**LAST TIME OUT:** Fristoe turned in a strong bounce back start last Wednesday morning against the Bowling Green Hot Rods. The right-hander allowed one run on just one hit while walking two and striking out five across 3.2 innings while throwing a season-high 50 pitches. The lone run he allowed came in the top of the third when he walked Ryan Spikes and Chandler Simpson brought him in with an RBI single.

- Began the season on the Renegades Break Camp Roster.

### 2023 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season in extended spring training and was assigned to the FCL Yankees...transferred to Single-A Tampa Tarpons on Aug. 29 following the conclusion of the FCL season...transferred to High-A Hudson Valley on Sept. 12 before the start of the SAL playoffs.
- Picked up his first win in relief on July 25 @ FCL Blue Jays, walking five across 2.0 hitless innings.
- In his Single-A debut on Aug. 31: 3.2 IP, 3 H, 1 R, 1 BB, 6 K, throwing a season-high 62 pitches.
- From 7/25-End of Season: 1-2, 2.91, 7 G, 6 GS, 21.2 IP, 12 H, 7 R/7 ER, 12 BB, 28 K between FCL and Tampa.
- Made his Renegades debut in Game 1 of the SAL Championship Series on 9/17 vs Greenville: ND, 4.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 5 K.

- Full name is Jackson Carlisle Fristoe.
- Grew up as neighbors with Renegades RHP Mason Vinyard in Paducah, Kentucky, though they moved apart as kids. Vinyard is currently on the 7-day Injured List.
- In two seasons with Mississippi State University, went 6-7 with one save, a 6.57 ERA (86.1IP, 63ER) and 116K in 40 games (16 starts)... was mostly a starter as a freshman in 2021 (16 games, 13 starts) and was used as a reliever as a sophomore (24 games, 3 starts).
- Took part in the inaugural Prospect Development Pipeline League hosted by USA Baseball and Major League Baseball, was a 2x Perfect Game All-American in HS at Paducah-Tilghman HS.
