20-20-20 VISION: **OF Brewer Hicklen** is closing in on a milestone that has not been accomplished with Triple-A Omaha during the modern franchise era (since 2005). He needs just one more double to have 20 doubles, 20 home runs, and 20 steals in a single season for Omaha. **INF Bobby Witt Jr.** accomplished the feat last year between Double-A Northwest Arkansas and Triple-A Omaha. Hicklen's 23 home runs are tied for fourth in the International League while his 71 RBIs come in at seventh. He has stolen the eighth most bases at 25 and his 44 extra-base hits are tied for fourth in the league.

AUGUST HEAT: **C Freddy Fermin** has already had an impressive August, looking to finish his hot month well. Fermin has five home runs so far this month, tied for second most on the team behind **OF Brewer Hicklen** with six. Fermin's .329 batting average this month is the best among Storm Chasers that have played at least 10 games. He has failed to get a hit in just three of his 19 games, snapping his hit streak last night at nine games. By virtue of a walk, however, he is still riding an 18-game on-base streak, the third longest active streak in the International League. He has a nearly one-to-one strikeout to walk ratio, earning 10 walks and striking out 11 times this month.

TOP IN THE LEAGUE: With a pinch-run stolen base yesterday, **OF Dairon Blanco** now leads the International League in stolen bases with 33. He holds a .917 stolen base success rate, the highest among the league's top five in stolen base totals. Blanco has stolen nine bases in August, the most in the league, and needs just one more to set a new season high. The Storm Chasers are tied with Buffalo for most steals in the International League with 148 while Omaha's .860 stolen base success rate is the best in the league, besting Memphis at .834.

CHASING HISTORY: **OF Brewer Hicklen** has reached base safely in 27 consecutive games, the longest active streak in the International League. Hicklen is already in possession of the longest on-base streak on the team this season and is now chasing the longest by an Omaha Storm Chaser. His streak is the tied with **OF Paulo Orlando** for the fifth longest in the Storm Chaser era (since 2011). **OF Jarrod Dyson** holds the fourth longest on-base streak, reaching in 28 consecutive games in 2011 for the Storm Chasers. The longest on-base streak by a Storm Chaser belongs to **OF Travis Snider** who played for Omaha in 2016, earning a 30-game on-base streak during his 85 games with the Storm Chasers that season.

PROCEED WITH CAUTION: The Chasers allow the lowest stolen base percentage in the International League, catching would-be base stealers 29.9 percent of the time. Omaha's 61 stolen bases allowed are 19 fewer than second place Toledo. **C Freddy Fermin** leads the team with 12 caught stealing

FOR OMAHA: **LHP Drew Parrish** heads to the mound to make his 12th start and 13th overall appearance for the Storm Chasers. In his last start, Parrish recorded his second consecutive quality start, going 6.0 innings and allowing two earned runs on four hits with six strikeouts. Parrish, since the MLB All-Star break, holds a 2.95 ERA and a 2-2 record. The span includes just one start of less than five innings in which he allowed three earned runs on July 31 in just 2.0 innings of work. Parrish started the season with Double-A Northwest Arkansas, going 4-3 with a 2.13 ERA before getting transferred to Triple-A Omaha on June 2.

FOR SCRANTON/WILKES-BARRE: **LHP Matt Krook** gets the ball to make his 21st start and 23rd overall appearance for the RailRiders. In his last start, Krook went 4.2 innings, allowing no hits but conceding two runs with a career-high-tying seven walks in the no decision at St. Paul. Krook has thrown the fourth most innings (115.1) in the International League and is tied for the fifth most wins. He holds the lowest ERA among pitchers that have thrown at least 112 innings in the league. Krook has a 4-1 record and a 4.17 ERA on the road this season, compared to a 4-6 record and 4.11 ERA at home. Krook was drafted in 2016 by the San Francisco Giants before getting traded to the Tampa Bay Rays in the trade that sent Evan Longoria to the Giants. The Yankees selected Krook in the 2020 Rule 5 draft, splitting time in 2021 between Double-A Somerset and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

PARRISH NOTES

- Took no-hit bid into the sixth inning on 8/6 vs STP before allowing a pair of solo homers.
- Threw back-to-back games allowing a career-high tying 7 hits against St. Paul, earning quality start win in one and loss in the other.
- Transferred to Triple-A Omaha on June 3, made his Triple-A debut a few days later against Lehigh Valley.
- Named Double-A Texas League Player of the Month of May, winning two straight weekly awards during the month.
- Has pitched 5.0 or more innings in each of his last eight starts with Double-A NW Arkansas. Four of his last six were quality starts.
- Finished the 2021 season with Double-A NW Arkansas. Had 5-4 record across 18 appearances with 17 total starts.
- Split the 2021 season between High-A Quad Cities and Double-A NW Arkansas. Started the season with High-A Quad Cities, tossing 15.2 innings of scoreless ball, allowing just three walks with 23 strikeouts.
- Played for Team USA in the 2021 WBSC Olympic Baseball Qualifiers, appearing in one game for the U. S. Threw 2.0 scoreless innings out of the bullpen to earn the win against Canada and helped Team USA qualify for the Tokyo Olympics.
- Went 3-0 in nine games (four starts) for the Burlington Royals with a 2.52 ERA in 2019. He struck out 39 strikeouts with just four walks in his first season as a professional. Did not allow a run in five of his nine appearances with Burlington.
- Drafted in the eighth round of the 2019 MLB Draft by the Kansas City Royals
- Made two trips to the College World Series with Florida State (2017 & 2019). Went 8-5 with 112 strikeouts across 17 appearances with 16 starts in final season with FSU. Started and ended his season with memorable games. He pitched 5.0 innings in a combined no-hitter against Maine, getting the start in the 10th no-hitter in school history. Went 8.0 scoreless innings in his final game of his FSU career, helping the Seminoles beat No. 5 Arkansas in CWS opener.

2022 NOTES

- Allowed a home run for the first time in more than a month at the Triple-A level on 7/29 @ SYR, just the fourth homer he allowed through the first four months of the season.
- Optioned to Triple-A Omaha on 6/4, now coming out of the bullpen for the Storm Chasers.
- Recalled by Kansas City on 4/21, made appearance in eight games for Royals, recording 0-0 record with a 4.42 ERA
- Made season debut as Opening Day starter for Omaha on 4/5 @ IND, throwing 4.0 scoreless innings with six strikeouts and one walk

CAREER NOTES

- Began 2021 season with Triple-A Omaha before earning a promotion to Kansas City, entering the season as the No. 18 prospect in the Royals organization per Baseball America
- Made three relief appearances for Kansas City from 6/4-6/12/21, allowing one run on four hits in 6.1 innings with 10 strikeouts and two walks, posting a 1.42 ERA
- Began the 2020 season with San Diego before being traded to Kansas City on 7/16/20
- Made Royals' debut on 7/26/20 @ Cleveland, allowing two runs on three hits in 2.0 innings as the game's opener
