INDY BITS

ABOUT SUNDAY: An eight-run second inning and five-run sixth from the Toledo Mud Hens was too much for the Indians to overcome on Sunday afternoon at Fifth Third Field, as Indianapolis dropped the series finale, 16-6. The Mud Hens ambushed Indians left-hander Michael Plassmeyer for five consecutive hits to open the bottom of the second inning, plating four runs before an out was recorded. Toledo pushed across eight runs in the frame, highlighted by a two-run triple from Akil Baddoo, RBI doubles from Jace Jung and former Indian Ryan Vidade, and a two-run home run from Keston Hiura. Toledo added a three-spot in the bottom of the third and tacked on five more runs in the sixth, thanks in large part to a pair of home runs from Jung and Baddoo. The Indians started a comeback bid with a three-run third thanks to an RBI double from Liover Peguero and runs driven in from Malcom Nuñez and Canaan-Smith Njigba. Gilberto Celestino later added an RBI double, and solo homers from Nuñez and pinch hitter Eii Wilson accounted for the rest of the Indians' run production.

WELL WELL, WILSON: In his second at-bat of the season on Sunday afternoon, catcher Eli Wilson launched a pinch-hit home run in the top of the ninth inning for his first Triple-A long ball. Wilson split the 2023 season between High-A Greensboro and Double-A Altoona, launching seven home runs in 55 games between levels. In just three career Triple-A games since making his debut at the level with Indianapolis in 2021, Wilson is 2-for-5 with a run, double, home run and two PBI.

NUÑEZ HITS NUKES: Malcom Nuñez launched his third home run of the season and first since going yard in back-to-back games from 3/31-4/2. On Sunday, he launched a solo shot in the seventh inning to continue to chip away at a double-digit St. Paul lead. In total, he went 1-for-3 with two RBI, his solo shot supplemented by a third-inning sacrifice fly to plate the Indians second of six runs in the game. It was Nuñez's second extra-base hits in two games and his sixth of the season in 13 total hits. The 23-year-old is known for his power, launching 23 home runs in 2022 between Double-A Springfield, Altoona and Indianapolis to finish the season ranked sixth among all Double-A leaders with 87 RBI.

FIELDING WELL: Liover Peguero is currently tied for the second-longest errorless streak in the International League this season, logging 13 perfect games dating back to Opening Day on 3/29. He has split time in the field between second base (38.0 innings) and shortstop (70.1), committing no errors in 35 total chances between positions. He has turned two double plays from the left side of the infield.

GONZO STREAKING: Nick Gonzales singled in the first contest and doubled in his last at-bat of the second affair on Saturday to extend his on-base streak to 14 games, longest in the International League this season. He ranks among IL leaders in doubles (1st, 8), hits (3rd, 21), runs (3rd, 15) and batting average (10th, .362) after tying for the league lead in '23 with eight triples. Seven of his 14 games have featured multi-hit performances. Gonzales' longest on-base streak with Indy in '23 was a 13-gamer from 4/6-19.

BAE'S BACK: After hitting .500 (5-for-10) through three games of his rehab assignment, utilityman Ji Hwan Bae was reinstated and optioned to Indy today. He was placed on the 10-day injured list with a strain of his left hip muscle on March 28 (retroactive to March 25) and has played in four total games since split between Single-A Bradenton and Indianapolis. Since making his big-league debut in September 2022, Bae made two return trips to Indy on rehab assignments and fared well, hitting .381 (16-for-42) with 11 runs, five extra-base hits and a 1.104 OPS in 12 games.

TONIGHT: The Indianapolis Indians and St. Paul Saints kick off their first of three six-game series this season, two of which come at Victory Field (also: 8/13-18). Last season, the Saints narrowly edged the Indians, 10 wins to eight, with four wins coming in six games in Indianapolis. Kicking off the series for Indianapolis tonight is LHP Eric Lauer (1-0, 2.61), who has never faced St. Paul in 20 Triple-A games (15 starts) dating back to 2018. Countering for the Saints is RHP Randy Dobnak (1-1, 3.65), who is no stranger to the Indians. Since 2019 with Rochester, Dobnak has faced Indianapolis seven times (four starts) with a 1-2 record, 7.94 ERA (20er/22.2ip) and 20 strikeouts.

LAUER DOESN'T LIE: Indians southpaw Eric Lauer is slated to take the bump for Indianapolis in the homestand opener vs. St. Paul tonight. He made his first start of the 2023 season last Wednesday at Toledo and tossed 3.2 hitless innings with four walks and five strikeouts. He has now logged 7.2 shutout frames across his last two outings, beginning with an appearance of 4.0 one-hit innings out of the bullpen to earn his first win of the season on 4/5 vs. Memphis.

YAZMANIAN DEVIL: The Pittsburgh Pirates today announced that catcher Yasmani Grandal will begin a rehab assignment with the Indianapolis Indians tonight. The 35-year-old was placed on the 10-day injured list with left foot plantar fasciitis on March 28 (retroactive to March 25). He went 0-for-3 in just two spring training games after signing with Pittsburgh as a free agent on Feb. 14. Grandal spent the entire 2023 season with Chicago (AL) and hit .234 (85-for-363) with 22 extra-base hits and 33 RBI in 118 games. He was a National League All-Star with Los Angeles (NL) in 2015 and again with Milwaukee in 2019 and has 185 career home runs in the big leagues.

THIS DATE IN 2002: For a second consecutive game at Victory Field, left fielder Ryan Thompson clubbed two home runs against Louisville, the latter performance lifting Indy to a 5-1 win. Right fielder Izzy Alcantara and catcher Lance Burkhart both homered as well, giving the Indians four long balls off Louisville starting pitcher Paul Darnell who lasted just three innings.
