### Looking Back

Reading won 3-2 last night thanks to a stellar bullpen effort. Casey Martin homered and Griff McGarry allowed one run over 4.1 innings. The bullpen allowed one hit, no runs and had eight strikeouts over 4.2 innings. Reading allowed two hits, which matched a season low.

### Bullpen Success

Reading's bullpen has been stellar this week. Through three games, they've allowed four-earned runs over 15.2 innings, which is good for a 2.30 ERA. The R-Phils added Phillies No. 21 Prospect Orion Kerkering to the bullpen and he struck out two in an inning last night. Zach Haake also joined the bullpen yesterday and had four strikeouts in two hitless and shutout innings.

### Collecting Accolades

R-Phils reliever Carlos Francisco was named Phillies Minor League Pitcher of the Month of June. With Jersey Shore in June, he had a 0.93 ERA and was four-for-four in save oppurtunities. Overall, Francisco struck out 15-of-40 batters he faced and walked just one, with a .205 opponents batting average. He led the South Atlantic League with four saves and was fifth with a 0.62 WHIP. Francisco was promoted to Reading on June 29.

### Road Warriors

Reading has been vastly better on the road this season, then compared to at home. The R-Phils road winning percentage is .472 and it's just .341 at home. Reading is scoring over half a run more per game on the road and also has 20 more stolen bases in road contests. On the mound, Reading's team ERA is 5.55 at home and 4.58 on the road. Additionally, the R-Phils have allowed 70 home runs when at home, compared to just 40 on the road.

### Hey Now You're an All Star

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Mick Abel will participate in tomorrow's All Star Futures Game at T-Mobile Park in Seattle.

### Around the Organization

The Phillies won 3-1 over the Rays to become the first team to sweep Tampa this season. Lehigh Valley fell 18-2 at Scranton as Weston Wilson homered. Jersey Shore fell 5-4 to Hudson Valley as Marcus Lee Sang doubled. Clearwater beat Palm Beach 4-1 as Ricardo Rosario had two hits and Cade Fergus doubled.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

**July 7, 2006:** At Akron, Brian Sellier's first Double-A home run leads off the 9th inning and provides the winning margin as the Phillies top the Aeros, 3-2. Jeff Key notches his 8th save by getting all three batters to ground out in the bottom of the inning.

### 'Sup Somerset

This is the second series of the season between Somerset and Reading, with the first being a split in North Jersey. Somerset won the first half title and is 5-4 in the second half. Last week, the Patriots took four-of-six at Bowie, and after this week, they'll head to the break and then play nine-straight on the road, with three at Binghamton and then six at Hartford.

### Patriot Pitcher

Blane Abeyta is making his 15th appearance and 13th start of the season. He is 5-3 with a 6.00 ERA; and over 69 innings pitched, Abeyta's allowed 68 hits, 34 walks and has 75 strikeouts. On July 2 at Bowie, he went six innings, allowing just two hits and two runs, with nine strikeouts. Against Reading on May 21, he went 5.2 innings and had seven strikeouts with just two hits and two runs allowed. Abeyta spent all of 2022 with Somerset and split 2021 between Tampa and the Yankees Rookie-Legue team. He signed with the Yankees as an undrafted free agent in 2020 out of Nevada and was born in Martinez, California.

Transferred to triple-A Lehigh Valley to make appearance out of bullpen on June 3, where he allowed five runs in four innings of work. Transferred back to Reading and has made four-straight starts of five innings or more, including three-straight of six innings. Allowed season-high nine hits on July 1 against Richmond. Had season-high nine strikeouts on June 23 at Portland.
