after he was picked in the 24th round of the 2017 June draft, making 88 outings for the organization's Rookie and Single-A affiliates.

The Winston-Salem, North Carolina native played four years (2014-17) at Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, N.C.

## JASON HART

Years with Rangers: 13

Years with RoughRiders: 9

Hart returns as the hitting coach in Frisco for the first time since he served as the RoughRiders hitting coach from 2012-2019. Before that, most recently, he was the Major League hitting assistant for the Miami Marlins under current Rangers manager Skip Schumaker.

In 2015, Hart was named the Mike Coolbaugh Texas League Coach of the Year for his work with the Riders hitters. Prior to joining Frisco, Hart spent two seasons as the hitting coach with Low-A Hickory. His tenure with the Rangers began after he assisted the Single-A Clinton staff with coaching responsibilities for a portion of the 2008 season and continued when he accepted the role of hitting coach for the Arizona Rangers before the 2009 campaign.

Hart played professionally for parts of eight seasons from 1998-2006, with stints in the Oakland, Texas and Minnesota organizations. He made his Major League debut with the Rangers in 2002, when he batted .267 (4-for-15) with three doubles over a span of 10 games. He missed the 2004 campaign following the removal of a benign brain tumor, but returned to the field in 2005 and hit 21 home runs in 128 games with Frisco.

Originally drafted by Oakland in the fifth round of the 1998 draft, Hart was acquired by Texas in a January 2002 trade with the Athletics. He attended Southwest Missouri State University, where he paced the conference in homers in 1997 and was named a Missouri Valley Conference All-Star in 1998.

Hernandez joins the RoughRiders for his first season with the Rangers organization.

During 2020, Hernandez managed the Texas Collegiate League Frisco RoughRiders after the MiLB season had been canceled. In 2025, he served as a bench coach for Triple-A Jacksonville and spent 19 seasons with the Marlins as a coach and coordinator. As part of that stint, he served eight seasons as a manager, most recently in 2022 with High-A Beloit.

Hernandez started his coaching career at the University of Mobile in 1993 as a hitting coach and stayed there through 2001. From 2005-2006, Hernandez served as the hitting coach for the Independent Pensacola Pelicans.
