YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels had their four-game win streak snapped with a 6-2 loss to the Harrisburg Senators. Richmond opened a 1-0 lead in the second inning with a bases-loaded walk by **Kyle Mottice**, but that was the only run allowed in the inning by Harrisburg's Luis Reyes, who stranded the bases loaded. In the third, Ramon Flores tied the score with a sac fly. In the fourth, Reyes put the Senators ahead with a two-run double and a run later scored on an error to open a 4-1 lead. **Heliot Ramos** hit a solo homer in the bottom of the fifth to bring the Flying Squirrels within two runs. Jakson Reetz hit a two-run homer in the top of the ninth to extend Harrisburg's lead to 6-2. Richmond starter **Sean Hjelle** allowed four runs (two earned) over 5.0 innings on four hits with one walk and six strikeouts.

TODAY'S GAMES: The Flying Squirrels play the fifth of a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, at The Diamond. This series marks the only trip to Richmond this season for the Senators. The Flying Squirrels played the Senators on their first road trip of the season from May 11-16 at FNB Field. Richmond won the first three games of the series, capped by a no-hitter on May 13. Harrisburg recovered to win the final three games of the series, earning a six-game split.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won five of their last seven games. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 4.0 games behind first-place Bowie. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked eighth in the league with a .236 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked second in the league with a 3.32 ERA for the season.

THE SENATORS have lost ten of their last 14 games and are currently in sixth place in the Double-A Northeast, 12.5 games behind first-place Bowie and 8.5 games behind Richmond. The Harrisburg offense is ranked 12th in the league with a .186 batting average. The Senators pitching staff is ranked third in the league this season with a 3.51 ERA. Harrisburg's roster includes four of MLB.com's top Nationals prospects, including LHP Tim Cate (8), 1B Drew Mendoza (11), SS Jackson Cluff (17 - on IL) and Jakson Reetz (26).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Phil Pfeifer** makes his second start. In his Flying Squirrels debut last Saturday and was charged with a loss after allowing five runs on eight hits over 3.1 innings with one walk and six strikeouts. He began the year with Triple-A Sacramento, going 0-3 with an 11.25 ERA in five relief appearances. He signed with the Giants as a minor league free agent in March. Pfeifer was originally drafted by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the third round in 2015 out of Vanderbilt before being traded to the Atlanta Braves in 2016.

FOR HARRISBURG: Left-hander Tim Cate makes his eighth start of the season and his second against Richmond. He last pitched on Sunday against Portland, allowing one run over 5.0 innings in a loss. He faced the Flying Squirrels on May 15 at FNB Field and picked up a win after allowing one run in 5.0 innings. After going 1-2 with a 5.92 ERA in his first five starts of the season, Cate is 0-1 with a 0.77 ERA in his last two starts, both against Portland. Cate was selected in the second round (65th overall) of the 2018 MLB Draft out of the University of Connecticut. As a freshman at UConn, Cate was teammates with Richmond relief pitcher **Patrick Ruotolo**. In 2019, Cate was an MiLB.com Nationals Organizational All-Star after going 11-9 with a 3.07 ERA in 26 starts split between Low-A Hagerstown and High-A Potomac.

FABULOUS FABIAN: Over his last nine games since June 1, **Sando Fabian** is batting .478 (11-for-23) with one homer, four doubles and seven RBIs while scoring four runs. Last Friday, he hit his third home run of the season. He followed on Saturday by going 3-for-4 with a run scored, a Double-A career high in hits. He entered as a pinch-hitter on Tuesday against Harrisburg and drove a two-run double. In the first game of Thursday's double-header, Fabian went 2-for-4 with a pair of doubles. Fabian hit .184 through his first 18 games of the season, but his performance since June 1 has raised his season average to .278.

STRINGING THEM TOGETHER: **Vince Fernandez** homered in back-to-back games for the second time this year earlier this week. Fernandez homered on Sunday against Altoona, a two-run shot, and followed with a solo home run against the Senators in the series opener on Tuesday. He also went deep in back-to-back games in Harrisburg on May 15 and May 16.

LOBBYING IN THE UPPER HOUSE: **Vince Fernandez** has clubbed four home runs in 22 at-bats against the Senators during the 2021 season. He is batting .318 (7-for-22) against Harrisburg on the year. In 2019 as a member of the Hartford Yard Goats (Colorado Rockies), Fernandez hit .235 (8-for-34) with two homers.

TORRES ON A TEAR: In his last five games since June 1, **Bryan Torres** is batting .500 (7-for-14) with one double and one RBI. He has seen time defensively this season at catcher and second base. Torres is in his first Double-A season. Prior to 2021, he had not played higher than the rookie level.

MO' TIME: Over his last four games since June 5, **Kyle Mottice** is batting .357 (5-for-14) with a double and three RBIs. On the season, he is batting .355 (11-for-31) against left-handed pitchers compared to .216 (11-for-51) against right-handers. He has hit the ball to the opposite field on 46.5 percent of his balls put in play, which is the second-highest rate in the Double-A Northeast, trailing only Erie's John Valente (48.8 percent).

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY: The Flying Squirrels' relievers have the second-best bullpen ERA in the Double-A Northeast at 3.02 on the season, trailing only Harrisburg (2.28). The bullpen is tied for the league lead with 12 saves. **Patrick Ruotolo** and **Norwith Gudino** are tied for third in the Double-A Northeast this season with four saves each.

RUBIO RIDING HOT: Reliever **Frank Rubio** worked a scoreless inning on Thursday against the Senators before rain ended the contest early. It marked the 11th consecutive appearance for him this season without allowing an earned run. Rubio is in his third overall season with the Flying Squirrels. He appeared in one game for Richmond in 2018 and made 11 appearances during the 2019 season.

AMAYA REBOUNDS: After surrendering five runs (four earned) in his first two Double-A appearances on May 4 and May 8 (G2), reliever **Luis Amaya** has worked eight straight appearances without allowing an earned run. That stretch spans 9.2 innings of work. The span has lowered his season ERA from 15.43 through the first two outings to 3.00. He has not allowed a run in his last six outings, covering 8.0 straight scoreless innings.

STRONG START: The Flying Squirrels' 20-14 record is the second-best start in team history through 34 games, trailing only the team's 21-13 mark in the franchise's inaugural season in 2010. That year, the Flying Squirrels went 22-13 through 35 games.

GETTING ON THE BOARD: Dating back to August 25, 2019, the Flying Squirrels have scored at least one run in 43 consecutive games. That streak includes all 34 games of the 2021 season. Portland had a streak of scoring in 40 straight games before being shut out in Harrisburg last Saturday. Richmond is the only team in the Double-A Northeast that have not been shut out this year.

LAW OF AVERAGES: The 12 teams in the Double-A Northeast have combined to hit .240 this season. In 2019, the Eastern League combined for a .238 batting average, which was the lowest for the circuit since a .234 mark in 1971 and the sixth-lowest since the league was first classified as "Double-A" in 1963. Harrisburg's .186 average this season would be the lowest in the EL/AA-NE since the 1963 restructuring, surpassing a .208 team average by the 1968 Waterbury Indians.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Heliot Ramos** (3), **Tristan Beck** (12), **Sean Hjelle** (13) and **Jose Marte** (30). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. Four players, Ramos (3), Hjelle (11), Beck (20) and **Caleb Kilian** (30) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
