LUG-NOTES

Class of 2026: Going into the Michigan Baseball Hall of Fame tonight: **Bob Sullivan**, the patriarch of baseball in West Michigan, who founded Little League baseball in Grand Rapids and coached the Grand Rapids Sullivan's for half a century, winning national and international championships; **Connie Wisniewski**, one of the greatest players in All-American Girls Professional Baseball League history, who set the career winning percentage and single-season innings record, then moved to the outfield and led the league in home runs and total bases; **Terry Collins**, who led Eastern Michigan to the NAIA national championship, then managed over a decade in the Major Leagues and won the 2015 National League pennant; and **Bob Welch**, who excelled on the mound for EMU and Team USA, then won 211 games in the Majors as well as the 1990 A.L. Cy Young Award.

Home Cooking: The Lugnuts have won six straight games at home to improve to 27-22 in Lansing this year, compared to 18-35 on the road. That's a better home record than every team in the Midwest League except South Bend (31-17), Dayton (30-21) and Great Lakes (29-22). West Michigan, by way of comparison, is just 23-30 at home.

Streaking: Outfielder **Jake Reinisch** has homered in each of the last two games and reached base in 20 consecutive games (and in 21 of 22 games played for the Nuts), batting .292/.452/.508 over that stretch.

Willing and Abel: Reliever **Abel Mercedes** has turned around his season..

Welcome Aboard: 18-year-old Breyson Guedeuz (pronounced "GEH-des") joined the Lugnuts at the start of this week from Class-A Stockton. The teenager is ranked the Athletics' No. 2 outfield prospect and No. 8 overall prospect by MLB Pipeline, signing as a top international free agent for about \$1.5 million from San Felipe, Venezuela, in January 2025. He posted a sizzling .359 batting average in his pro debut in the Dominican Summer League, then opened eyes in 2026 Spring Training, collecting singles in his first three Cactus League at-bats before slugging a 450-foot home run off San Diego Padres reliever Michael King on March 13. Thus encouraged, the A's skipped Guedeuz up to Single-A Stockton to open the year and the Guedeuz responded by hitting for a .379 average in June and .375 in July, collecting 73 hits in his last 46 games. He is the top-ranked player on the Lugnuts' roster.

Cooperstownian Nut: A member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** was inducted on July 26 into Cooperstown alongside Jeff Kent and Andruw Jones. In his 11th game with the Lugnuts (batting .143, 6-for-42, with one walk and 11 strikeouts), Beltrán suffered a right knee in an outfield collision. He flew back to the Royals' complex in Florida and never returned to Lansing, making his MLB debut on September 14, 1998, against the Oakland Athletics. A year later, Carlos was voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, and was on his way to a 20-year MLB career with 2,725 hits, 565 doubles, 78 triples, 435 homers, 312 homers, nine All-Star appearances, three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and a 2017 World Series ring as a member of the Astros.

2026 Campaign: 2026 Lugnuts Opening Day starter... will tie for the Midwest League lead with his 20th start today... ranks 5th in the MWL in innings (87 2/3, 8 2/3 behind league-leading teammate Samuel Dutton) and ranks 4th in batting average (.261)... limited opposition to .195 avg. with 3.86 ERA in April, but allowed .260 avg. with 7.23 ERA in May. .263 avg. with 6.93 ERA in June, .343 avg., 4.96 ERA in July, .263 avg. and 1.93 ERA (in 4 2/3 IP) in August... limiting lefties to .247 avg., righties are batting .275 (and .440 SLG)... allowing .349 avg. / 1.010 OPS in 1st inning.

Gatorade, Not Gator: Echavarria posted a 0.28 ERA with 80 strikeouts in 50 innings as a senior at Millburn High School, allowing only one extra-base hit the whole season. He was named New Jersey's 2022-2023 Gatorade High School Baseball Player of the Year and the top prep prospect in the state. Initially committed to Oregon, he changed his commitment to the University of Florida as his senior year dawned, but then signed with the A's for \$3 million to head into professional baseball – the only New Jersey high schooler taken in the 2023 MLB Draft.

Pro Ball: After signing, Echavarria debuted in instructional league ball in 2023. He was slated to pitch in the 2024 Spring Breakout for the A's against the Giants, but the game was canceled due to rain. On May 2, 2024, Game 22 of the Stockton Ports' season, he made his official professional debut, starting against Visalia and working three scoreless innings before allowing two unearned run in the fourth... posted 9.00 ERA in six May starts (20 R/18 ER in 18 IP)... limited opposition to one run or fewer in nine of his final 13 starts of the year, including stretch from June 25-August 4 with just 2 ER allowed in 25 2/3 IP... best inning was the fourth inning: 3-for-26, .115 avg. against... base-stealers were successful in 11 of 13 attempts.
